DMM Revision: Adding Diplomatic Post Office as a Valid Overseas Address

Effective January 18, 2009, the Postal Service™ is revising the *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service*, Domestic Mail Manual (DMM®) 113, 123, 413, 423, 503, 507, 601, 703, 705, and 707.3 to reflect a request from the Department of State to distinguish diplomatic overseas mail from military mail.

A Diplomatic Post Office (DPO) is a designated USPS® civilian Post Office™ that falls under the jurisdiction of the postmaster of either New York City or San Francisco. These facilities are operated and managed by the Department of State to serve overseas personnel at American embassies and consulates. DPO is the preferred name for mail addressed to Department of State overseas offices.

Customers shipping items to a DPO address in a Priority Mail® large flat-rate box will pay the same price for the

Priority Mail large flat-rate box as for a box shipped to an APO/FPO address.

With this change, DPO last line address information must contain the DPO designation and the appropriate two-letter state abbreviation (AA, AE, or AP), followed by the ZIP+4® or 5-digit ZIP™ Code.

IMM Revision: Computing Postage for International Mailpieces

Effective January 18, 2009, the Postal Service™ is revising *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service*, International Mail Manual (IMM®) 152, 212, 222, and 235 to clarify the procedures for determining single-piece weights in retail and presort mailings.

These revisions also provide procedures on computing online postage for Global Express Guaranteed® (GXG®), Express Mail International®, and Priority Mail International™ services.

For the most part, these standards mirror what we have in place in *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal*

Service, Domestic Mail Manual (DMM®) for determining single-piece weights and how customers compute online postage for Express Mail® service.

IMM Revision: Customs Label Requirements for the Priority Mail International Flat-Rate Envelope and Small Flat-Rate Box

Effective January 18, 2009, the Postal Service™ is revising *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service*, International Mail Manual (IMM®) Exhibit 123.61 to clarify and simplify the proper required customs declaration forms when mailers use the Priority Mail International™ flat-rate envelope or the small flat-rate box.

Regardless of content, the Priority Mail International flat-rate envelope or small flat-rate box requires PS Form 2976, *Customs Declaration CN 22 — Sender's Declaration* (green label), for items valued under \$400, or PS Form 2976-A, *Customers Declaration and Dispatch Note — CP 72*, for

items valued at \$400 or more. The maximum weight for both of these items remains at 4 pounds.

Deposit Ticket Changes

The Harland Banking Supply changes referenced in the article “Deposit Ticket and Bank Account Changes” in *Postal Bulletin 22244* (10-23-08, pages 65–68) will now take effect in eBuy on January 23, 2009, and not on January 30, 2009, as previously stated.

Beginning January 23, 2009, the maximum order quantity for deposit ticket orders will be increased, and offices may chose quantities of either 200 or 400.

To further support financial reporting requirements, only two-part deposit tickets will be used, effective January 23, 2009. The two-part deposit tickets will be shipped in bound books with 50 tickets per book.

Contract Postal Unit Anti–Money Laundering/Anti-Terrorist Compliance Training Released

All postal managers responsible for the administration of contract postal units (CPUs) are reminded that personnel in CPUs that sell money orders must comply with all federal laws and regulations and with postal policies related to anti–money laundering and anti-terrorist initiatives.

Federal anti–money laundering and anti-terrorist laws and regulations (commonly referred to as the Bank Secrecy Act and the USA PATRIOT Act) mandate that the Postal Service™ implement a comprehensive anti–money laundering/anti-terrorist program (AML/ATP). To satisfy its legal mandate, the Postal Service has developed a CPU training packet that consists of a Bank Secrecy Act (BSA) training DVD and stand-up talk. This packet was mailed in December. We are asking that the training be completed within 45 days of receipt of the training materials. All training should be completed no later than March 1, 2009.

Postal managers responsible for CPUs must ensure that the CPU receives the BSA training material. Managers of CPUs must ensure that:

1. All CPU personnel who sell postal money orders and the CPU managers who supervise them must view the BSA training video and review the training stand-up talk.

2. All CPUs that sell postal money orders maintain a supply of PS Forms 8105-A, *Funds Transaction Report*, and PS Forms 8105-B, *Suspicious Transaction Report*, and that the forms are readily available to personnel who sell money orders.
3. CPU personnel send completed PS Forms 8105-A and PS Forms 8105-B to the address on the bottom of the forms the day the forms are completed.

A copy of the stand-up talk that was mailed to the CPUs is included on page 8. Each office should report to the BSA Compliance Office once its training is complete by sending an e-mail to lisa.m.williams@usps.gov or by calling Lisa at 202-268-3773.

Note: CPUs that do not sell postal money orders *do not* need to take the training.

BSA/AML Contract Postal Unit Training Stand-Up Talk

Notes and Topics	Stand-Up Script
Overview	Over the past several years you have been learning about compliance with federal anti-money laundering laws, commonly referred to as the Bank Secrecy Act. You have learned that customers must complete PS Form 8105-A, <i>Funds Transaction Report</i> , when they purchase \$3,000 or more in money orders during the same day, and that you must complete a PS Form 8105-B, <i>Suspicious Transaction Report</i> , when you suspect that customers might be using money orders to launder proceeds from illegal activities. Thanks to your efforts, the Postal Service has made tremendous strides in complying with the laws. We have gained the respect of our regulators and law enforcement agencies alike. But we need to fine-tune some of the procedures to make us even better. Following are some important points to keep in mind when completing PS Form 8105-A and PS Form 8105-B.
PS Form 8105-A	Let's start with PS Form 8105-A. It is very important that the form is complete and accurate in order for the Postal Service to stay in compliance with federal laws.
Date of Birth	Make sure the complete date (including the year) is recorded accurately on the form.
Social Security Number	The <i>only</i> acceptable substitutions are: Tax Identification Number (TIN), Employer Identification Number (EIN), Passport Number, and Alien Registration Number.
Military IDs	Note: Military IDs are no longer acceptable replacements for Social Security Numbers.
Other IDs	Acceptable "other government IDs" include: local-, state-, and federal-issued photo identification <i>if they contain a unique number</i> . Examples include local, state, and federal law enforcement IDs, and Indian tribal IDs
Non-Government Issued IDs	Note: Credit cards, library cards, company (employment) IDs, club cards, such as Wal-Mart, Sam's Club, etc., are <i>not</i> acceptable "other IDs", even if they have photographs on them.
Other ID Type	If "other government ID" is used, the <i>type</i> of photo ID must be entered on the form.
Complete Customer Information Needed	If customers refuse to provide <i>all</i> required information, you must refuse to sell the money orders.
Awareness of Previous Money Order Purchases	If you are aware that the customer has purchased money orders from another office (or another person in your office) and if the purchase being made combined with the other purchase(s) during the day is \$3,000 or greater, a PS Form 8105-A <i>must</i> be completed.
PS Form 8105-B	Let's review a few key points about PS Form 8105-B. The training video provides you with the top 10 things to remember about reporting suspicious activities. Keep these things in mind as you are filling them out.
Reasons for Suspiciousness	The reasons for suspiciousness <i>must</i> be indicated — Box 1, 2, and/or 3 must be checked. If none of those boxes apply, the comments must contain sufficient detail to indicate why the transaction is suspicious.
Full Description of Suspicious Activity	Simply checking Box 4, the "Other box", is not sufficient, even if a detailed description of the individual(s) is provided.
Handwriting	Comments must be legible. The BSA team recommends printing instead of script.
Minimum PS Form 8105-B Information	Each form should, at a minimum, have the age and gender of the customer(s) and the time of the transaction.
Wrap-up	This year's training video is an excellent reminder of a few of the top things to remember about suspicious activities. The training provides examples of how we can stay alert to money laundering activities and keep the Postal Service in compliance with federal laws. Your work in this area is making a difference and is very important. Thank you for your efforts and let's continue to keep a sharp eye out for potential money launderers.

Stamp Announcement 09-07: Abraham Lincoln



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On February 9, 2009, in Springfield, Illinois, the Postal Service™ will issue a 42-cent, *Abraham Lincoln* commemorative stamp in four designs in a pressure-sensitive adhesive (PSA) pane of 20 stamps (Item 464700). The stamp, designed by Richard Sheaff of Scottsdale, Arizona, goes on sale nationwide February 9, 2009.

The Postal Service recognizes the 200th anniversary of the birth of Abraham Lincoln (1809–1865), who rose from humble, frontier origins to become a prominent lawyer, politician, and ultimately president of the United States.

The stamp art was created by Mark Summers of Waterdown, Ontario, Canada, who is noted for his scratch-board technique, a style distinguished by a dense network of lines etched with exquisite precision. Each stamp features a different aspect of Lincoln's life.

How to Order the First Day of Issue Postmark

Customers have 60 days to obtain the first day of issue postmark by mail. They may purchase new stamps at their local Post Office™, at The Postal Store® website at www.usps.com/shop, or by calling 800 STAMP-24. They should affix the stamps to envelopes of their choice, address the envelopes (to themselves or others), and place them in a larger envelope addressed to:

After applying the first day of issue postmark, the Postal Service will return the envelopes through the mail. There is no charge for the postmark. All orders must be postmarked by April 10, 2009.

Distribution: Item 464700, 42-cent Abraham Lincoln PSA Pane of 20 Stamps

Stamp distribution offices (SDOs) will receive approximately 50 to 55 percent of their full standard automatic distribution quantity for a PSA sheet stamp. Distributions are rounded up to the nearest master carton size (40,000 stamps).

Initial Supply to Post Offices

SDOs will make a subsequent automatic distribution to Post Offices of one-half their full standard automatic distribution quantity using PS Form 17, *Stamp Requisition/Stamp Return*. SDOs must not distribute stamps to Post Offices before February 2, 2009.

Additional Supply

Post Offices requiring additional stamps must requisition Item 464700 from their designated SDO using PS Form 17. SDOs requiring additional stamps must order them from the appropriate accountable paper depository (APD) using PS Form 17.

For fulfilling supplemental orders from SDOs, the Chicago, New York, Memphis, and San Francisco APDs will each receive 1,200,000 additional stamps.

Sales Policy

All Post Offices must acquire and maintain a supply of each new commemorative stamp as long as customer demand exists, until inventory is depleted, or until the stamp is officially withdrawn from sale. If supplies run low, Post Offices must reorder additional quantities using their normal ordering procedures.

Verifying U.S. Postal Service Money Orders

Follow these steps to cash a Postal Service™ money order:

1. Check that the amount does not exceed the legal limit: \$1,000 for domestic, and \$700 for international postal money orders.
2. Check that the proper security features are present:
 - When held to the light, a watermark of Benjamin Franklin is repeated from top to bottom on the left side.
 - When held to the light, a dark line (security thread) runs from top to bottom with the word “USPS” repeated.
 - There should be no discoloration around the dollar amounts, which might indicate the amounts were changes.

3. If the money order seems suspicious, call the U.S. Postal Service Money Order Verification System at 866-459-7822.

Note: Mail order catalogs are prohibited as SAM or PAL mail.

A. Securities, currency, or precious metals in their raw, unmanufactured state are prohibited. Official shipments are exempt from this restriction.

A1. Mail addressed to "Any Servicemember," or similar wording such as "Any Soldier," "Sailor," "Airman," or "Marine"; "Military Mail"; etc., is prohibited. Mail must be addressed to an individual or job title such as "Commander," "Commanding Officer," etc.

B. PS Form 2976-A is required for all mail weighing 16 ounces or more, with exceptions noted below. In addition, mailers must properly complete required customs documentation when mailing any potentially dutiable mail addressed to an APO or FPO regardless of weight. The following are exceptions to the requirement for customs documentation on nondutiable mail that weighs 16 ounces or more:

- Known mailers are exempt from providing customs documentation on non-dutiable letters, and printed matter weighing 16 ounces or more. (A known mailer is anyone who legally applies a permit imprint to a mailpiece. Mail with meter postage is not considered to be from a known mailer.)
- All federal, state, and local government agencies are exempt from providing customs documentation on mail addressed to an APO or FPO, except for those APOs/FPOs to which restriction B2 applies.
- Prepaid mail from military contractors is exempt, providing the mailpiece is endorsed "Contents for Official Use — Exempt from Customs Requirements."

B1. PS Form 2976 or 2976-A is required. Articles are liable for customs duty and/or purchase tax unless they are bona fide gifts intended for use by military personnel or their dependents. When the contents of a parcel meet these requirements, the mailer must endorse the customs form, "Certified to be a bona fide gift, personal effects, or items for personal use of military personnel and dependents," under the heading, Description of Contents. **Exceptions:** All other exceptions listed in restriction B above are applicable to this restriction.

B2. All federal, state, and local government agencies must complete customs documentation when sending mail addressed to or from this APO or FPO weighing 16 ounces or more.

C. Cigarettes and other tobacco products are prohibited.

C1. Obscene articles, prints, paintings, cards, films, videotapes, etc., and horror comics and matrices are prohibited.

D. Coffee is prohibited.

E1. Medicines or vaccines not conforming to French laws are prohibited.

E2. Any matter depicting nude or seminude persons, pornographic or sexual items, or nonauthorized political materials is prohibited. Although religious materials contrary to the Islamic faith are prohibited in bulk quantities, items for the personal use of the addressee are permissible.

E3. Radio transceivers, cordless telephones, global positioning systems, scanners, base stations, and handheld transmitters are prohibited.

F. Firearms of any type are prohibited in all classes of mail. See definitions of firearms in DMM 601.11.1.2c. This restriction does not apply to firearms mailed to or by official U.S. government agencies. The restriction for mail to this APO/FPO ZIP Code does not apply to firearms mailed from this APO/FPO ZIP Code, provided ATF and USPS regulations are met. Antique firearms are a separate category defined in DMM 601.11.2 and ATF regulations; they do not require an ATF form.

F1. Privately owned weapons addressed to an individual are prohibited in any class of mail.

F2. Importation of firearms is restricted to one shotgun and one single shot.22 caliber rifle per individual.

G. Only letters, flats, and Periodicals are authorized. Parcels of any class are prohibited.

H. Meats, including preserved meats, whether hermetically sealed or not, are prohibited.

H1. Pork or pork by-products are prohibited.

I. Mail of all classes must fit in a mail sack. Mail may not exceed the following dimensions:

- Maximum length 20 inches.
- Maximum width 12 inches.
- Maximum height 12 inches.

The maximum length and girth combined may not exceed 68 inches.

This restriction does not apply to registered mail and official government mail marked MOM.

I1. This restriction does not apply to registered mail.

I2. This restriction does not apply to official government mail marked MOM.

J. Parcels may not exceed 108 inches in length and girth combined.

K. Mail that includes in the address the words, "Dependent Mail Section," may consist only of letter mail, newspapers, magazines, and books. No parcel of any class containing any other matter may be mailed to the Dependent Mail section. This restriction does not apply if the address does not include the words "Dependent Mail Section."

L. All official mail is prohibited.

M. Fruits, vegetables, animals, and living plants are prohibited.

N. Registered mail is prohibited.

O. Delivery status information for Extra Services is not available on USPS.com.

P. APO is used for the receipt and dispatch of official mail only.

Q. Mail may not exceed 66 pounds, and size is limited to 42 inches maximum length and 72 inches maximum length and girth combined.

R. All alcoholic beverages, including those mailable under DMM 601.8.0, are prohibited.

R1. Materials used in the production of alcoholic beverages (i.e., distilling material, hops, malts, yeast, etc.) are prohibited.

T. Mailings of case lots of food and supplemental household shipments must be approved by the sender's parent agency prior to mailing.

U. Parcels must weigh less than 16 ounces when addressed to Box R. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped."

U1. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail weighing 13 ounces or less when addressed to Box R. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped." Videotapes are prohibited when addressed to Box R, regardless of weight.

U2. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail letters only when addressed to Box R.

U3. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail correspondence (including voice and video cassettes), newspapers, magazines, photographs, not exceeding 16 ounces, when addressed to Box R.

V. Express Mail Military Service (EMMS) not available from any origin.

V1. Delivery Confirmation service is not available.

W. Meat products, such as dried beef, salami, and sausage, may be mailed, provided they remain in their original, hermetically sealed packages and bear USDA certification. Other meats, bones, skin, hair, feathers, horns or hoofs of hoofed animals, wool samples, tobacco leaves, including chewing and pipe tobacco, snuff, cigars, and cigarettes, or obscene material, including obscene drawings, photographs, films, and carvings, are prohibited. Exception: 200 grams of tobacco per parcel are permitted duty free.

X. Personal mail is limited to First-Class Mail items (to include audio cassettes and voice tapes) weighing 13 ounces or less. This limitation does not apply to official mail.

Y. Mail is limited to First-Class and Priority Mail items only. All Periodicals, Standard Mail items, and Package Services items (including SAM and PAL) are not authorized. This restriction also applies to official mail.

Z. No outside pieces (OSPs).

Z1. The following restriction is applicable only to International Service Centers (ISC)/Exchange Offices. An Anti-Pilferage Seal (Item No O817E or O818A) is required on all pouches and sacks.

On February 17, 2009, in Oxford, Ohio, the Postal Service™ will issue a 27-cent, *Miami University* stamped card (Item 223500). The stamped card, designed by Howard E. Paine, Delaplane, Virginia, goes on sale nationwide February 17, 2009.

Distribution: Item 223500, 27-cent Miami University Stamped Card

The 27-cent; *Miami University* Stamped Card will be distributed nationwide to all Stamp Distribution Offices (SDOs) and to Stamp Fulfillment Services in Kansas City, Missouri.

Initial Supply to Post Offices

SDOs will not make a subsequent automatic distribution to Post Offices. Post Offices requiring quantities of Item 223500 must order them from their designated SDO using a separate PS Form 17, *Stamp Requisition/Stamp Return*. SDOs must not distribute Item 223500 to Post Offices before February 10, 2009.

Philatelic Requirement

Authorized philatelic centers nationwide must be supplied their quantities from the initial automatic distribution made to stamp distribution offices. SDOs must not distribute Item 223500 to philatelic centers before February 10, 2009.

Additional Supply

Post Offices requiring additional quantities of Item 223500 must requisition them from their designated SDO using PS Form 17. SDOs requiring additional quantities must order them from the appropriate accountable paper depository (APD) using PS Form 17.

For fulfilling supplemental orders from SDOs, the Memphis, Chicago, New York, and San Francisco APDs will each receive additional cards. In addition, the Cincinnati, Columbus, Cleveland, and Akron SDOs will receive additional cards for Post Offices in the state of Ohio.

Sales Policy

All Post Offices in the state of Ohio, and authorized philatelic centers nationwide must acquire and maintain a supply of this commemorative stamped card as long as customer demand exists, until inventory is depleted, or until the card is officially withdrawn from sale. If supplies run low, Post Offices must reorder additional quantities using their normal ordering procedures.

As a community service, the Postal Service™ offers pictorial postmarks to commemorate local events celebrated in communities throughout the nation. A list of events for which pictorial postmarks are authorized appears below. If available, the sponsor of the pictorial postmark appears in italics under the date. Also provided are illustrations of those postmarks.

People attending these local events may obtain the postmark in person at the temporary Post Office™ station established there. Those who cannot attend the event but who wish to obtain the postmark may submit a mail order request. Pictorial postmarks are available only for the dates indicated, and *requests must be postmarked no later than 30 days following the requested pictorial postmark date.*


All requests must include a stamped envelope or postcard bearing at least the minimum First-Class Mail® postage. Items submitted for postmark may not include

postage issued after the date of the requested postmark. Such items will be returned unserved.

Customers wishing to obtain a postmark should affix stamps to any envelope or postcard of their choice, address the envelope or postcard to themselves or others, insert a card of postcard thickness in envelopes for sturdiness, and tuck in the flap. Place the envelope or postcard in a larger envelope and address it to: PICTORIAL POSTMARKS, followed by the NAME OF THE STATION, ADDRESS, CITY, STATE, ZIP+4® CODE, as listed below.



How to Order the First Day of Issue Digital Color or Traditional Postmarks

Customers have 60 days to obtain the first day of issue postmarks by mail. They may purchase new stamps at their local Post Office™, by telephone at 800-STAMP-24, or at The Postal Store® Web site at www.usps.com/shop.

Traditional Postmarks

Customers should affix the stamps to envelopes of their choice, address them to themselves or others, or provide a self-addressed return envelope with sufficient postage large enough to accommodate the canceled item. Mail the request to the corresponding city of issuance. There is no charge for the first 50 postmarks. There is a 5-cent charge for each additional postmark over 50. Customers should submit a check, money order, or credit card for payment. After applying the first day of issue postmark, the Postal Service™ will return the envelopes to the customer by U.S. Mail.

All postmark requests should go to the first day of issue city. The first day of issue city Post Office will then forward in bulk all postmark requests to Cancellation Services, Stamp Fulfillment Services, P.O. Box 449992, Kansas City, MO 64144-9992 by respective Post Offices.

Digital Color Postmarks

Only select stamp issues offer a digital color postmark. Customers may submit #6 or #10 envelopes constructed of paper rated as "laser safe." The Postal Service recommends envelopes of 80-pound Accent Opaque, acid-free, 9/16" side seams with no glue on the flap. The maximum

size of all digital color postmarks is 2" high x 4" long. Allow sufficient space on the envelope to accommodate the postmark. Do not use self-adhesive labels for addresses on the envelope. Two test envelopes must be included. There is a minimum of 10 envelopes at 50 cents per postmark required at the time of servicing. Customers should submit a check, money order, or credit card for payment.

The Postal Service reserves the right to not accept hand-painted and other cachet envelopes that are not compatible with our digital color postmark equipment. The Postal Service also reserves the right to substitute traditional black rubber postmarks if use of non-specified envelopes results in poor image quality or damage to equipment.

Customers should affix the stamps to the envelopes and address them to themselves or others for return through the mail. Or, they may include an additional self-addressed return envelope, large enough to accommodate their canceled items, with sufficient postage affixed for return of their postmarked items. Mail the request for a first day of issue digital color postmark to the corresponding city of issuance. Post Offices will then forward all customer requests for digital color postmarks to Cancellation Services, Stamp Fulfillment Services, P.O. Box 449992, Kansas City, MO 64144-9992.

After applying the first day of issue postmark, the Postal Service will return the envelopes to the customer by U.S. Mail.

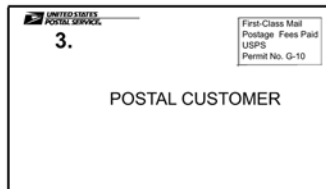
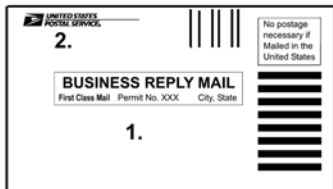
