By the Chief, Policy and Program Planning Division:

- 1. On November 22, 1995, Southwestern Bell Communications Services, Inc. (SBC) filed a request to be declared a non-dominant, interstate, domestic interexchange services provider to customers of (1) unaffiliated commercial mobile radio services (CMRS) providers, and (2) landline local exchange providers other than Southwestern Bell Telephone Company.
