The following tables present a summary of the monthly traffic reports of the railways of Canada for the calendar year 1922. They show for each province and for the Dominion as a whole, the total revenue freight traffic of all railways, divided into seventy classes of commodities. The data are also divided to show the quantities of each class, that originated in each province and that terminated in each province, including under originating, freight received from foreign connections, and under terminating, freight delivered to foreign connections.

The tables do not include freight belonging to the railways carrying it or other freight not earning revenue. Freight received from and delivered to foreign connections covers all revenue freight crossing the United States Border by rail, including revenue freight passing through Canada, as between Detroit and Buffalo.
