




1 Plug the AC power cord to the power adapter.




2 Plug the AC power cord to a wall socket.




3 Plug the DC cable to your computer.

Common symptoms

Ensure the AC power cord is connected to the adapter and the DC plug is plugged in to the computer. Check if the DC cable LED turns on.
Computer cannot detect the adapter	 Ensure the computer power chargeable. AC power cord is not connected to the wall socket. 	 Ensure that the computer is powered on. Ensure the AC plug is plugged in to a wall socket. Test the adapter in another computer
