 units organized for service from the State of Delaware.
 270 Service records consist of a jacket-envelope for each soldier containing
 his name, rank, unit, and card numbers; cards which contain information
 abstracted from muster rolls, regimental returns, descriptive books, and
 other records; and may contain documents such as enlistment papers,
 substitute certificates, casualty sheets, medical descriptions, death
 reports, prisoner-of-war memorandums, and correspondence. Records for
 officers are interfiled with the records of enlisted men. If an individual
 served in more than one unit, there will be a separate service record for
 each unit in which he served. Military units include 1st Battalion Cavalry,
 Milligan's Independent Company Cavalry, Neild's Independent Battery Light
 Artillery, Ahl's Independent Company Heavy Artillery, 1st Infantry (3
 months), and the 1st through 9th Infantry organizations. Also included are
 records for Unassigned Delaware soldiers, Miscellaneous Personal Papers,
 Miscellaneous Enlistment Papers, and Miscellaneous Muster Cards.
