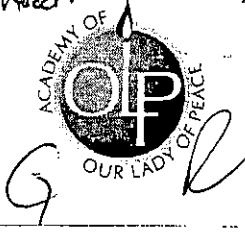

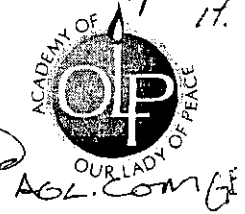

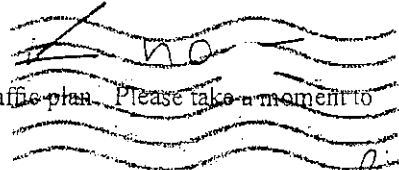

I am writing on behalf of the Bob Baker Family in support of the Academy of Our Lady of Peace's (OLP) plan to modernize its campus.



I have been a tenant at 4777 Hamiton St. for three years.

I am in favor of the application to modernize and expand by OLP. I hope you will decide in their favor to expand and modernize as well.

Parking is the critical issue. It is very limited in our neighborhood. OLP needs adequate parking for their faculty, staff, and students.

When I first moved into the neighborhood in Sept. 2006, I regularly found my vehicle sandwiched in between student's vehicles. On nights OLP held their special events, I would have to park three blocks away.

I understood the students and their families needed to park somewhere, but it was difficult for the residents who are without driveways to find places to park.

When I complained to my then landlord, Mr. David J. Plapp, he responded by informing me OLP had tried to build a parking structure, but was blocked from doing so.

I found that more annoying than having parking challenges.

OLP have been good neighbors. Their school is a handsome structure that is kept beautifully. It is an asset to our neighborhood.

The students are lovely, polite young women. They are very orderly and quiet in going to and from school.

In recent months, OLP instituted men to direct traffic, for the orderly and safe flow of vehicles coming and going before and after school.

OLP had also allowed one of their buildings to be used as a polling place, which demonstrates civic involvement.

The properties OLP has acquired on either side of their complex are 'naturals' for expansion. I have no doubt the additions to their campus will look just as tasteful as their existing buildings and lots.

A house has recently been built on a small piece of property on Copely Ave., one block east of Uvada and Copely. I have never received notices of protest concerning this structure, (though it blocks a view of the valley, and sits very close to the house next to it), as I have received by some disgruntled neighbors concerning OLP.

In conclusion, OLP has been as accomodating and considerate of their neighbors as evidently possible with their current limited space. I urge you therefore, Mr. Schultz, and members of the planning commission to vote in favor of OLP's application to expand and modernize their school.

Thank you for your time in considering my input on this issue, as you hopefully make your decision to grant OLP their request for additional permits to improve their facility.


We are writing to ask that the City of San Diego approve the Modernization Plan and request for amended Conditional Use Permit of The Academy of Our Lady of Peace.

I have been a tenant at 4777 Hamiton St. for three years.

I am in favor of the application to modernize and expand by OLP. I hope you will decide in their favor to expand and modernize as well.

Parking is the critical issue. It is very limited in our neighborhood. OLP needs adequate parking for their faculty, staff, and students.

When I first moved into the neighborhood in Sept. 2006, I regularly found my vehicle sandwiched in between student's vehicles. On nights OLP held their special events, I would have to park three blocks away.

I understood the students and their families needed to park somewhere, but it was difficult for the residents who are without driveways to find places to park.

When I complained to my then landlord, Mr. David J. Plapp, he responded by informing me OLP had tried to build a parking structure, but was blocked from doing so.

I found that more annoying than having parking challenges.

OLP have been good neighbors. Their school is a handsome structure that is kept beautifully. It is an asset to our neighborhood.

The students are lovely, polite young women. They are very orderly and quiet in going to and from school.

In recent months, OLP instituted men to direct traffic, for the orderly and safe flow of vehicles coming and going before and after school.

OLP allows local pet owners to let their dogs run on the small patches of grass in front of their main doors. They have never sent letters of complaint to the community about the effect pet urine has had on their lawn. Nor have they complained about the large dog eliminations that less considerate pet owners allow their dogs to leave on the sidewalks surrounding the OLP campus.

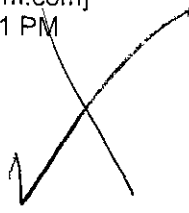


