

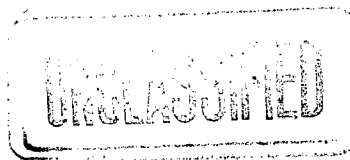

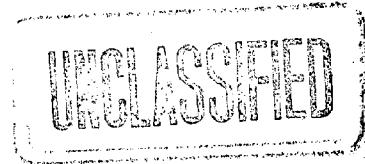

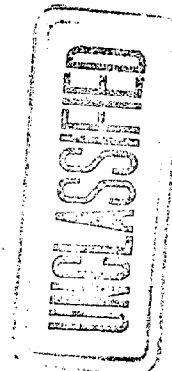

PART II

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

During the month of June the Battalion conducted both saturation patrolling of the Rocket Belt and Operation Allenbrook. Prior to departure on Allenbrook, security was provided for bridges within the TAOR and for the dam construction site where construction continues. The Battalion position and that at the Ha Dong Bridge were improved and extensive training and preparations for Allenbrook were carried out. The Battalion also had elements participating in a river clearing operation, Operation Woodpecker, along the western edge of the TAOR.

The S-2 Section continued its activities around the Battalion perimeter, with daylight sweeps and night time ambushes. All Kit Carsons and Scouts were assigned to companies for Allenbrook and most of the Section displaced with the forward Command Group. The snipers from Headquarters Company, 27th Marines were employed frequently with much success in the Battalion TAOR, but even more successfully during Allenbrook.

The MEDCAP program continued both in the Or and in local hamlets. In the CP 2197 patients were treated, an increase of 150% over the month of May. There was also an increase in the mobile MEDCAP with 827 people treated. During the mobile medcaps psychological operations continued with the distribution of leaflets, newspapers, posters, rewards, and Cheu Hoi information.

The construction of the dam in the vicinity of Ha Tay and Viem Tray (4) (BT 007654) continued. Most of the heavy work done by the engineers has been completed and the local population is taking a greater percentage of the construction effort upon itself.

During the first half of the month an extensive census was taken of all hamlets and villages within the Battalion TAOR. When compared with the last census taken by 3/5 the results showed that population had shifted and grown. Some hamlets had received more incoming personnel while some had decreased in population.

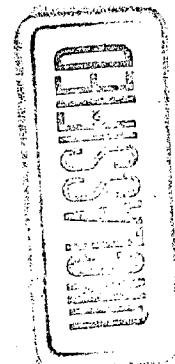
Training in personal response continued throughout the month. On the 18th representatives from Div G-5 conducted a class and Battalion S-5 personnel indoctrinated new personnel in the Battalion.

Constant improvement of the CP area continued. New buildings at the waterpoint, new drainlines for the messhall, a new Battalion ammo bunker, and the new concrete mess deck were completed during the month. In addition four new Company Command bunkers, a Battalion Command Bunker, 4 Company communications bunkers and a Battalion communication bunker were requested. Acquisition of those bunkers is expected to be delayed due to the shortage of material in the Division area. Requests were also submitted for new heads and urinals and for construction of a new tower in the SII sector of the Battalion Combat Base.

On 23 June the S-4 section undertook the operation of the LSA at the Regimental CP under the cognizance of the 27th Marines to support the Battalion activities in Operation Allenbrook. All resupply and replacement of necessary equipment for the Operation was processed thru the LSA. In addition non-battale casualties and some minor WIA's were processed thru the LSA to the Battalion rear. POW's, refugees, and slightly wounded civilians were also lifted out of the Operation area to the LSA. Approximately 20,000 pounds were lifted to the companies daily. This included 800 gal of water and apples, ice cream, soda, sandwiches, onions and other moral boosting items.

At 1530 on 23 June the Battalion assumed the mission of continuing Operation Allenbrook. The Battalion CP and two companies together with the Engineer Clearing Team established a combat base. From this location local clearing operations were conducted and extensive combat patrolling both day and night met with light contact. The other two Companies set up combat bases elsewhere in the Operation area. Thus far most contact has been siting of small groups of enemy. There have been many areas discovered that were heavily booby trapped. On the night of 23 June, Companies E, F, and H received about 60 incoming mortar rounds mixed 60mm and 82mm. This was the only instance of mortars being fired by the enemy. In spite of light contact and evasive actions on the part of the enemy, aggressive combat operations, extensive combat patrolling and the use of "killer teams" netted 11 enemy KIA while losing only 3 USMC KIA. Maximum and timely use of supporting arms and supporting fires isolated the AO, securing a realitively safe environment for engineering clearing operations. A total of 315,000 meters of heavily fortified wooded areas was completely leveled.

1. SITUATION

a. Enemy Forces. See Annex B (Intelligence) to Operation Order 6-68.

b. Friendly Forces

- (1) See Annex A (Task Organization) to Operation Order 6-68.
- (2) 1st Bn, 27th Marines displaces to 2nd Bn, 27th Marines T-OR and assumes tactical responsibility for operational area.
- (3) 27th Marines provides logistical support from LSA established at LZ 410.
- (4) 1st Engineers Clearing Team provides engineer support on Co Noi Island.
- (5) Helicopter Support Team, Shore Party Battalion supports 2nd Battalion, 27th Marines by selecting and controlling LZ's and incoming aircraft.
- (6) 1st Plt, Co B, 5th Tank Battalion provides light section of tanks in support of operations on Co Noi Island.

c. Artillery

- (1) Echo Btry, 2nd Bn, 13th Marines displaces to vic Liberty bridge and provides direct artillery support.

2. MISSION. 2nd Battalion, 27th Marines deploy to Co NOI Island and conduct offensive operations to seek out and destroy the enemy, his caches, and installations.

3. EXECUTION

- a. Concept of Operations. On or about 220700 June 68 two companies and Cnd Gr A (Forward) will embark aboard helicopters, one at LZ 410 and one at LZ 412 to be helilifted to GO NOI Island where they will effect a relief of two companies of 1/27 located on the eastern sector of the area of operation.

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On or about 230700 June 68 two companies will embark on helicopters at LZ 412 to be helilifted to GO NOI Island where they will effect a relief of two companies of 1/27 located on the western half of the island.

b. Company E

- (1) On or about 220700 June 68 board trucks at the Ha Dong Bridge for transportation to Battalion CP.
- (2) On or about 220900 and on order commence embarking aboard helicopters at LZ 412 to be helilifted to eastern half of GO NOI Island.
- (3) Upon arrival GO NOI Island effect a relief of one company 1/27 and be prepared to impliment the Battalion's mission.

c. Company F

- (1) On or about 220700 June 68 embark one Sqd on one truck in the Bn CP to be transported to the Ha Dong bridge, where they will provide security for that installation until relieved by units of 1/27.
- (2) On or about 230700 June 68 board helicopters at LZ 412 to be helilifted to the western half of GO NOI Island.
- (3) Be prepared, on order, to divert to eastern sector of AO and conduct operations in conjunction with companies Bohe and Motel.

d. Company G

- (1) On or about 230830 Jun 68 and on order embark aboard helicopters at LZ 412 to be helilifted to the western half of GO NOI Island.
- (2) Upon arrival GO NOI Island effect a relief of one company 1/27 and be prepared to impliment the Battalion's mission.

e. Company H

- (1) On or about 220700 June 68 embark aboard helicopters at LZ 410 to be helilifted to the eastern half of GO NOI Island.
- (2) Upon arrival GO NOI Island effect a relief of one company of 1/27 and be prepared to impliment the Battalion's mission.

f. H&S Company

- (1) Secure the Battalion (Rear) CP.
- (2) Provide personnel as specified in Annex A (Task Organization).

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 G. 81st Air Assault Lt

- (1) Attach 2d Section to E Company

- (1) Provide continuous radio communications between forward rear Command elements during the movement and operation.

J. Coordinating Instructions

- (1) Companies will report when their embarkation is commencing, when their last units have arrived at GO WOI, and when the company is organized and prepared to commence tactical operations.
- (2) Position reports giving the locations of all Company CP's and Platoon CP's and all patrols and outposts are required as they occur or change, and will be reported no less than once an hour. If no change in location has occurred submit a no change report.
- (3) Spot reports will be submitted immediately as incidents occur. Do not delay reports due to completeness of the information available. Submit the complete spot when final information is available.
- (4) Companies will dig in nightly. Fill in holes prior to departing area.
- (5) Companies will plan and submit night defensive fires promptly upon setting in night defensive position.
- (6) When moving out and conducting operations make maximum use of preplanned fires, reconnaissance by fire, preparatory fires, and all means of fire support on contact.
- (7) Units and personnel will be tied in visually and all areas covered by observation and fields of fire. Special consideration must be given to prevent infiltration of enemy during the hours of darkness.
- (8) All positions will be policed for Government equipment and ordnance prior to departing area. Police of the battlefield and field sanitation will be enforced.

1. SUMMARY OF ENEMY SITUATION

a. Information pertaining to the enemy at present on Goi Noi Island has been sketchy. The enemy has been in defense operations until now. Actual attacks are usually probing actions and minor. 60mm and 81mm Mortar attacks can be expected. It is felt that he will continue his present tactics of defenses with the enemy trying to dictate the time and place of engagement with the remnants of one regiment sized unit (designation unknown).

b. Small unit contacts of stubborn defenses, sniper fire, covered by heavy machine guns, are present throughout Goi Noi. It has been reported that these tactics are used extensively. It has also been reported that many of the NVA/VC operating in this region are discouraged and might be willing to surrender. Signs of this should be looked for; at the same time be on guard for trickery.

2. ESSENTIAL ELEMENTS OF INFORMATION

- a. Determine the size of unit or units in this area.
- b. Determine if the enemy will attack our units, when, where, and in what strength.
- c. Determine as to what extent the enemy will defend Goi Noi Island.
- d. Determine if the enemy will withdraw and escape thru our lines or south toward Tam Ky.

3. INTELLIGENCE ACQUISITION TASKS


a. All units of this command will be on the lookout for answers to the EEIs listed in paragraph 2.

b. In addition, any and all information obtained about the enemy and his future plans will be forwarded to this headquarters by the most expeditious means available.

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4. MEASURES FOR HANDLING PERSONNEL, DOCUMENTS AND MATERIAL.
 - a. Prisoners of war, Deserters, Repatriates, Inhabitants and other persons will be handled in accordance with Battalion SOP for Intelligence 3800.1
 - b. Captured documents and material will be handled in accordance with Battalion Order 3800.1.
5. REPORTS AND DISTRIBUTION. Intelligence reports will be forwarded to all Company Commanders by the fastest means available.

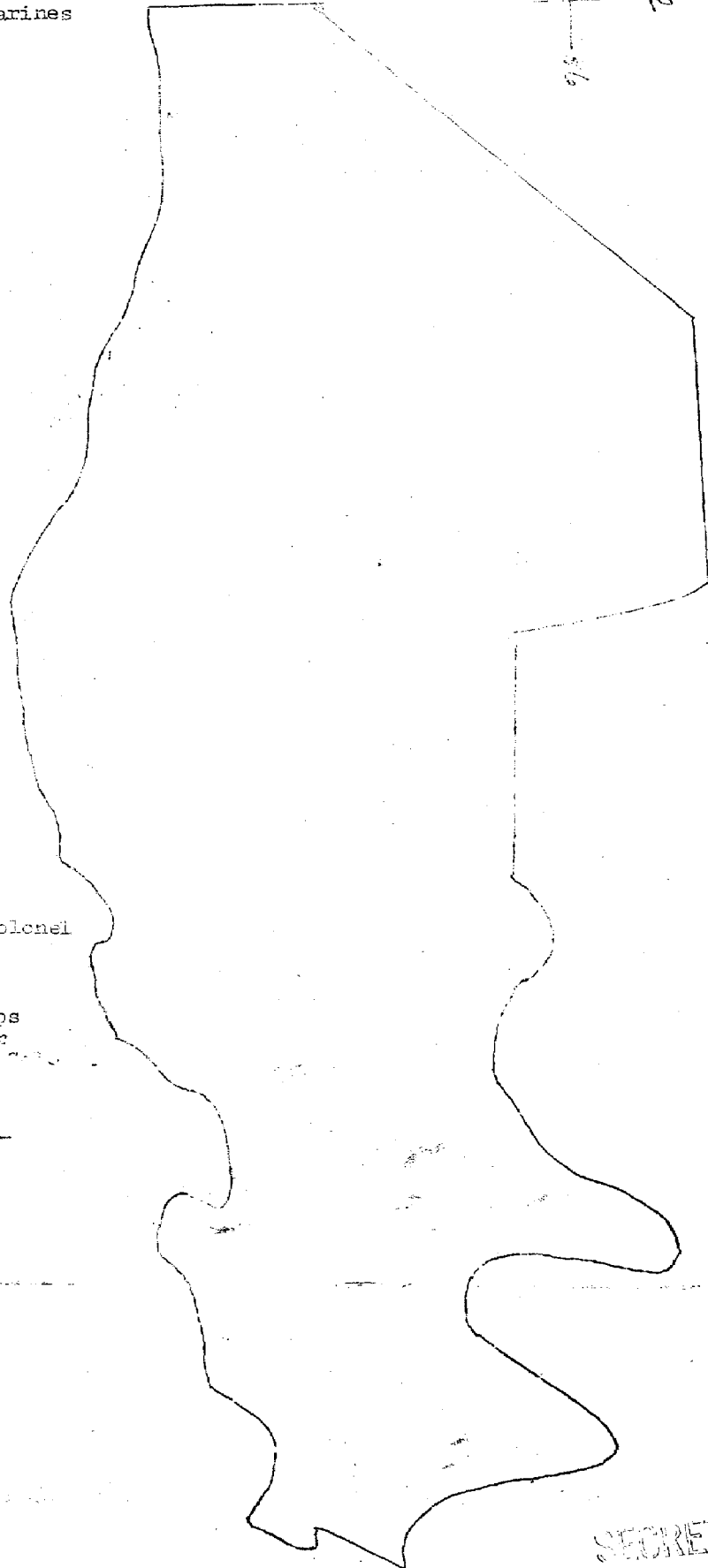
