- I confirm that the information given to the examining doctor regarding my present state of health and previous medical history is correct.
- I agree to the MSA's Medical Consultant obtaining medical information about me from any doctor who has ever seen me about anything which affects my physical or mental health.
- I understand that if any medical conditions arise during the validity of my 2016 licence, including (but not limited to) accidents at motor sport events, I must inform the MSA Medical Administrator prior to competing in any further motor sport events.
- I understand that the MSA is registered under the Data Protection Act to hold information on its computer system and I hereby agree to my personal data being processed in any way relevant to the operation of the MSA.
- If applying for professional status, I confirm that for the last tax year prior to this application I declared earnings as a competitor in motor sport to Her Majesty's Revenue & Customs and I therefore request that the MSA endorses my licence with the EU flag, in accordance with H26.2.
- A competitor shall not have time off school to participate in motorsport without the prior written approval of their school (see H7.1).
- I understand that any Competition Licence issued will remain the property of the MSA which reserves the right to withdraw or suspend at any time. The reason(s) for any such withdrawal or suspension shall be stated (see H3.1.2).
- I hereby agree that, in the event of being involved in a motor sport accident, personal data recorded by the FIA or MSA concerning only the circumstances of the accident and its immediate outcome, including any injuries suffered by me may be stored electronically on the FIA Motor Sport World Accident Database (WADB) in accordance with the International Sporting Code, for the sole purpose of research in support of improving safety for the sport.


