"In Lamb" or "Due to Lamb" means any female sheep carrying a lamb but shall not imply that any lamb due will be born alive

and, where the female sheep is stated to be In Lamb or Due to Lamb to a named ram the Vendor shall provide the Auctioneer with details of the ram, his ear tag number and any breed society registration number together with such, if any, further information that may be required of him, such information to be included in any catalogue for the sale and announced at the sale.

37 Female sheep

37.1 Vendor's warranty

Each female sheep is warranted not to be In Lamb at the time of sale. This warranty is a 14 weeks and 5 Day Warranty.

37.2 Purchaser's rights

If the Purchaser proves a breach of warranty the Vendor shall pay to the Purchaser as Liquidated Damages a sum equal to 33.33 per cent of the purchase price.

Notice of a claim must be supported by a Veterinary Surgeon's Certificate or a slaughter-house manager's or other competent person's certificate confirming the sheep to have been In Lamb for a period of at least 12 weeks on the day of sale.

38 Female sheep not described as In Lamb

38.1 Vendor's warranty

The Vendor warrants that a female sheep not described in any catalogue for sale or at the time of sale as In Lamb is not In Lamb at the time of sale. This warranty is a 14 Week + 5 Day Warranty.

38.2 Purchaser's rights

If the Purchaser proves a breach of warranty then, at the Purchaser's option, either the Purchaser may exercise his rights under Schedule 6, or the Vendor shall pay to the Purchaser as Liquidated Damages a sum equal to the amount in paragraph (i) of the Appendix. Notice of a claim must be supported by a Veterinary Surgeon's Certificate or a slaughterhouse manager's or other competent person's certificate confirming that the sheep was In Lamb

39 Female sheep described as correct**39.1 Vendor's warranty**

The Vendor warrants that all female sheep described in the catalogue or at the time of sale as correct are sound in mouth and udder, that is they are not lacking any of the 8 broad teeth and do not have any damaged or worn teeth or a defective udder. This warranty is a 5 Day Warranty.

39.2 Purchaser's rights

If the Purchaser proves a breach of warranty then, at the Purchaser's option, either the Purchaser may exercise his rights under Schedule 6, or the Vendor shall pay to the Purchaser as Liquidated Damages a sum equal to the amount in paragraph (i) of the Appendix. Notice of a claim must be supported by a Veterinary Surgeon's Certificate.

40 Female sheep proving barren**40.1 Vendor's warranty**

The Vendor warrants that any female sheep sold as being In Lamb is In Lamb at the time of sale. This warranty is a 21 Day Warranty.

40.2 Purchaser's rights

If the Purchaser proves a breach of warranty he may exercise his rights under Schedule 6. Notice of a claim must be supported by a Veterinary Surgeon's Certificate.

41 Ewes with lambs at foot**41.1 Vendor's warranty**

The Vendor warrants that, unless stated to the contrary in any catalogue for the sale or at the time of sale, in a Lot in which the ewes are described as with lamb or with lambs at foot every ewe is suckling one or more lambs, and every lamb has a mother in the Lot. This warranty is a 5 Day Warranty.

41.2 Purchaser's rights

If the Purchaser proves a breach of warranty he may exercise his rights under Schedule 6 in respect of any ewe which does not have a lamb or any motherless lamb.

42 Castrated sheep**42.1 Vendor's warranty**

The Vendor warrants that, unless stated to the contrary in any catalogue for sale or at the time of sale, any male sheep not expressly sold as rams:

a) have been castrated; and

b) have not been imperfectly castrated.

The warranty in Condition 42.1 (a) is an After Sale Warranty and the warranty in Condition 42.1 (b) is a 14 + 5 Day Warranty.

42.2 Purchaser's rights

If the Purchaser proves a breach of warranty then, at the Purchaser's option, either he may exercise his rights under Schedule 6, or the Vendor shall pay to the Purchaser as Liquidated Damages a sum equal to 33.33 per cent of the purchase price of the sheep concerned. If other sheep had been sold in the Lot the compensation payment shall be calculated on the basis of the average price per head of all animals in the Lot.

43 Stock rams

43.1 Vendor's warranty

The Vendor warrants that any ram sold as a stock ram for the amount in paragraph (j) of the Appendix or more is capable of natural service. This warranty is a 10 Week Warranty.

43.2 Purchaser's rights

If the Purchaser proves a breach of warranty the Purchaser may return the ram to the Vendor who shall, at the Purchaser's option, either replace the ram with another ram of equal value which is capable of natural service, or refund the purchase price together with such other costs and charges as the Purchaser may be entitled to under these Conditions.

For the avoidance of any doubt if the Purchaser is able to obtain viable semen from the ram for use by artificial insemination he shall not be entitled to any claim against the Vendor for breach of warranty.

Notice of a claim must be supported by a Veterinary Surgeon's Certificate confirming that:

- a) the ram's inability incapacity or ineffectiveness is not the result of injury, accident or illness happening after the time of the sale; and

The Texel Sheep Society provides enhanced data collection and performance reporting services to its membership and supports the National Terminal Sire Evaluation.

texelplus indexes have been updated, making them simpler to use and understand.

In simple terms: higher value = higher profit per lamb

The texelplus economic indexes support the breed's development with an increased focus on commercial traits and profitability. The **TERMINAL** and **REPLACEMENT INDEXES** reflect the breed's influence on industry. Both are presented as the potential extra profit per lamb born in a commercial setting, compared to the population average.

The **TERMINAL INDEX** supports increased profitability through improving prime lambs and is weighted strongly for meat production. The **REPLACEMENT INDEX** includes additional maternal traits to optimise production of female replacements.

Commercial producers solely producing prime lambs should use the **TERMINAL INDEX** to inform their selection; however, those retaining female replacements should use the **REPLACEMENT INDEX**.

Sub-indexes underpin the indexes to provide more information on the relative values of growth, carcass quality, reproduction, and adult size.

An example

High ranking rams deliver over £6.00 per lamb more than lower-ranking rams. Over a ram's working lifetime, this is easily worth an extra £1,500 per ram; generated through shorter finish times and improved carcass quality.

Trait weighting

Different emphases are given to individual traits between the terminal and replacement indexes. This results in different sub-index values.

Growth sub-index

Captures the benefit from growth using eight-week weight and scan weight information. Faster growth is more advantageous.

Reproduction sub-index

The commercial benefit of lambing ease, litter size and maternal ability. Promotes optimum litter sizes and better mothers.

Carcass sub-index

The value of muscle and fat weight in the carcass. Encourages muscle growth with fat cover.

Adult size sub-index

The benefit of mature size as a replacement ewe. Promotes smaller animals as they require less maintenance.

Accuracy

A measure of accuracy of the index. The higher the number the better.

Ranking

Where the animal ranks compared to the current average animal.

Index values

The sum of the sub-index values and potential profit per lamb born for terminal and replacement production.

INTRODUCTION

Welcome to the 14th Dutch Texel Breeders' Sale with H & H in Carlisle.

This year we are again pleased to welcome new vendors; this provides additional choice for buyers and vendors the chance to sell at the largest auction house in the UK, in an area well known for recognizing the place Dutch Texels have in primestock production.

As we look forward to another successful sale it may be worth remembering that Dutch Texels are not another separate breed originating in Holland. The Netherlands is responsible for several breeds, such as the Zwartbles, - (so difficult to pronounce, but meaning black with a blaze) the Blue Texel, the Dassenkop (Badgerface) and more recently the Dutch Spotted which gained pedigree status in Holland only a few years ago. They all have become highly popular in the UK.

The Dutch Texel is simply the original Texel from which all other types were developed, such as the British Texel and Beltex. Dutch Texels went to France in the 1930s and to South America in the 1950s long before they were imported to the UK in the late 1970s. Right from the start Dutch Texels were registered with British Texels in the Texel Society flock book and no distinctions are made as to their origin. Despite the dominance of the larger framed British Texel a small number of breeders have continued to favour the Dutch type. This sale is for them and an opportunity for breeders to purchase new bloodlines and for producers to buy rams for their commercial flocks.

We thank our auctioneers Harrison & Hetherington for their continued dedication and professionalism and this year's judge Mr. Ian Clough, himself a successful breeder of Dutch Texels for many years.

When loading or unloading livestock handlers must ensure that the dock and vehicle gates are securely fixed so as to prevent the escape of animals.

Traders are responsible for providing and maintaining suitable livestock handling equipment. They should ensure that livestock handlers are fit, experienced in livestock handling and familiar with the livestock in their charge.

Children must not be permitted in any area where they may be at risk from livestock or machinery.

In the case of bulls, during the period when the show/sale is open to visitors, bulls in stalls or pens should not be left unattended. If the handler is temporarily absent, arrangements should be made with another vendor, steward or member of Harrison & Hetherington staff to oversee the bull until the handler returns.

1. The biddings to be regulated by the Auctioneers and the highest bidder, subject to the Vendor's reserve (if any), to be the purchaser.
