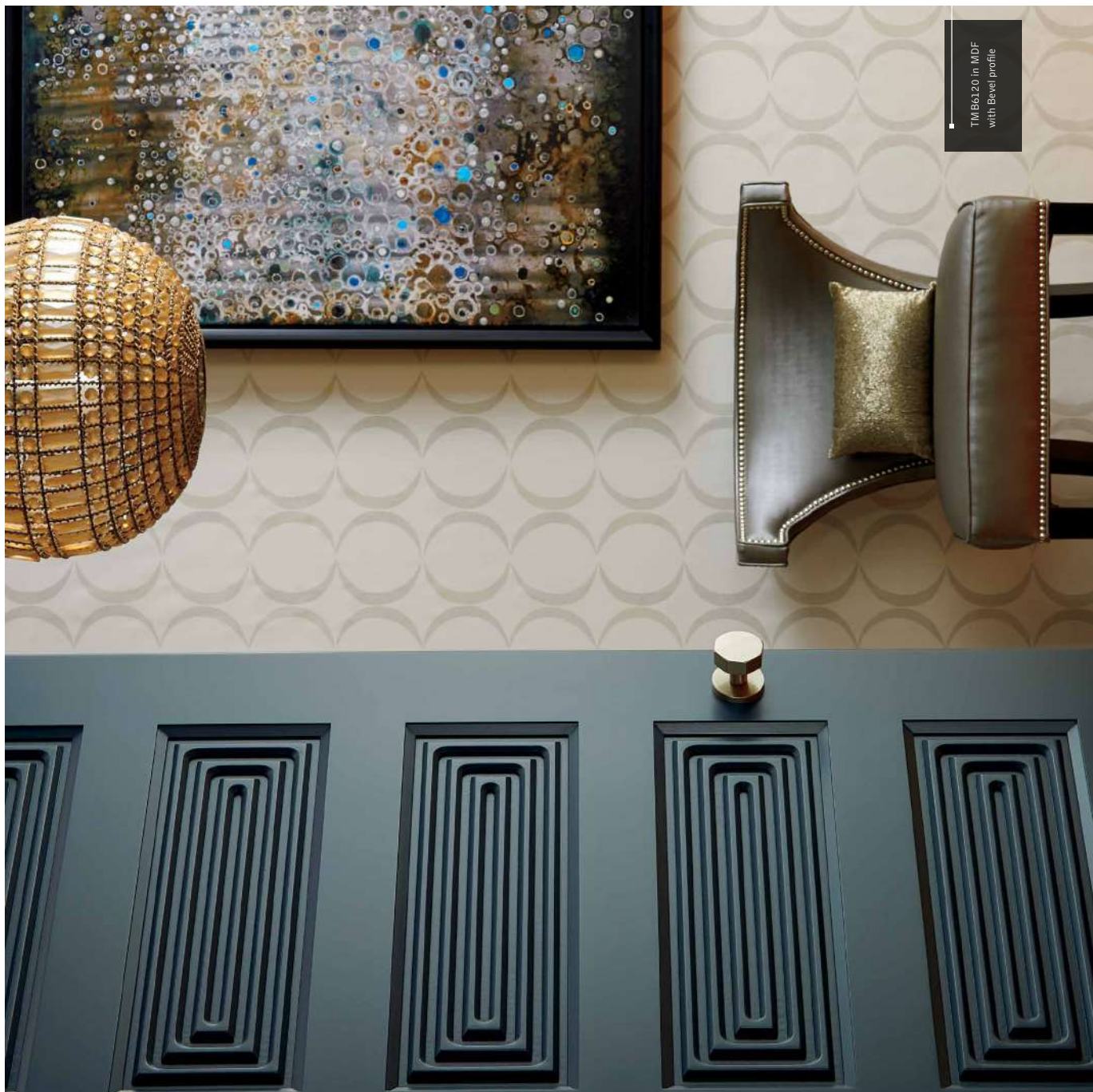
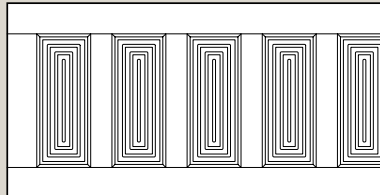




ART DECO

- The TruStile Art Deco door styles combine modern European design ideas introduced in France with the romance of 1930s Hollywood.

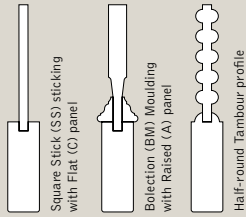

A comfortable style that reflects architectural simplicity.

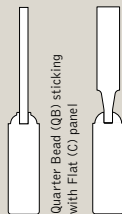

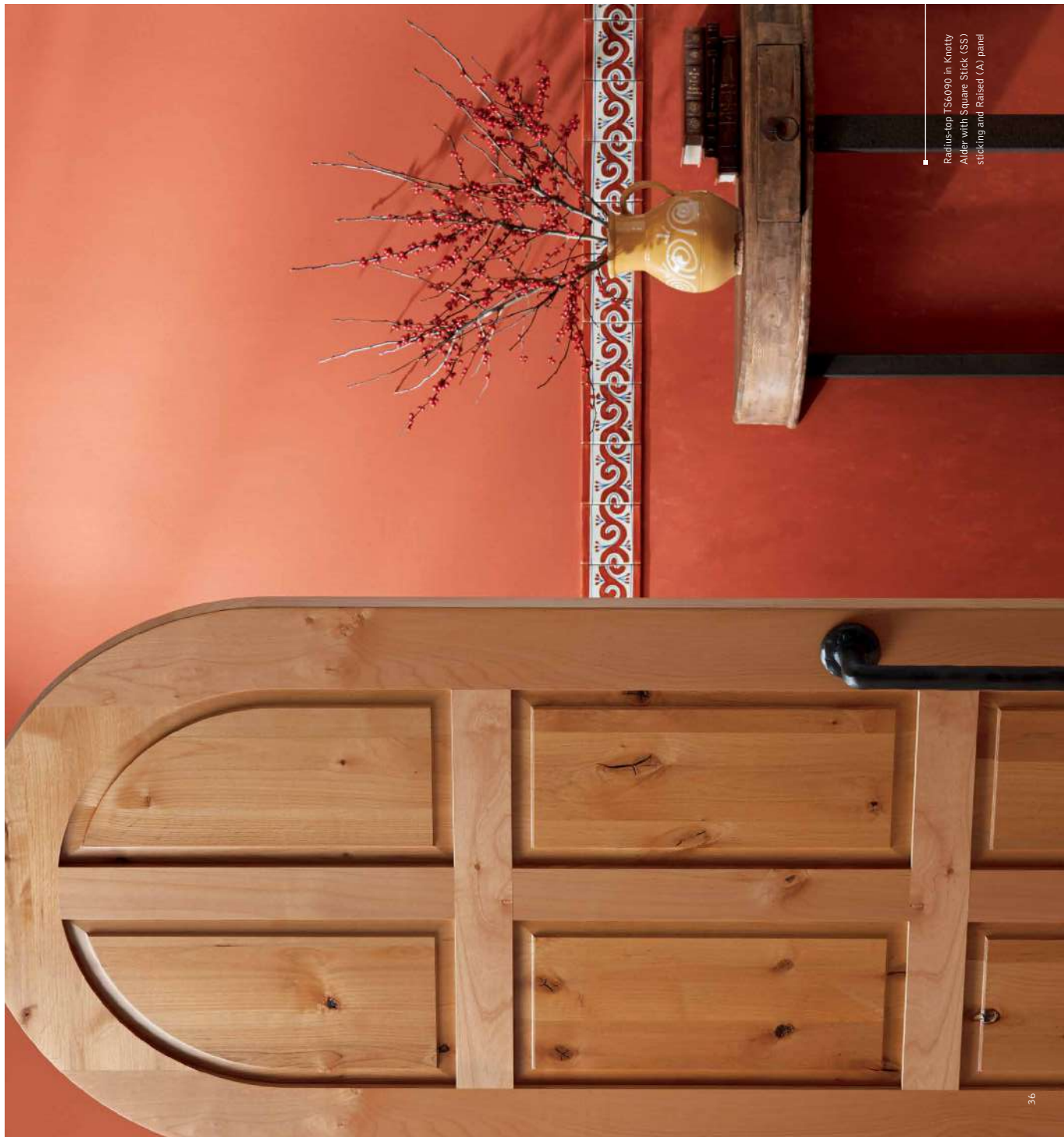


MEDITERRANEAN

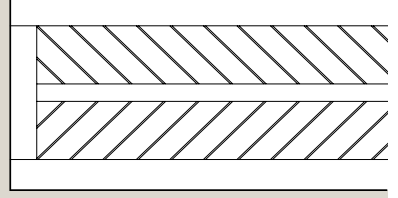




SPANISH COLONIAL

- TruStile's Spanish Colonial series showcases doors with simple lines associated with today's Mission-Inspired architecture as well as decorative Spanish Revival door designs.



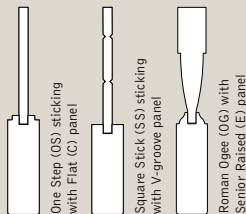

TRADITIONAL

Traditional design often reflects the common sense principles of practicality and functionality.

- Broadly defined, Traditional or vernacular architecture is viewed as a conservative way of building homes to retain the style and beauty of a particular community based on the localized design and historic context.

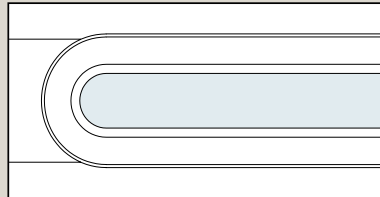




TUDOR

- Inspired by English manor homes, the TruStile Tudor series features an assortment of elegant designs and gentle arches.



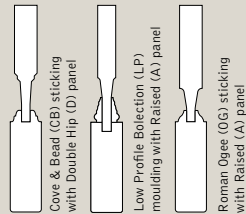

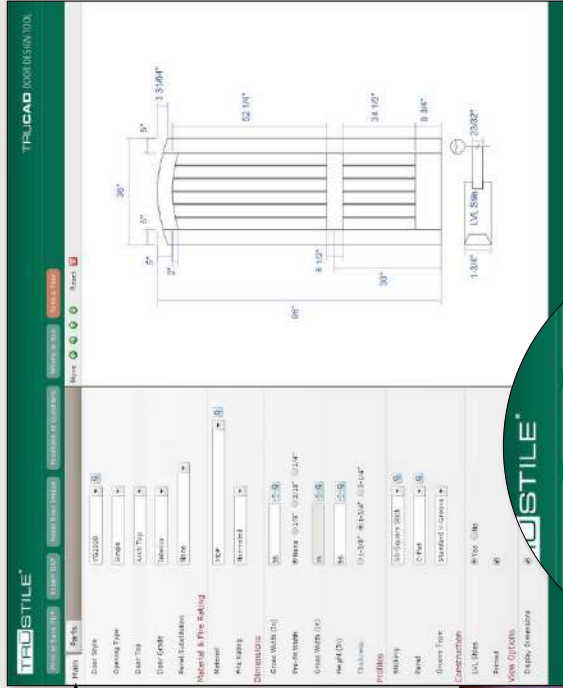
