Quick Hits

» Georgia's quest to a 10th Southeastern Conference Regular Season Championship starts friday. The Bulldogs finished tied for second last season and haven't finished below that mark since 2006. The last Georgia title came in 2013.

»The Bulldogs dropped their outdoor season opener to then-No. 12 Georgia Tech, now ranked No. 3. The Yellow Jackets obtained the doubles point - a first for a Georgia opponent this season.

»Georgia's first win in the 2018 ITA National Team Indoors against Texas marked milestone victory No. 700 for Georgia head coach Jeff Wallace.

»Jokic is the only freshman in the nation to be ranked in the top 10 in singles and doubles. During the 2017-18 campaign, she has faced five of the nine other players that are currently ranked in the singles top-10. She is 3-0 with two unfinished in those matches.

Georgia Bulldogs Notes Match VIII & IX

»Familiar Foes Start Off SEC Play«

Georgia opens the 2018 Southeastern Conference schedule against LSU and Texas A&M, the two opponents that the Bulldogs ended with for the 2017 campaign. Last season, the Tigers busted Georgia's doubles-point streak of 10 matches in a row, but the Bulldogs won five of the six singles matches. In the regular-season finale, the No. 21 Aggies upset the second-ranked Bulldogs to deny Georgia a share of the SEC regular season title.

»Tiger Scout«

Friday's matchup marks LSU's first match against a top-25 ranked opponent this season. The Tigers' lone loss was a close one (4-3) to Washington in the Duke Regional of the ITA Kick-Off Weekend. The sole senior Ryann Foster plays No. 1 in singles and doubles. The No. 1 singles matchup with Georgia's Katarina Jokic will represent two of the conference's top four No. 1 players as each have a 5-0 dual record - good for third in the SEC.

»Aggie Scout«

Texas A&M opens its SEC schedule against No. 17 Tennessee - also its first ranked opponent - prior to the Sunday's match with the Bulldogs. TAMU's single loss on the season came from Rice. The Aggie lineup is an even split between seniors and freshmen. Leading the squad at No. 1 singles is senior Domenica Gonzalez who sports a SEC-best 10-0 dual record.

» Dawgs in the House«

Georgia wrapped up the Indoor portion of the schedule with a 5-1 record, making their seventh straight trip to the National Indoors. The Bulldogs have made 28 appearances at the ITA National Indoors dating back to 1988, the inaugural year of the tournament.

»Nearly Perfect Doubles«

Georgia has dropped one doubles point among its seven matches in the dual season. The Bulldogs have only lost three doubles matches in that span (11-3, 5 unf.). Eighth-ranked Jokic and Gould have won each of their matches.

»MARTA«

Three matches into the spring's dual season, sophomore Marta Gonzalez tied her freshman total in wins at 19. The Madrid, Spain product currently is 19-7, while finishing last season 19-5.

»Georgia Nabbed to Finish First in SEC«

The Preseason SEC coaches poll has Georgia slotted to finish first in the 2018 season. Each head coach votes with each position corresponding with a point system. Following Georgia (184 points) in the top-five was Florida (174), Vanderbilt (171), South Carolina (140) and Auburn (138).

»Excelling On-and-Off the Court«

Freshman Katarina Jokic, Annette Goulak and Vivian Wolff received Dean's List on the J. Reid Parker Director of Athletics honor roll for Fall of 2017, earning a 3.50 GPA or higher while taking 14 or more credit hours. Seniors Mariana Gould and Laura Patterson also were recognized on the J. Reid Parker Director of Athletics honor roll for the fall term.

Last season, the team was named an ITA All-Academic Team after acheiving a team GPA of over 3.20 which they did with a 3.38. In addition, Elena Christofi, Stephanie Grodecki, Ellen Perez and Laura Patterson were named ITA Scholar-Athletes for having above a 3.50 GPA.

»Georgia Signs Kowalski«

Fresh off a 2017-18 freshman class that drew the No. 1 ranking by the Tennis Recruiting Network, the Bulldogs are adding another Blue Chip Recruit next season. In November, Georgia signed Meg Kowalski, of LeGrange, III., who has been ranked as high as the top-25 in juniors in her career and trains at the Smith Stearns Academy in Hilton Head, S.C.—same as Mariana Gould.

»By the Numbers«

Katarina Jokio's ITA Southeast Regional Singles Championship made it three in a row for Georgia as teammate Elena Christofi (2016) and volunteer coach Caroline Brinson (2015) won in the previous two years.







BULLDOG AWARDS

In the Wallace era, seven Bulldogs have won grand slam titles, two have won the Honda-Broderick Award/tennis, 35 Bulldogs have earned All-America honors 107 times, and 51 different Bulldogs have been listed on the SEC Academic Honor Roll

As the nation's winningest active women's tennis coach, Jeff Wal lace has built the Georgia Bulldogs into one of the elite college programs that both wins and plays host to NCAA Championships. The 2016-17 season welcomed the NCAA Championships once again to Athens and the Dan Magill Tennis Complex.

The 2017 season saw Georgia post another successful season highlighted by a No. 6 ITA final ranking and 19-6 record. Georgia made its 31st consecutive apperance in the NCAA Tournament and four Bulldogs earned five All-America honors.

For the past seven years, Georgia has finished the year ranked in the top eight nationally. In 28 of his 32 seasons at the helm, the Bulldogs have ended the year in the top 10 including No. 1 in 1994 and 2000

A Proven Winner

During his tenure, Wallace's squads have claimed two NCAA championships, three USTA/ITA National Team Indoor titles, eight Southeastern Conference crowns and six SEC Tournament titles. A four-time National Coach of the Year recipient and four-time SEC Coach of the Year, Wallace's career .801 winning percentage is the best among active Division I coaches with a minimum of 500 victories.

Wallace's teams are the picture of consistency. With the 2017 NCAA bid, Georgia has appeared in 31 straight NCAA Tournaments and has advanced to the "Final Four" 11 times. Only once during his time as coach of the Bulldogs has the team missed the NCAA Tournament, and that was his first year back in 1986.

Playing/Coaching Career

A 1985 graduate of the University of Georgia, Wallace capped his playing career under legendary Bulldog head coach Dan Magill in 1984 after winning the SEC singles title at the No. 6 spot. The very next season, his first as coach of the Bulldogs, Wallace led a struggling team up the path of respectability by posting a 20-9 mark and landing a spot in the final Volvo Tennis/ITCA Top 25 poll. In 1987, just two years removed from a losing record, Georgia advanced to the national championship match. Although they didn't win it that year, the Bulldogs would have their day.

NCAA Champions

The 1994 season ranks as one of the most dominant ever in women's tennis history. It found Georgia on the champion's pedestal in every major team tournament possible: NCAA Champions, USTA/ITA National Team Indoor Champions, and SEC regular season and tournament champions. Top that all off with a 27-2 overall record including a perfect 14-0 SEC mark and a season sweep of arch-rival Florida and it's easy to see why Wallace was named coach of the year.

The 2000 Bulldogs went 27-2, winning the Southeastern Conference title and the NCAA National Championship. In the title match on the campus of Pepperdine, Georgia dethroned the defending champion Stanford Cardinal 5-4, snapping a 48-match winning streak. Wallace was named the Wilson/ITA National Coach of the Year.

Drake Bernstein, a two-time ITA Regional Assistant Coach of the Year selection, enters his sixth season with the highly successful Georgia women's tennis program. In this span, the Bulldogs have registered 113 wins, been ranked as high as No. 1 during two of those seasons and No. 2 in the others, and continued their 31-year streak of advancing to the NCAA Championships and developing All-Americans.

In the past two seasons, he assisted the Bulldogs to No. 6 (2017) and No. 7 (2016) final rankings. Each year, Georgia advanced to the quarterfinals of the NCAA Tournament, reached the semifinals of the ITA National Team Indoors and the finals of the 2016 SEC Tournament. Five Bulldogs earned a total of nine All-America honors.

Volunteer Coach Caroline Brinson

Caroline Brinson moves from the playing court to the coaches bench for the 2018 campaign. Brinson finished her Bulldog career in the spring of 2017 with a 92-28 singles record and a 83-38 doubles record.

The New Orleans native early enrolled into Georgia in the spring of 2014 and immediately contributed by helping the Bulldogs cease their seventh SEC Tournament Championship.

In fitting fashion, Brinson finished her career on the Henry Feild courts earning Doubles All-America honors. As a junior, she landed on the All-SEC Second Team.

Off the court, she was named to SEC Community Service team twice and earned the 2017 ITA/Arthur Ashe Leadership and Sportsmanship Award for the Southeast Region. Brinson graduted with a B.S. in Marketing in December of 2017.
