

Cab Fares in Different Cities.

San Francisco—Population, 233,050. A two-horse conveyance for one or two persons not exceeding one mile, \$1.50, which would cover the distance between most of the passenger depots and the principal hotels; for each additional person, 25 cents; this part being very rarely adhered to. By the hour for four persons or less, \$2 for the first hour and \$1.50 for each subsequent hour. A one-horse cab charges \$1 a mile for one or two persons, and 50 cents for each additional mile. By the hour, \$1.50 for the first and \$1 for each subsequent hour.

New Orleans—Population, 216,000. The "districts" mentioned here correspond to our wards, and average about one mile in distance. One trip within the limits of a district, or from the limits of one to the limits of another, 25 cents a passenger. From the limits of one district to the limits of any of the others, 62½ cents. Rates are double at night.

Newark, N. J.—Population, 136,565. Two-horse hack, one passenger, not over one mile, 40 cents; each additional passenger, 20 cents; exceeding one mile, one passenger, 60 cents; additional passenger, 20 cents; by the day, \$5. One-horse and one-seat vehicle, 75 cents an hour. Two-seat vehicle, \$1 for the first hour and 75 cents for each succeeding hour. Two-horse vehicle, by the hour, \$1.25 for one or more passengers; \$1 for each succeeding hour.

Pittsburg, Penn.—Population, 136,359. Fifty cents for landing one person from any railroad station, hotel, etc. In the first twelve wards the same rate is charged to any other point within such limits.

Chicago—Population, 503,165. The distance between hotels, railroad depots and steamboat landings are computed as not exceeding one mile. Two-horse hacks—one passenger from one depot to another, 50 cents; fare for one passenger not exceeding one mile, 50 cents; over one mile and less than two, \$1; each additional passenger, 50 cents; \$8 a day. By the hour—first hour, \$2 for one or more passengers; additional time at the rate of \$1 per hour; for any distance between the hours of 12 m. and 7 a. m., \$2 for one or more passengers. One-horse cab by the hour—first hour, \$1; additional time at the rate of 50 cents; \$1 per day.

St. Louis—Population, 350,518. Two-horse hack—one or more passengers one mile, \$1; each additional mile, 50 cents; by the hour, \$1.50 for the first hour, and \$1 for each additional. One-horse cab—one or more passengers not exceeding one mile, 50 cents; for the first hour, \$1, and 75 cents for each succeeding hour.

Cincinnati—Population, 255,130. Where no bargain is made the charge shall not be more than 50 cents for each passenger; children half-price.

Boston—Population, 362,830. Hackney coach—within the limits of the city, \$1 for one passenger; 50 cents each for two or more, between 12 m. and 6 a. m., double for one passenger, and 50 cents for each additional.

Buffalo—Population, 155,134. Any distance not exceeding one mile, \$1; each additional mile, 25 cents; every passenger over one and not exceeding two miles, 50 cents; over two miles, every passenger, \$1; by the day, one or more passengers, \$8; by the hour, one or more passengers, \$1.50 an hour.

Providence, R. I.—Population, 164,557. Distances to be measured in straight line according to the map of the city. From one place to another within the city limits, 50 cents a mile; for each additional mile, 25 cents; by the hour, \$2 for the first and \$1.50 for each subsequent hour; children, half-rates.

Rochester, N. Y.—Population, 89,360. To any place in the city, 50 cents for the first mile and 25 cents for each additional mile; distances not exceeding one and one-half miles, 75 cents; each additional passenger, 25 cents; distances of two and one-half miles, \$1; each additional passenger, 50 cents; by the hour, \$1.25 for first and \$1 for each additional, estimated in quarter hours.

Richmond, Va.—Population, 63,600. Distances of ten squares, 50 cents; each additional square, 5 cents; provided the distance to any part of the city shall not exceed \$1; the charge for carrying four persons must not exceed \$1.50 for the first hour and 50 cents for each succeeding hour. After 10 p. m. one-half additional to day rates.

Lowell, Mass.—Population, 59,475. Conveyances by hack from any one point to another in the city, 35 cents; between the hours of 10 p. m. and 5 a. m. not to exceed 50 cents.

Charleston, S. C.—Population, 40,681. Conveyance from or to steamboat landing, hotel, or railroad depot, 75 cents within the city limits; from any one point to another within the city, 75 cents; by the hour, \$2 for the first and \$1 for each succeeding hour.—Eastern Paper.

A Look at the Real Paris.

Not long ago many visitors to Paris returned home full of enthusiasm for that beautiful city, and anxious to see London, New York and Philadelphia and other towns could not be made like the French capital. Now the French themselves are criticizing the municipal administration of Paris, and from the account given of it in a recent number of their leading Review, we can get some useful hints. With a population approaching 2,500,000, less than three-third of the city, for it is a central point for skilled workmen and men of all persuasions from far and near, it is a city with over 1,000,000 separate apartments, and one-third of its working population. While London has more than 200 building associations, with over a 100,000 members, Paris has in its service nearly 1,000 large speculative corporations, which look more to their own profit, and not to the benefit of the city, than do the London companies. A Famous Game of Poker.

From a story by Joel Chandler Harris, "Uncle Remus" in the November number, we quote the following characteristic sketch. The time of the story is before the war. In his own estimation Major Compton was a first-class gambler, and he had down his readiness to test his peach brandy as overgrown country boys who needed to be introduced to some of the arts and sciences he had at his command. Thereupon the Major pitched his cards, figuratively speaking, and became, for the time being, a part and parcel of the innocence that characterized Hillsborough. A wise man would doubtless have made the same mistake. The little village possessed advantages that seemed to be providentially arranged to fit the various enterprises of Major Compton. There was a large, airy, well-ventilated block in front of the stuccoed court-house, if he desired to dispose of a few of his negroes; there was a quiet track laid out to be let on lease, and in order, if he chose to enjoy the pleasures of horse-racing; there were secluded places thickly within easy reach, if he denied to himself the use of the public gaming establishment, and various other well-kept rooms in the second story of the tavern, if he cared to challenge the chances of dice or cards. Major Compton tried them with varying luck until he began his famous game of poker with Judge Alfred Wellington, a stately gentleman with a flowing white beard and mild eyes, who gave the appearance of a benevolent patriarch. The history of the game in which Major Compton and Judge Alfred Wellington took part is something more than a tradition in Hillsborough; for there were living three or four men who sat around the table and watched its progress. It is said that at various stages of the game Major Compton would destroy the cards with which they were playing, and would use a new pack, but the result was always the same. The mild blue eyes of Judge Wellington, with few exceptions, continued to overlook "handicaps" that were winnable—a habit that had acquired during a long and arduous course of training from Saratoga to New Orleans. Major Compton lost his money, and when his body-servant and all his negroes but one, his body-servant. When his misfortune had reached this limit the Major adjourned the game. ELIAS V. WILCOX.

The defendant thereupon took the certificates out of his pocket and handed them back to the plaintiff, and the plaintiff thereupon returned them at the office of the company, and procured a certificate for sixty shares in the plaintiff's name, and the next day it was tendered to the plaintiff, and he refused to receive it, and said he would not take it, and that he would not pay for it.
