SHANGHAI, AUG. 21.—(AP)—War and fire continued to lay waste to Shanghai today, with foreign police estimates that about eleven square miles of the world's sixth largest port had been destroyed by fire. Fire leveled most of Chinese Chapel, Japanese Honkwa, Yangtzeport, Industrial Post, and the Wangpoo river, and Kiangwan. Only the International Settlement, the French concession and parts of Nantao in the South Chow Creek area remain intact. In the absence of firemen, who already had evacuated the burning areas, the flames continued to spread unchecked in all directions. Stiffing smoke and fumes had been driving many Chinese belligerents from the Hongkew battle area.
