

BEING HAPPY AND THE BALANCE OF LIFE

The great Ari'z"l, (Yitzchok Luria / 16th century) instructed his disciples that Simcha / being happy is one of the prerequisites for attaining mystical illumination. Having gone through the necessary ten days of teshuvah (return) from Rosh Hashanah through Yom Kippur we are ready to begin our engagement with the new year. Since mystical illumination can only take place when we are in a state of happiness & Toy of Sukkos sets our direction on the right course.

Jews who come to the synagogue on Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur get but a partial picture of what Yiddishkeit expects of us. The traditional pounding of the first nail into the Sukkah as soon as the Fast of Yom Kippur is over both literally and figuratively hammers home the point that the Days of Awe must be seen as complementary parts of the whole. The seriousness of Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur is only one side of the whole picture. When Sukkos arrives we go outside to build and to live. These holidays need each other. Our internal work during the Days of Awe is a necessary prerequisite providing us with the spiritual sustenance and energy to live in the physical world. Our prayers on Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur takes place inside in our synagogues. Sukkos takes place outside. On Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur we hold our machzorim (Holiday prayer books). During Sukkos we hold the Lulav, Esrog, Hadasim and Aravos. On Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur we use our internal strength to commit ourselves on being better. During Sukkos we build with our physical strength to create a beautiful Sukkah. On Yom Kippur we fast. On Sukkos we feast. On Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur we are serious and introspective. On Sukkos we are charged to be happy.

The balance of life is an ongoing process in our pursuit of being the type of people we should be. In observing the laws of kashrus the Jew is constantly being challenged before eating his food. He just doesn't grab and eat. He needs to pause and think before eating. May the new year be one where we bring glory to Hashem and to ourselves.

The DK staff, our board of directors join me in wishing you a year filled with blessings, success and good health.

May you be written and sealed for a Shana Tova!




FOODS AND MEANINGS

This is a humanitarian and relocation program that is helping not only a Jewish family or individual with an opportunity to better their lives but helps Dallas kosher establishments by providing much needed qualified mashgichim. This program can change the lives of the individual or family with an opportunity to obtain a green card and become a US citizen. DK is the leading VAAD around the country implementing this program, with our very own Rabbi Sholey Klein, as a panel speaker. Rabbi Klein provides his guidance to other VAAD's at AKO (Association of Kosher Organizations) annual meetings so other VAAD's can benefit and learn from DK about this program. DK has been awarded a matching grant from the JFGD to help support this program, so keep an eye out for future opportunities to help support this very important cause.

On a personal note, this is a bittersweet Newsletter for me. I will be leaving Dallas Kosher at the end of our fiscal year, December 31...with over 7 years as Executive Director. I am grateful for the opportunity to work for Dallas Kosher and serve the Dallas community. My mentor, Jeri Finkelstein, has given me so much inspiration, along with Rabbi Shawel and Rabbi Klein, who all three have no less than 25 years (individual not cumulative) of DK involvement. They have all shown me what it means to serve and provide kosher options to the Dallas Jewish community. Thank you! I have enjoyed getting to know the restaurant owners, caterer owners, who make up a dedicated group of individuals who put their livelihood and talent of creating kosher options for you....the Dallas kosher consumer. I want to also acknowledge how much I admire and appreciate the mashgichim. They are the backbone of the kosher world. These individuals show up day in and day out, wash vegetables, check produce, package, seal orders, open up at 6 am for the deli counter or show up at midnight for a catering event and work over Shabbos, etc for minimum compensation to make sure kosher is available. I want to acknowledge the dedication of our board members who I've known for over 7 years. These individuals volunteer their time, away from their families and other responsibilities to help the Dallas community and DK, Yeshar Koach!.

It has been an honor to be on the DK team. Shanah Tovah U'metukah. May you and your family have a Healthy Sweet New Year in 5784!




