



ADVENTIST DEVELOPMENT AND RELIEF AGENCY INTERNATIONAL BYLAWS

- Article I** **Name**
The name of this Corporation is ADVENTIST DEVELOPMENT AND RELIEF AGENCY INTERNATIONAL (hereinafter referred to as ADRA International).
- Article II** **Offices**
The registered office of this Corporation shall be located in the City of Washington in the District of Columbia. The Corporation may also have offices at such other places as the Board of Directors may, from time to time, designate.
- Article III** **Membership**
Membership of this Corporation shall be the members of the Executive Committee of the General Conference of Seventh-day Adventists and the members of the ADRA International Board of Directors who are not members of the Executive Committee of the General Conference of Seventh-day Adventists ("General Conference Executive Committee"). For the purpose of membership of this Corporation, the members of this Corporation shall continue as members until the General Conference Executive Committee and ADRA International Board of Directors members are chosen to succeed them.
- Article IV** **Members Meetings**
- Section 1. Regular Members Meetings**
The regular meeting of the membership shall be held annually in conjunction with the Annual Council of the General Conference Executive Committee. Notice to members of the meeting shall be sent to the members at least ten (10) days but not more than fifty (50) days prior to the opening of the meeting. A notice of the General Conference Executive Committee of its Annual Council schedule that includes the annual members meeting for ADRA International shall be deemed sufficient notice to the members of the General Conference Executive Committee.

Section 2. Special Members Meetings

Special meetings of the membership may be held upon notice sent to the members at least ten (10) days but not more than fifty (50) days prior to the date of the meeting. Special meetings of the membership may be called upon the affirmative vote of the Board of Directors, or upon the Board chair receiving a request documenting that at least fifty percent (50%) of the members who are also members of the General Conference Executive Committee have requested such special meeting. All meetings of the membership shall be conducted in accordance with the General Conference Rules of Order. Notice of a special meeting of the membership shall include a statement of the purpose or purposes for which the meeting is called. Members meetings may be conducted within or outside the District of Columbia as designated by the Board Chair.

Section 3. Quorum and Voting

A quorum to conduct business shall be at least one-third (1/3) of the eligible members of the Corporation present in person. The affirmative vote of a majority of the votes cast by those members present at a meeting at which a quorum is present shall be necessary for the adoption of any matter presented to the members. A member may vote in person only.

Section 4. Dissolution of the Corporation

The dissolution of the Corporation shall be only by a vote of the members of the Corporation and as required under District of Columbia law.

Article V

Board of Directors

Section 1. Powers

The business and property of the Corporation shall be conducted and managed by its Board of Directors, which may exercise all of the general powers granted to nonprofit corporations enumerated in Section 29-301.05 of the District of Columbia Nonprofit Corporation Act (the "Act") including subsequent amendments thereto, including, but not limited to, the power:

- a. To control and manage the affairs, property and funds of the Corporation;
- b. To authorize and cause to be executed mortgages and liens upon the real and personal property of the Corporation;
- c. To declare vacant the office of any officer or director or agent who does not conform to the Bylaws of this Corporation. Vacancies shall be filled in harmony with the Bylaws and the Act.

Section 2. Board of Directors Election

The Board of Directors shall be elected quinquennially by the members of the Corporation. Directors shall hold their offices until their successors are duly elected and enter upon their duties, unless otherwise determined by the Board of Directors. The Board of Directors shall consist of not less than twelve (12) and up to a maximum of sixty (60) members. The election of the Board of Directors shall take place at a members meeting held during the first Annual Council of the General Conference Executive Committee following a regular Session of the General Conference of Seventh-day Adventists.

Section 3. Vacancies

Vacancies occurring in the Board of Directors shall be filled by the Board of Directors for the unexpired portion of the quinquennial period.

Section 4. Meeting and Notice

The Board of Directors shall meet at the call of the chair and/or at the time of the Annual Council of the Executive Committee of the General Conference of Seventh-day Adventists, and such meetings shall be held at the principal office of the Corporation or at such other place as the Chair may determine either within the District of Columbia or elsewhere. The Corporation shall provide reasonable notice to the Directors in advance of any meeting based on the circumstances requiring such meeting but in no case shall notice be less than three (3) days in advance of any meeting unless such meeting is a regular meeting of the Board of Directors according to a schedule regularly provided to the Directors in which case notice shall be deemed to have been given.

Section 5. Quorum and Voting

At all meetings of the Board of Directors, one-third (1/3) of the Board of Directors shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business. Except as otherwise provided by law, the Articles of Incorporation, or these Bylaws, the vote of a majority of such quorum at a duly called meeting shall be sufficient to conduct business. Voting on all matters shall be in viva voce unless otherwise determined by the Chair or requested by a majority of the Directors present. In the absence of a quorum, the Directors present, by majority vote and without notice, may recess the meeting until a quorum shall attend.

Section 6. Assent to Action

A Director of the Corporation who is present at a meeting of the Board of Directors at which action on any corporate matter is taken shall be presumed to have assented to the action taken unless the Director's dissent shall be entered in the minutes of the meeting or unless the Director shall file a written dissent to such action with the person acting as the secretary of the meeting before the adjournment thereof, or shall forward such dissent by registered mail or in person to the Secretary of the Board of Directors within three (3) days after the adjournment of the meeting. Such right to dissent shall not apply to a Director who voted in favor of such action.

Section 7. Meetings by Conference Telephone

Members of the Board of Directors may participate in a meeting of the Board of Directors or a Committee of the Board by means of a conference telephone or similar communications equipment if all persons participating in the meeting can hear and speak to each other at the same time. Participation in a meeting by these means constitutes presence in person at a meeting.

Section 8. Action by Members Without a Meeting

Any action required or permitted to be taken at a meeting of the directors of the Corporation may be taken without a meeting if a consent in writing, setting forth the action so taken, shall be signed by all of the Directors. Such consent shall have the same effect as a unanimous vote of members and may be stated as such in any articles or documents filed with appropriate office required under the Act.

Section 9. Waiver of Notice

Whenever any notice is required to be given to any Director of the Corporation under the provisions of these Bylaws or under the provisions of the Articles of Incorporation or under the provisions of the Act, a waiver thereof in writing, signed by the Director or Directors entitled to such notice, whether before or after the time stated therein, shall be deemed equivalent to the giving of such notice.

Section 10. Director Conflicts of Interest

Any Director who has an interest in a contract or other transaction presented to the Board or a committee thereof for authorization, approval, or ratification shall make a prompt and full disclosure of their interest to the Board or committee prior to its acting on such contract or transaction. Such disclosure shall include any relevant and material facts known to such a person about the contract or transaction that might reasonably be construed to be adverse to the Corporation's interest.

No Director shall cast a vote on any matter which has a direct bearing on services to be provided by that Director, or any organization which such Director represents or in which such Director has an ownership interest or is otherwise interested or affiliated, which would directly or indirectly financially benefit such Director. All such services will be fully disclosed or known to the Board members present at the meeting at which such contract shall be authorized. Furthermore, the majority of the Board of Directors will be non-salaried by the Corporation and will not be related to salaried personnel or to parties providing services. In addition, the salaried individuals cannot vote on their own compensation, and compensation decisions will be made by the Board of Directors or as otherwise provided for in these Bylaws.

Section 11. Loans to Directors

The Corporation shall not lend money to or use its credit to assist its Directors or officers.

Section 12. Removal of Directors

At a meeting of the Board of Directors called including expressly for that purpose, any director may be removed by a vote of a majority of the Directors then in office.

Article VI

Committees of the Board

Committees of the Board called for in these Bylaws shall have and exercise the authority of the Board of Directors in the management of the Corporation as determined by the Board of Directors. Any committee formed by the Board of Directors but not otherwise called for in these Bylaws shall not have the authority of the Board of Directors but shall at all times report to the Board of Directors for implementation of recommended actions. The designation or appointment of any committee, either under these Bylaws or otherwise, shall not operate to relieve the Board of Directors or any individual Director of any responsibility imposed upon it or the Director by law.

A. Executive Committee

Section 1. Between Meetings of the Directors

The Board of Directors may conduct its business through an Executive Committee. The Board shall determine any limitations on the authorized power of the Executive Committee.

Section 2. Number, Appointment and Term

The Executive Committee shall consist of twelve (12) to sixteen (16) members who shall be appointed quinquennially by the Board of Directors from among their members. The Executive Committee shall be organized and shall perform its functions as directed by the Board and shall report periodically all actions to the

Board. Any action taken by the Executive Committee within the course and scope of its authority shall be binding to the Corporation.

Section 3. Chair

The Chair of the Executive Committee shall be the Chair of the Board of Directors.

Section 4. Vice Chair

The Vice Chair of the Executive Committee shall be the Vice Chair of the Board of Directors.

Section 5. Secretary

The Secretary of the Executive Committee shall be the President/Executive Director of the Corporation.

Section 6. Committees

The Executive Committee may, by resolution, provide for such special or ad hoc committees consisting of Directors of the Corporation as it determines desirable and discontinue the same at its pleasure. Each such committee shall have such powers and perform such duties, not in conflict with law, as may be assigned to it by the Executive Committee.

B. Finance Committee

Section 1. Purpose

The Board of Directors may conduct its financial business including budgeting and review of financial operations through a Finance Committee. The Board shall determine the extent of the role of the Finance Committee along with any limitations on its authorized power.

Section 2. Number, Appointment and Term

The Board of Directors shall determine the number of members of the Finance Committee and shall determine who shall serve on the Finance Committee and fill any vacancies, and, except as provided herein, shall name the officers of the Committee.

C. Audit Committee

Section 1. Purpose

The Board of Directors shall conduct its review of financial operations pertaining to its annual audit through an Audit Committee. The Board shall determine the scope of activities assigned to the Audit Committee and any limitations on its authorized power.

Section 2. Number, Appointment and Term

The Board of Directors shall determine the number of members of the Audit Committee and shall determine who shall serve on the Audit Committee and fill any vacancies, and, except as provided herein, name the officers of the Committee. The Audit Committee shall not include any

administrative officer or employee of the Corporation. The Audit Committee shall be organized and shall perform its functions as directed by the Board and shall report periodically all actions to the Board.

D. Provisions Governing All Committees Called for Under these Bylaws

Section 1. Quorum

At all meetings of the Committee, fifty percent (50%) plus one (1) of the members shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business. The vote of a majority of such quorum at a duly constituted meeting shall be sufficient to conduct business. Voting on all matters of business shall be by viva voce unless otherwise determined by the Chair or requested by a majority of the members present.

Section 2. Chair Pro Tempore

In the absence of the Chair and Vice Chair, if a committee has a vice chair appointed by the Board, at any meeting of the Committee, the Committee shall appoint a Chair pro tempore who shall preside at its meeting provided the Chair or the Vice Chair, if applicable, has consented to the calling of such meeting unless both the Chair and Vice Chair are unable or incompetent to provide such approval.

Section 3. Meetings

The Committee may hold a meeting at the call of the Chair or the Chair's designee at any time or place when a quorum is present.

Article VII

Corporate Officers

The officers of the Corporation shall be those that serve as officers of the Board and administrative officers of the Corporation.

A. Officers of the Board

Section 1. Officers of the Board

The officers of the Corporation Board shall be the Chair of the Board, at least one Vice Chair, the Board Secretary and the Board Treasurer, who shall be duly elected members of the Board of Directors, and such other officers as may be appointed by the members of the Board of Directors.

Section 2. Appointment, Term of Office

The officers of the Corporation Board specifically designated in Section 1 of this Article VII shall be appointed for terms of up to three (3) years by the directors. Each such officer may be appointed to successive terms and shall hold office until the officer's successor has been duly appointed or said officer shall have resigned or have been removed. A vacancy in any office because of death, resignation, removal, disqualification, or otherwise, may be filled by the Board of Directors for the unexpired portion of the term. In any case, all officers of the Board shall be subject to replacement or reappointment at a Board of Directors meeting following the members meeting at the time of the first Annual Council

of the General Conference Executive Committee following a regular Session of the General Conference of Seventh-day Adventists.

Section 3. Chair and Vice Chair of the Board

The Chair of the Board shall preside at all meetings of the Board of Directors and all Membership meetings, unless as otherwise provided for in these Bylaws. The Chair and Vice Chair of the Board shall each be a Vice President of the General Conference of Seventh-day Adventists as recommended by the General Conference President. The Vice Chair, at the request of the Chair, or in the Chair's absence, or during the Chair's inability to act, shall perform the duties and exercise the functions of the Chair and while so acting shall have the powers of the Chair. The Vice Chair shall have such other powers and perform such other duties as may be assigned by the Board of Directors or the Chair.

Section 4. Chair Pro Tempore

In the absence of the Chair and a Vice Chair at any duly called meeting of the Board of Directors, said Board of Directors shall appoint a Chair pro tempore who shall preside at its meeting.

Section 5. Secretary of the Board

The Secretary of the Board shall be the President/Executive Director of ADRA International. The Secretary of the Board is not the Corporation's Secretary as called for under the Act which shall be named under the administrative officers of the Corporation. The Secretary of the Board's duties shall include the following:

- a. Make and record the minutes of the meetings of the members and of the Board of Directors in books provided for that purpose and record therein all votes of such meetings;
- b. Give or cause to be given all notices, including those of the meetings of the members, the Board of Directors, and the Executive Committee in accordance with the provisions of the Bylaws or as required by law;
- c. Filing of legal documents as required in compliance with the Act;
- d. Other duties as assigned by the Board Chair or the Board of Directors.

Section 6. The Treasurer of the Board

The Treasurer of the Board shall be selected from the members of the Board of Directors and shall be assigned financial oversight duties for the Board as determined by the Chair and/or the Board of Directors. The Board Treasurer shall serve as Chair of the Finance Committee and the Audit Committee called for in Article VI. The Board Treasurer shall not be an administrative officer or employee of the Corporation.

Section 7. Compensation

The officers of the Board and the Directors of the Corporation shall receive no compensation for their attendance at any meeting of the Board of Directors. The Board may authorize appropriate reimbursements or policies for expenses for Directors. Notwithstanding the foregoing, any officer of the Board who serves as an administrative officer for the Corporation may be compensated in the officer's capacity as an administrative officer.

B.**Corporation's Administrative Officers****Section 1. Administrative Officers**

The administrative officers of ADRA International shall be the President/Executive Director, the Executive Vice President, who may also served as the Corporation's Secretary, Vice President for Finance, who also may serve as the Corporation's Administrative Treasurer, other officers as designated and appointed by the Board of Directors. Officers may hold more than one office at the same time except the offices of President and Secretary shall not be held by the same person.

Section 2. Appointment of Administrative Officers

The administrative officers of the Corporation shall be appointed for terms of up to three (3) years by the Board of Directors. Officers may serve successive terms and shall remain in their positions until such a time as the Board of Directors shall approve their dismissal and/or replacement. In any case, all administrative officers shall be subject to replacement or reappointment at a Board of Directors meeting following the members meeting at the time of the first Annual Council of the General Conference Executive Committee following a regular Session of the General Conference of Seventh-day Adventists.

Section 3. President

The President, also known as the Executive Director, shall be the chief executive officer of the Corporation and, subject to the control of the Board of Directors, shall in general supervise and control all of the business and affairs of the Corporation. The President may sign, with the Secretary or any other proper officer of the Corporation thereunto authorized by the Board of Directors, any deeds, mortgages, bonds, contracts or other instruments which the Board of Directors has authorized to be executed, except in cases where the signing and execution thereof shall be expressly delegated by the Board of Directors or by these Bylaws to some other officer or agent of the Corporation, or shall be required by law to be otherwise signed or executed; and in general shall perform all duties incident to the office of the President and such other duties as may be prescribed by the Board of Directors from time to time.

Section 4. Vice President(s)

There may be one (1) or more Vice Presidents who shall be assigned specific duties for administration. In the absence of the President or in the event of the President's death, inability or refusal to act, the Executive Vice President shall perform the duties of the President, and when so acting, shall have all the powers of and be subject to all the restrictions upon the President. Vice Presidents shall perform such other duties as from time to time may be assigned by the President or by the Board of Directors. Vice Presidents may be designated by their specific assignments and may carry duplicate roles such as the Vice President for Administration serving as Secretary and the Vice President for Finance serving as Administrative Treasurer.

Section 5. Secretary

The Secretary shall be the custodian of the official seal of the Corporation, if any, and shall affix that seal on all documents executed on behalf of the Corporation, pursuant to due authorization by the Board of Directors. The Secretary shall have the custody of and properly protect all executed deeds, leases, agreements and other legal documents and records to which the Corporation is a party or by which it is legally affected. The Secretary shall in general perform all duties incident to the office of Secretary and such other duties as from time to time may be assigned to the Secretary by the President or the Board of Directors.

Section 6. (Administrative) Treasurer

The Treasurer shall be the principal administrative financial officer of the Corporation and shall have charge and custody of and be responsible for all funds of the Corporation. The Treasurer shall sign all checks and promissory notes of the Corporation and shall receive and give receipts for moneys due and payable to the Corporation from any source whatsoever and deposit all such moneys in the name of the Corporation in such banks, trust companies or other depositories as shall be selected in accordance with the provisions of these Bylaws. The Treasurer shall keep or cause to be kept, adequate and correct accounts of the Corporation, including accounts of its assets, liabilities, receipts and disbursements. The Treasurer shall submit to the Board of Directors and the President, when required, statements of the financial affairs of the Corporation. The Treasurer shall in general perform all of the financial duties incident to the office of Treasurer and such other duties as from time to time may be assigned to the Treasurer by the President or the Board of Directors. If required by the Board of Directors, the Treasurer shall give a bond for the faithful discharge of the Treasurer's duties in such sum and with such surety or sureties as the Board of Directors shall determine.

Section 7. Other Appointments

The Board of Directors shall annually appoint:

- a. Auditors, whose duty shall be to audit the books of the Corporation and to prepare and submit to the Board of Directors an annual written report;
- b. Other officers and agents as necessary, to perform specifically assigned duties as the Board of Directors may determine. The Board of Directors may delegate to any officer or committee the power to appoint other officers or agents, specifying their authority and duties.

Section 8. Vacancies

A vacancy in any administrative officer position shall be filled for any unexpired portion of the term by the Executive Committee or the Board of Directors at any regular or special meeting. In the case of a vacancy of any officer of the Board, the vacancy shall be filled for any unexpired portion of the term by the Board of Directors at any regular or special meeting.

Section 9. Removal

The officers of the Corporation, whether administrative officers or officers of the Board, may be removed, either with or without cause, by the vote of a majority of the Board of Directors at any duly called meeting of the Board.

Article VIII

Finances, Contracts, Loans, Checks and Deposits

Section 1. Checks, Drafts, etc.

All checks, drafts and orders for the payment of money, notes and other evidence of indebtedness issued in the name of the Corporation, shall be signed by the President/Executive Director or one of the Vice Presidents of the Corporation or, in their absence, such other officer or person as the Board of Directors may appoint.

Section 2. Fiscal Year

The Corporation's fiscal year shall be the period from January 1 to December 31. The officers of the Corporation shall cause a balance sheet as of the closing date of the last fiscal year, together with a statement of income and expenditures for the year ending on that date, to be prepared and presented to the Directors at a duly called meeting of the Board of Directors.

Section 3. Contracts

The Board of Directors may authorize any officer or officers, agent or agents, to enter into any contract or execute and deliver any instrument in the name of and on behalf of the Corporation, and such authority may be general or confined to specific instances.

Section 4. Deposits

All funds of the Corporation not otherwise employed shall be deposited from time to time to the credit of the Corporation in such banks, trust companies or other depositories as the Board of Directors may elect.

Section 5. Gifts

The Board of Directors and the Executive Committee, or as otherwise delegated to the administrative officers of the Corporation, on behalf of the Corporation may accept any contribution, gift, bequest or devise for the general purposes or for any special purpose of the Corporation.

Article IX

Miscellaneous Provisions

Section 1. Seal

The Board of Directors shall provide a suitable seal bearing the name of the Corporation which shall be in the charge of the Secretary of the Board of Directors.

Section 2. Amendment of the Bylaws

Any and all provisions of these Bylaws may be altered, amended, repealed or added to only at a meeting of the membership of ADRA International. In order to make such changes in the Bylaws, a two-thirds majority of the members present and voting shall be required.

Article X

Indemnification

The Board of Directors may authorize the Corporation to pay expenses incurred by, or to satisfy a judgment or fine rendered or levied against, a present or former member, Director, officer or employee of the Corporation in an action brought by a third party against such a person (whether or not the Corporation is joined as a party defendant) to impose a liability or penalty on such a person while a member, Director, officer or employee, or by the Corporation, or by both; provided the Board of Directors determines in good faith that such member, Director, officer or employee was acting in good faith within what that person reasonably believed to be the scope of the person's employment or authority and for a purpose which that person reasonably believed to be in the best interests of the Corporation or its members. Payments authorized hereunder include amounts paid and expenses incurred in settling any such action or threatened action. The provisions of these articles shall apply to the estate, executor, administrator, heirs, legatees or devisees of a member, Director, officer or employee, and the terms "person" where used in this article shall include the estate, executor, administrator, heirs, legatees or devisees of such person.

Part VI-B lobbying Activity

Lobbying activities were conducted by Ellen Levinson on behalf of the Coalition for Food Aid (dissolved April 2006) and Alliance for Food Aid (created May 2006), of which ADRA is a member. Activities continued throughout the fiscal year, and were aimed at influencing legislation having to do with food aid. This targeted both the Farm Bill and annual appropriations actions by both Houses of Congress. Activities included direct contact with all relevant legislators and their staffers, as well as Congressional Committee members and staffers. It also included written letters on behalf of the Coalition / Alliance.

In addition,

ADRA participated in a multi-agency advertisement placed in the Washington Post to influence the position of the United States representative to the WTO/DOHA negotiations.

ADRA staff participated in the Interaction Forum advocacy day in which members visited congressional staff to advocate that Congress pass a budget that maintained current levels of Foreign Aid funding.

ADRA signed a multi-agency sponsored-letter to enlist congressional support to provide more funding for Family Planning.
