## News & Notes

- St. John's has won six of its last seven games, including a 15-point victory over Xavier on Wednesday at Carnesecca Arena. Joel Soriano recorded his 1,000th career rebound versus the Musketeers. The 6-foot-11 senior center finished with 18 points, 14 rebounds, six blocks and five assists.
- The Red Storm has not trailed in a game since falling to Boston College on Dec. 10 at Barclays Center. In the last two wins over Fordham and Xavier, the Johnnies allowed just 60.5 points per game while limiting these opponents to shoot 30.3 percent from the field and 15.4 percent from 3-point territory. St. John's also boasts a +7.0 turnover margin and has averaged 7.5 blocks in the last two victories.
- St. John's will look for its first win over a team ranked in the top-5 of the Associated Press Poll since defeating No. 3 Villanova, 70-59, on Feb. 3, 2021 at Carnesecca Arena. The Red Storm has not defeated a top-5 ranked team on the road since Feb. 7, 2018 when St. John's topped No. 1 Villanova, 79-75, at the Wells Fargo Center in Philadelphia.
- Saturday's contest will mark the 28th time Hall of Fame coach Rick Pitino will lead his team into competition against UConn. Pitino's teams have defeated the Huskies nine times in the last 11 meetings. Last season as head coach at Iona, Pitino's Gaels were the only team to hold an advantage at halftime over the Huskies in their NCAA Tournament run to the National Championship. Iona led 39-37 at the break in the First Round before eventually falling 87-63 at MVP Arena in Albany, N.Y.
- The Red Storm checked in at No. 53 in the NCAA's NET Rankings as of Friday. St. John's owns a Quad 1 win over Utah and has gone 6-0 against Quad 3 and Quad 4 opponents.

## About the Series with Connecticut

### Record

St. John's leads 37-31, 32-28 in BIG EAST  
 (19-10 home, 12-18 away, 6-3 neutral)

### Overview

St. John's and Connecticut will meet for the 69th time in a series that dates back to 1951. Original members of the BIG EAST, St. John's split the regular season meetings with the Huskies in 2022-23. In its last trip to the XL Center, St. John's earned an 85-74 victory on Jan. 15, 2023. Joel Soriano paced the Red Storm with 19 points and 13 rebounds.

### Coaches

Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame coach **Rick Pitino** is in his first season at St. John's. He was introduced as the 22nd coach in program history on March 21, 2023, at Madison Square Garden. Pitino owns an 842-296 career record in 36 seasons as a Division I head coach. Pitino has led his teams to 28 postseason appearances with 23 trips to the NCAA Tournament, including seven trips to the Final Four. He is the first coach to lead three different programs to the Final Four and the first coach to lead two different schools to a National Championship (Kentucky - 1996, Louisville - 2013). **Dan Hurley** is in his sixth season leading Connecticut. He owns a 114-57 record with the Huskies and a 265-162 overall record in 14 seasons as a Division I head coach. He led the Huskies 31 wins last season and the 2023 National Championship. Hurley previously served as head coach at Rhode Island (2012-18) and at Wagner (2010-12).

Last Time Out

St. John's 81, Xavier 66  
December 20, 2023  
Queens, N.Y. - Carnesecca Arena

For the second-straight game, St. John's led from start to finish as the Johnnies rolled to an 81-66 victory over Xavier on Wednesday at Carnesecca Arena. Senior center Joel Soriano led the charge with 18 points, 14 rebounds, six blocks and five assists as the Red Storm improved to a perfect 4-0 in Queens this season.

St. John's put forth a dominant defensive effort as the Musketeers shot just 34.9 percent (22-63 FG) from the field and a season-low 19.0 percent (4-21 3FG) from distance. The Red Storm also forced Xavier into 18 turnovers while Soriano set a career-high recording six of the team's eight blocks.

On the offensive end of the floor, the Red Storm had five players score in double figures and shot 46.3 percent (31-67 FG) from the field with seven 3-pointers. The Johnnies also dished out 17 assists while recording 16 second chance points.

Soriano registered his seventh double-double of the season and grabbed the 1,000th rebound of his collegiate career.

Nahiem Alleyne earned his second start of the season and finished with a season-high 15 points, shooting 6-for-11 from the field. The 6-foot-4 guard from Buford, Ga., also grabbed four rebounds and dished out a pair of assists in 33 minutes of action.

St. John's scored the first eight points of the contest and never looked back. Jenkins powered the Red Storm's early surge by scoring seven points while also dishing out an assist for a Glenn Taylor Jr. 3-pointer that put the team up 10-3 less than four minutes into the game.

St. John's would maintain an eight-point advantage, 44-36, by intermission with Ledlum scoring 10 of his 13 points before the break.

St. John's lead quickly grew to double digits in the second half after Ledlum's 3-point jumper jumpstarted a 7-0 run that put the Johnnies on top 51-36 by the 16:39 mark.

The Red Storm led by as many as 20 after going on an 11-3 run capped by a pair of Soriano slams that gave the team a 79-59 advantage by the 2:14 mark to all but seal St. John's sixth win in the last seven games.

## Five Things To Know

- ① St. John's split the regular season series with eventual National Champion Connecticut last season with both teams earning victories on the road. In its last trip to Hartford on Jan. 15, 2023, the Red Storm rallied for an 85-74 victory over the No. 6/7 Huskies at the XL Center. Joel Soriano scored 13 of his team-high 19 points in the second half to snap UConn's 15-game home win streak that dated back to the 2021-22 season. It marked the Red Storm's first road win over a top-10 opponent since defeating No. 10/9 Marquette in Milwaukee on Feb. 5, 2019. It was also the program's first victory over a team ranked No. 6 or better in the AP Poll since downing No. 1 Villanova on Feb. 7, 2018 at Wells Fargo Center in Philadelphia. The Huskies countered with a 95-86 victory on Feb. 25, 2023 at Madison Square Garden. Soriano finished with 12 points and 11 rebounds in the second meeting with Connecticut. The 6-foot-11 center is the only current member of the Red Storm to appear in either of two regular season meetings with UConn last season.
- ② The Red Storm has elevated its defensive efforts since giving up a 10-point second half advantage and allowing Boston College to shoot 56.4 percent in an 86-80 setback on Dec. 10 at Barclays Center. St. John's responded with wire-to-wire victories over Fordham (Dec. 16) and Xavier (Dec. 20), as the Johnnies held both teams to a 30.3 field goal shooting percentage, including a 6-for-39 effort from 3-point territory. The Johnnies have averaged 7.5 steals in the past two games with Chris Ledlum leading the team with 2.0 per contest. St. John's has also averaged 7.5 blocks in these past two victories, as Joel Soriano has swatted 4.5 per contest. On the offensive end of the floor, Soriano (19.0 ppg), Ledlum (12.0 ppg) and Nahiem Alleyne (11.0 ppg) are averaging double figures. The trio has shot 52.5 percent (32-61 FG) from the field and 80.9 percent (17-21 FT) at the free-throw line over the two-game win streak.
- ③ Joel Soriano, who reached the 1,000 career points milestone on Nov. 13 versus Michigan, is approaching additional career marks and he is close to etching his name in the St. John's record book. The 6-foot-11 center is on pace to become the 53rd player in program history and first since Julian Champagne (1,408 points, 2019-22) to score 1,000 career points in a St. John's uniform. He enters Saturday's contest with 892 points in 74 appearances with the Red Storm. Soriano also reached the 1,000-rebound mark for his career with his 14 boards against Xavier on Wednesday. He has pulled down 677 rebounds in his three seasons at St. John's after collecting 326 boards in his first two years at Fordham. As of Dec. 22, Soriano is the program's all-time leader in career field goal percentage, shooting 58.3 percent from the floor, which ranks just ahead of St. John's Hall of Famer Walter Berry (58.1 pct, 1984-86). Soriano sits 25th on the program's career rebounding list and is just four rebounds behind Sir'Dominic Pointer (681, 2011-15). The Yonkers native is on pace to become one of only six players in St. John's history to record 900 or more rebounds, an elite list that includes George Johnson (1,240, 1974-78), Sonny Dove (1,036, 1964-67), Tony Jackson (991, 1958-61), Zendon Hamilton (949, 1994-98) and LeRoy Ellis (927, 1959-62).
- ④ Through 11 games, the Johnnies lead the BIG EAST and rank second in Division I averaging 17.2 offensive rebounds trailing only Texas A&M (17.5), as of Dec. 22. St. John's also ranks third in the nation with a 43.1 offensive rebounding percentage, according to KenPom.com, which measures the possible rebounds that are gathered by the offense. Joel Soriano has led the team's effort on the offensive glass, as the senior has pulled down 4.7 per contest, which ranks third in the nation. Chris Ledlum (3.0) also ranks among the BIG EAST leaders in offensive rebounding checking in fourth. Soriano continues to be a double-double machine with seven this season, which ranks sixth in the Division I. The 6-foot-11 center also stands among the national leaders with 10.8 rebounds per game (7th) and shooting 65.8 percent from the field (13th). As a team, St. John's also ranks top-30 in Division I in blocks (5.6 bpg - 16th), rebounds (41.6 rpg - 28th) and assists per game (17.4 - 28th). Graduate student Daniss Jenkins has been the team's lead facilitator and ranks 22nd in the nation with 5.9 assists per game.
- ⑤ The Red Storm signed three incoming freshmen to National Letters of Intent during the NCAA's Early Signing Period. Consensus four-star recruit Jaiden Glover will make his way to Queens next season. The 6-foot-5 wing from Brooklyn ranks 57th overall and 18th at his position in the Class of 2024 according to On3.com's industry rankings. Glover also played alongside current Red Storm guard Simeon Wilcher during his one season with Roselle Catholic (N.J.) before finishing his high school career at The Patrick School (N.J.). Lefteris Liotopoulos will make his way to St. John's next season after starring on the hardwood in Greece. The 6-foot-5 prospect currently ranks 32nd among shooting guards in the Class of 2024 according to On3.com. Liotopoulos played for Greece's U18 national team at the 2023 FIBA European Championship in Serbia. In seven international matches, Liotopoulos averaged 14.9 points, 5.1 rebounds and 2.7 assists per contest, helping his team advance to the quarterfinal round. Four-star standout Khaman Maker was the third player to officially sign with St. John's. The 7-foot-1 center from Las Vegas currently ranks 80th overall and 13th at his position in the Class of 2024, according to On3.com. Maker shined during the 2023 Nike EYBL Peach Jam with the Oakland Soldiers, ranked second with 2.7 blocks per game while averaging 8.4 rebounds and 6.3 points per contest.

## Scouting Connecticut

- Connecticut had its three-game win streak snapped on Wednesday with a 75-60 setback at Seton Hall in their BIG EAST opener. Tristen Newton led the Huskies with 16 points on 5-of-12 shooting, including a pair of 3-pointers, and grabbed six rebounds. As a team, UConn shot 19.0 percent (4-21 3FG) from distance and committed 17 turnovers in just its second loss of the season.
- The Huskies return to the XL Center for the first time since Nov. 24 when they rolled to a 30-point win over Manhattan. Connecticut is 3-0 in Hartford this season and has averaged 94.7 points shooting 55.4 percent (103-186 FG) from the field at its off-campus home court. Cam Spencer has paced the Huskies in scoring at the XL Center this season as the graduate transfer from Rutgers is averaging 18.3 points. Saturday's contest marks the first of five BIG EAST games for UConn in Hartford this season.
- The Huskies lead the BIG EAST and rank top-20 in Division I in assists (18.2 apg, 17th) and assist-to-turnover ratio (1.7 A/T/O, 9th). Veteran guards Tristen Newton (5.6 apg) and Cam Spencer (3.6 apg) have combined for 50.5 percent of the team's assists this season. Spencer ranks second in the league and 42nd in the nation with a 2.9 assist-to-turnover ratio. Newton stands third in the conference and 28th in Division I in assists per game.
- Connecticut also tops the BIG EAST and ranks top-15 nationally in field goal percentage (50.2 FG pct, 15th) and rebounding margin (+11.1, 13th). Junior forward Samson Johnson has shot a team-best 73.2 percent (30-41 FG) from the field in 12 games off the bench, while sophomore center Donovan Clingan has converted 63.2 percent (67-106 FG) of his field goal attempts. Freshman forward Jaylin Stewart (52.6 pct) and red-shirt sophomore forward Alex Karaban (51.9 pct) are also converting on more than half of their shot attempts.

# RICK PITINO

HEAD COACH - FIRST SEASON AT ST. JOHN'S



One of the winningest coaches in NCAA Division I history, Rick Pitino was named the 22nd head coach in the history of St. John's Men's Basketball program on March 20, 2023.

During his 36 seasons as a collegiate head coach, Pitino has established a stellar reputation for excellence on the court and a dedication to student-athlete academic success. Pitino, who owns a 842-296 career head coaching record, has made 23 NCAA Tournament appearances with five different schools and advanced to the Final Four seven times, a total reached by only six coaches all-time.

Pitino became the first coach to take three different schools to the Final Four and the first coach to win an NCAA Championship at two different schools. With a 54-21 record in the NCAA Tournament, Pitino holds the third-highest winning percentage in NCAA Tournament games (.720) among all active coaches. Off the court, he has served as a charitable benefactor for a broad spectrum of worthy causes, often choosing to do so anonymously.

Prior to leading Iona University to three-straight postseason appearances with two trips to the NCAA Tournament, Pitino served as head coach of the University of Louisville (2001-2017, winning the 2013 NCAA Championship), University of Kentucky (1989-1997, winning the

1996 NCAA Championship), Providence College (1985-1987), Boston University (1978-1983) and Hawaii (last six games, 1975-76).

Pitino's teams have won 14 tournament championships and he owns a collective 55-16 conference tournament record (.774). At Kentucky, his teams posted an incredible 17-1 Southeastern Conference (SEC) tournament mark. His coaching resume also features three BIG EAST Tournament titles while at Louisville in 2009, 2012 and 2013. In addition, Pitino has mentored 29 players who were drafted or have played in the NBA. His 1996 NCAA Championship team at Kentucky featured seven future NBA performers.

Pitino was inducted into the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame in 2013, a tribute to a lifetime of impressive basketball achievement.

Over the last three seasons as head coach at Iona University, Pitino led the Gaels to a 64-22 overall record with a 40-9 mark in the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAAC). A two-time MAAC Coach of the Year, Pitino led the Gaels to a pair of MAAC regular season titles and two tournament championships. Iona made trips to the NCAA Tournament in 2021 and 2023 while earning a berth in the National Invitation Tournament (NIT) in 2022.

Pitino spent 16 seasons as head coach at Louisville and led the Cardinals to a 416-143 overall record from 2001-2017. While at Louisville, he took the Cards to the NCAA Tournament 13 times, making seven Sweet 16 appearances, six trips to the Elite Eight, three Final Fours

and a National Championship. Louisville set a school record with 35 wins in its national championship campaign in 2012-13.

For three and a half years prior to Louisville, Pitino served as president and head coach of the NBA's Boston Celtics. He also spent four years coaching the New York Knicks, beginning as an assistant coach under Hubie Brown from 1983-85 before returning to serve as head coach from 1987-89. During the 1988-89 season, the Knicks won 52 games and swept the Philadelphia 76ers in the first round of the NBA Playoffs.

From 1989-97, Pitino served as the head coach at Kentucky, guiding the Wildcats to three NCAA Final Four appearances in his last five years. The Wildcats posted a 219-50 overall record (.814) under Pitino, winning the 1996 NCAA Championship and reaching the national title game in 1997.

Pitino, 71, got his start in coaching as a graduate assistant at Hawai'i in 1974 and served as a full-time assistant there in 1975-76 before a brief six-game stint as head coach prior to season's end. He served two seasons as an assistant coach at Syracuse from 1976-78, before earning his first head coaching job at Boston University in 1978. Pitino produced a 91-51 record in five years at BU, departing as the most successful coach in program history. In his final season, he guided the Terriers to their first NCAA Tournament appearance in 24 years.

After his two years as an assistant with the New York Knicks, Pitino was the head coach at Providence College for two seasons from 1985-87, producing a 42-23 record with the Friars. He guided Providence to an NCAA Tournament appearance in 1986, followed by a trip to the Final Four in 1987.

Pitino also has international coaching experience, leading the Puerto Rico national team in three 2015 summer competitions and Panathinaikos B.C. in the EuroLeague from 2018-20.

Pitino is a 1974 graduate of Massachusetts, where he was a standout guard for the Minutemen's basketball team.

Born Sept. 18, 1952, Pitino is a native of New York City where he was a standout guard for St. Dominic High School in Oyster Bay, Long Island from 1966-70.

Pitino and his wife Joanne have five children, Michael, Christopher, Richard, Ryan and Jacqueline, and 14 grandchildren.

- Introduced as 22nd Head Coach in St. John's Basketball history on March 21, 2023 at Madison Square Garden
- Inducted into the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame as a member of the Class of 2013
- Has led his teams to 28 postseason appearances, including 23 trips to the NCAA Tournament with five different schools
- The first coach to lead two different schools to a National Championship, winning the 1996 title at Kentucky and the 2013 title at Louisville
- The first coach to lead three different programs to the Final Four - Providence (1987), Kentucky (1993, 1996, 1997) and Louisville (2005, 2012, 2013)
- One of just six coaches to advance to the Final Four seven or more times (Mike Krzyzewski, John Wooden, Dean Smith, Roy Williams, Tom Izzo)
- Ranks first among active Division I head coaches and the ninth winningest coach all-time with 842 career victories
