### TELEVISION COVERAGE

Friday's game is being televised live by ESPN with Dave Lamont on play-by-play, Mack Brown on color and Jen Lada on the sidelines.

### RADIO COVERAGE

The UConn IMG Sports Network is the home of Husky football on the radio. WTIC Newstalk 1080 in Hartford serves as the flagship station and is the state's only 50,000 watt signal and can be heard in 23 states and parts of Canada. The 2017-18 year marks the 26th consecutive season that WTIC is the flagship for UConn sports. The 2017-18 football, men's and women's basketball and men's ice hockey seasons also marks the fifth year that the radio rights are held by IMG College, which is UConn's multi-media rights partner.

Veteran UConn play-by-play announcer Joe D'Ambrosio is calling Husky games for the 26th season while Wayne Norman, who is celebrating his 50th year in broadcasting this year, in on color. Ken Sweitzer is back for his second season as the sideline reporter. Sweitzer was the 1981 Yankee Conference Offensive Player of the Year for the Huskies as a quarterback and earned All-Yankee Conference honors five times at three different positions during his career. Anthony "Rex" McCalla is on production

Other affiliates for UConn football on the UConn IMG Sports Network include longtime affiliate WILI 1400-AM (95.3-FM) in Willimantic in addition to WAVZ 1300-AM in New Haven and WGCH 1490-AM in Greenwich. The UConn vs. Memphis game will also be available on Sirius Channel 84, XM Channel 84 and 84 on the internet.

### UConn vs. MEMPHIS HISTORY

Friday's game will be just the third meeting between the two schools and the first meeting since 2014. The home team has won both matchups.

On Nov. 29, 2014 Paxton Lynch threw for four touchdowns for the Tigers and Memphis ran away with a 41-10 victory at the Liberty Bowl. Tim Boyle threw his first career touchdown pass to Arkeel Newsome.

The Huskies topped the Tigers 45-10 on December 7, 2013 at Rentschler Field. UConn QB Casey Cochran threw for a school record 461 yards in the game for four touchdown. Cochran was 36 of 54 in the air and did not throw an interception. UConn WR Jeremy Davis also had a record-setting day with a school single-game best 15 receptions to go along with 207 yards and a TD. UConn had 537 yards of total offense on the day, while limiting the Tigers to 257. Husky S Obi Melinfonwu led UConn with nine tackles.

### UConn IN THE AMERICAN

UConn has a record of 9-25 against American Conference opponents since the creation of the league in 2014. The Huskies are in the midst of their longest conference losing streak since joining the league (7 games). The current losing streak is also the longest for the Huskies since joining the Big East Conference in 2004. UConn was picked at the beginning of the season to finish sixth in The American Conference East Division.

### Quick Hits

- UConn and Memphis face off for the third time in program history. Casey Cochran threw for program record 461 yards during matchup in 2013.
- Huskies are seeking to end a seven-game conference losing streak, the longest since joining the Big East in 2004.
- Bryant Shirreffs ranks fourth in the country in passing efficiency at 182.32. He also ranks in the top-40 in passing TD's, passing yards and completion percentage.



## HURRICANE IRMA FORCES SCHEDULE CHANGES

UConn and USF were scheduled to play their first conference game of the season Saturday, Sept. 9. The American Athletic Conference announced changes to the league schedule on Thursday, September 14 with the Huskies playing East Carolina on Sunday, Sept. 24. The USF game will now be played on Nov. 4 in East Hartford. The ECU game was the first Sunday game since they played on, Nov 23, 2008 at USF.

## UConn JOINING CFB AIR RAID CULTURE

The UConn offense has developed this season into a passing offense that many programs have transitioned to over the last few seasons. The Huskies have already reaped the benefits with career games being set in the passing game. Bryant Shirreffs has set career-highs in passing yards the past two games. Against ECU, Shirreffs passed for 406 yards and three touchdowns and followed it up against the Mustangs with a career-high 408 yards and a pair of touchdown passes.

Bryant Shirreffs is the first UConn QB to ever record back to back 400-yard passing games and only the second to register two in the same season. Cornelius Benton had two in 1991, but not consecutive. There have only been seven 400-yard passing games in UConn history, accomplished by four QB's. Casey Cochran holds the UConn record at 461 vs. Memphis in 2013.

The 596 yards of total offense vs. ECU was the third-most for the Huskies and most since Sept. 10, 2005 vs. Liberty when the Huskies put up 600 yards of offense against the Flames.

UConn had a pair of receivers total 100 yards or more in a single game (Newsome and Donaldson) for the first time since Dec. 7, 2013 vs. Memphis (Jeremy Davis and Deshonn Foxx).

For the first time in program history the Huskies have four wide receivers with at least one 100-yard receiving game. The Huskies most recently had three 100-yard receivers in 2011 but since 100-yard games were recorded in 1970 there has never been more than three Huskies to each have a 100-yard effort.

UConn receivers already have compiled 92 receptions on the season, averaging 23 catches per game. In 2016, the Huskies averaged 17.75 catches per game and totaled 213 at season's end. The Huskies only had three receivers with 20 catches or more last year. Seven UConn receivers are on pace to record 20 or more receptions in 2017.

## PUTTING UP POINTS

The UConn offense has been able to put points on the board this season with 111 points scored in four games. Last season the Huskies totaled 178 points scored. UConn has already scored 27 points or more three times this season. An occurrence that only happened once for the Huskies in 2016.

## ROAD WOES

The Huskies have now lost their last nine games away from Pratt & Whitney Stadium. Their last win came at Tulane on Nov. 7, 2015, 7-3. With Aaron McLean's first quarter TD catch the Huskies snapped a four-game stretch in which they did not score a first half touchdown on the road.

## NEW HUSKY AT THE TOP

Senior running back Arkeel Newsome set new records as a pass-catching running back against ECU. The Ansonia native eclipsed 1,000 receiving yards mark, becoming the first UConn running back to reach the feat. Newsome also passed Joe Markus record of 91 career receptions (1979-82) for a running back with his eight receptions against ECU. He is now four catches away from the century mark.

Senior running back Arkeel Newsome ranks third all-time in all purpose yards in his UConn career with 4498. Against ECU Newsome passed UConn great Jordan Todman (4386). Tory Taylor (5296) and Joe Markus (4813) are the only remaining Huskies ahead of Newsome.

## SHIRREFFS CLIMBING CAREER CHARTS AS A HUSKY

Redshirt senior quarterback Bryant Shirreffs became the fifth UConn player to reach 5,000 total yards in his UConn career with 6,153 yards. Dan Orlovsky (10,421), Matt DeGennaro (9269), Shane Stafford (8829) and Ken Sweitzer (6126) are the four other Huskies to reach the 5,000 yard plateau. The redshirt senior continues to climb the charts in multiple career categories. Shirreffs ranks in the top-10 in many quarterback categories including completions (407, 4th), yards (5253, 4th), touchdown passes (24, T7th), and passing efficiency (134.05, 2nd).

## NEWCOMERS CONTRIBUTING IN BIG WAY

Nearly 50 percent of the Huskies total yards on offense and 48.6 percent of the scoring can be attributed to newcomers. Most recently, Mason Donaldson and Kevin Mensah had big games for the Huskies. Donaldson posted 108 yards on six catches and caught two touchdown passes.

Mensah followed with his first career 100-yard rushing game with 107 yards on the ground. Six of the seven rushing touchdowns have come from the young blood of Nate Hopkins (5) and Mensah (1).

## TWICE AS NICE

Hergy Mayala continued his hot stretch to open the season with a two-touchdown performance against Virginia. Mayala became the first Husky since Noel Thomas on Nov. 21, 2015 to haul in two touchdown receptions. After zero touchdown catches his first two seasons, Mayala has recorded three in first two games of 2017.



## MENSAH IMPRESSES IN SECOND HALF DEBUT

Freshman running back Kevin Mensah played in his first career game against Virginia. The Worcester, Mass. native rushed for 48 yards and broke off a 30-yard touchdown run late in the fourth quarter to punctuate his Husky debut.

## QUITE A DEBUT FOR HOPKINS

Redshirt freshman Nate Hopkins rushed for 130 yards and three touchdowns in his UConn debut. Hopkins became the first player since Lyle McCombs on September 3, 2011 against Fordham to rush for over 100 yards and score three touchdowns or more in his first game in a UConn uniform. Against Fordham, McCombs rushed for 141 yards and four scores. The feat earned Hopkins a spot on the American Conference Weekly Honor Roll.

## CAREER NIGHT FOR HERGY

Junior wide receiver Hergy Mayala set a new career-high with 106 receiving yards and caught his first career touchdown to give UConn a 21-20 lead against Holy Cross. Mayala's previous high for receiving yards came on Sept. 29, 2016 against Houston, hauling in 92 yards.

## 100 ON THE GROUND AND THROUGH THE AIR

The Huskies received 100-yard performances from running back Nate Hopkins and wide receiver Hergy Mayala against Holy Cross. It was the first time the Huskies have had a 100-yard rushed and receiver in the same game since Oct. 22, 2016 against UCF (Arkeel Newsome, Noel Thomas).

## HUSKY COMEBACK

The Huskies overcame a 20-7 halftime deficit on opening night to defeat Holy Cross 27-20. For UConn, the 13-point second half comeback was the largest comeback since Nov. 23, 2013 at Temple. The Huskies overcame a 21-0 halftime deficit to win 28-21.

## FIRST ONE OUT OF THE WAY

Many new faces have played for the Huskies early on this season. Darrian Beavers, Tre Bell, Brayden Brown, Garrison Burnett, Kyle Buss, Tyler Coyle, Cam DeGeorge, Keyion Dixon, Mason Donaldson, Omar Fortt, AJ Garson, Brett Graham, Eddie Hahn, Tajh Herring-Wilson, Nate Hopkins, David Pindell, Jay Rose, Quayvon Skanes, Santana Sterling, Jordan Swann, Ryan Van Demark all played in the season opener. Against Virginia, Noel Brouse, Brian Keating, Kevin Mensah and Ian Swenson made first career starts. Kyle Buss and Connor Freeborn debut's came in the ECU game.

## FATUKASI NAMED TO WATCH LISTS

UConn redshirt senior defensive lineman Foley Fatukasi has been named to three watch lists; the Wuerffel Trophy, Outland Trophy and the Bronko Nagurski Trophy.

The Wuerffel Trophy is college football's premier award for community service and is presented to the FBS player that best combines exemplary community service with athletic and academic achievement. Semifinalists will be announced November 2 and finalists November 22. The 2017 recipient will be selected on December 5 at the National Football Foundation's press conference in New York City.

The Outland Trophy is awarded to the top interior linemen in FBS. Semifinalists are announced on Wednesday, Nov. 15 and finalists on Nov. 21. The Outland Trophy will be awarded on Dec. 7 at The Home Depot College Football Awards. The Bronko Nagurski Trophy honors the best defensive player in college football. Finalists are revealed on Thursday, Nov. 16.



Fatukasi recorded 43 tackles in his junior season, including 3 sacks and 2.5 tackles for loss in 12 games started for the Huskies.

## FOUR OTHERS ON WATCH LISTS

In addition to Fatukasi, four other Huskies were named to watch lists this preseason – senior linebacker Junior Joseph for Butkus Award, senior tight end Alec Bloom for the John Mackey Award, redshirt senior quarterback Bryant Shirreffs for the Johnny Unitas Golden Arm Award.

Senior linebacker Vontae Diggs has been nominated for the 2017 Allstate AFCA Good Works Team, one of the most prestigious off-the-field honors in college football. Players nominated have demonstrated that they are actively involved in a charitable organization or service group while maintaining a strong academic standing.

## THE UCONN FOOTBALL COACH'S RADIO SHOW

## HUSKIES SET TO PLAY AT FENWAY PARK

The University of Connecticut, in partnership with the Fenway Sports Management Group, is proud to announce that the Huskies will face Boston College at Fenway Park on November 18, 2017.

This game is being played as a part of a series of "Football at Fenway" games matching several New England institutions and was originally scheduled to be played at Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field in East Hartford on the same date.

"I think this is a great opportunity for our team, to play a quality opponent, New England rival and in such a unique and famous setting," said UConn Head Coach Randy Edsall. "When David said that this was a possibility, I immediately thought about it being a once in a lifetime game day experience for our team, staff and fans."

## THE STADIUM

The Huskies moved into Rentschler Field in East Hartford for the 2003 season as UConn enters its 14th season of play there on Thursday. The stadium officially became known as Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field in 2015.

Located within miles of Interstates 91, 84 and 384, the home of the Huskies lies on 75 acres of land donated to the State of Connecticut from the historic Pratt & Whitney Airfield. The stadium, like the former airfield, was originally named for that company's founder, Frederick Rentschler. The stadium boasts a capacity of 40,000 with 38 luxury suites.

UConn has an all-time record of 61-36 at Rentschler Field and a 34-15 mark in non-conference games. UConn has played to 84.5-pct. of capacity all-time there, drawing 3,280,679 fans, or an average of 33,821 per game. UConn set a new all-time single-game attendance record at Rentschler Field on Sept. 21, 2013 against Michigan with a crowd of 42,704. That capacity was achieved with extra bleachers brought in for that game. Last time out against ECU the Huskies had a record-low crowd at Pratt and Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field with an announced attendance of 14,036.

EAST HARTFORD, Conn. (AP) Randy Edsall got another chance to coach UConn on Thursday night and Bryant Shirreffs got another chance to quarterback the Huskies.

It worked out for both of them.

Shirreffs came off the bench to lead UConn on three second-half scoring drives and the Huskies came from behind to beat Holy Cross 27-20 as Edsall began his second stint as head coach.

"It was great to be back here, but it's not about me," Edsall said.

Sophomore running back Nate Hopkins ran for 130 yards and three touchdowns in his UConn debut and receiver Hergy Mayala caught nine balls for 106 yards and a score.

Fifth-year senior Peter Pujals threw for 358 yards and a touchdown for Holy Cross, from the Football Championship Subdivision, which led 20-7 late in the third quarter.

That's when Shirreffs replaced David Pindell, a junior college transfer who could not get the Husky offense going despite throwing for 154 yards.

"I think it helps that I have some experience," said Shirreffs, a fifth-year senior who lost his starting job late last season. "I know the guys and I've played with most of the guys and I've been in the environment before. But really what it came down to is that I prepared for this game than I did any other game in the past."

He immediately led UConn on a five-play, 53-yard touchdown drive, capped by Hopkins' 3-yard run.

The Huskies got the lead back at 21-20 on an 11-yard pass from Shirreffs to Mayala in the front left corner of the end zone to complete a 59-yard fourth-quarter drive. The final score came after defensive back Tre Bell knocked the ball out of the arms of Holy Cross receiver Blaise Bell. UConn drove 47 yards and Hopkins punched the ball in from a yard out.

UConn's defense ended a late Crusaders' scoring threat, stopping a Pujals run on fourth down at the UConn 15.

Bell caught 10 passes for 129 yards and a touchdown for Holy Cross.

CHARLOTTESVILLE, Va. (AP) Kurt Benkert passed for a school-record breaking 455 yards and Virginia avenged a heartbreak loss last season with a 38-18 victory over UConn on Saturday.

The Cavaliers (2-1) jumped out to a 24-0 halftime lead and never looked back. Kurt Benkert, a fifth-year senior, broke his own passing record of 421 yards set last season against Central Michigan with a 73-yard touchdown pass to Andre Levrone in the middle of the fourth quarter. Levrone finished with a career-high 127 yards on four catches.

The Huskies offense struggled to keep pace with the constant pressure of the Virginia front early. UConn (1-1) went 1 of 4 on red zone possessions - including two turnovers and a turnover-on-downs.

The UConn defense allowed three Cavalier receivers to rack up 100 yards or more. A feat that hadn't occurred since Oct. 1, 2011 vs. Western Michigan. Virginia was able to muster 626 yards against the Huskies.

UConn finally got on the scoreboard with Bryant Shirreffs' 60-yard touchdown pass to Hergy Mayala in the third. Mayala finished with two catches - both touchdowns - for 77 yards. He is the first Husky to catch two touchdown passes in a game since Noel Thomas vs. Houston on Nov. 21, 2015 vs. Houston.

Kevin Mensah rushed for a 30-yard touchdown late in the fourth quarter, his first touchdown of his career.

UConn will host East Carolina in its first of five straight American Conference matchups.

EAST HARTFORD - The offense that the UConn football team has been expecting arrived at Pratt & Whitney Stadium Sunday --- by air mail.

Despite the disappointment of a 41-38 loss to ECU, the Huskies produced some of their most impressive passing statistics in years --- 406 yards by quarterback Bryant Shirreffs, the most by a UConn QB in four years; two receivers each with 100 yards, for the first time in four years; seven different receivers catching at least one pass, without top pass-catcher Hergy Mayala, who left the game early with an ankle injury; and three TD passes, including a 79-yarder.

Added to the Huskies' 190 rushing yards, the 596 total yards are the most production by a UConn team in 12 years.

While nothing takes away the sting of an American Athletic Conference loss, the offensive output is clearly something to build upon with nine games still remaining in the season. And if UConn can count on the weapons that were unveiled in the passing game Sunday, opposing defenses have a couple of added headaches --- namely senior running back Arkeel Newsome and redshirt freshman wideout Mason Donaldson.

Newsome's versatility as both a runner and a receiver has long been a bonus for the Huskies, but Sunday he set new standards as a pass-catcher with a career-high 170 yards and a 79-yard TD catch, escaping from a seemingly-impossible situation of four ECU defenders converging on him on the sideline. He is the first UConn running back to gain over 1,000 yards receiving and his 94 catches are a Husky record for a running back.

Count on the Ansonia native to be even more involved in the passing game.

"We evaluate every day and we're learning about guys - what they can do and what they can't do," UConn Coach Randy Edsall said. "As things unfolded, we felt we knew what he could do and now we want to accentuate the strengths. He did a good job of doing his job and executing his assignments. He made good runs. That's what we have to do, find out how we can get guys in the best possible position to make plays."

Newsome is embracing what might be a role that gives him more room to work on the field.

"It was definitely a little different today," Newsome said. "That's what coach told me to get ready for, to get out and hopefully make plays and that's what happened. We'll talk and roles can change, but whatever role they give me, I'm going to give it my all."

Which pretty much describes the attitude of Donaldson, who has worked his way from a fringe player on the special teams to a stunning performance Sunday, six receptions for 108 yards and two touchdowns.

"Donaldson is a guy who listens and understands what's being said," Edsall said. "He worked to get his opportunity. He came from being a guy who you didn't think was going to play much, in any phase, but we put him in because we saw how hard he was working. We put him on kickoff return and he aceed that. By doing that, we incorporated him into even more special teams because of getting his job done."

"We went into this week thinking he was going to alternate with Hergy because of the work he was doing and the productivity that he was showing. When Hergy went down, it didn't surprise me that he went in and performed the way he did. That's what I've been seeing."

"He's a great example to the other members of his teams - to guys who haven't gotten at opportunity yet. If they want that opportunity, all they have to do is look at that guy and how he earned it. And then when he earned that opportunity, he took advantage of it."

Donaldson is far too young to know of Wally Pipp, the New York Yankees' first baseman who took a day off, only to be replaced by Lou Gehrig for the next 2,130 games. Maya is not Pipp, and Donaldson is not Gehrig, but the receiver from Allentown, Pa., has obviously made himself part of the Huskies' offensive equation.

"I really just tried to work hard on the field and off the field, and worked my way as the backup to Hergy," Donaldson said. "When Hergy went down, we work by the motto, that next guy's got to hop in and do the same role."

DALLAS (AP) Ben Hicks passed for 280 yards and four touchdowns on Saturday and SMU pulled away with three fourth-quarter touchdowns to beat Connecticut 49-28.

The Mustangs (4-1, 1-0 American) took the lead for good at 35-28 on Hicks' 34-yard touchdown pass to Courtland Sutton with 11:46 left. SMU's Ryan Becker blocked Brett Graham's punt on UConn's next possession and Ke'Mon Freeman's 3-yard run made it 42-28. The Huskies (1-3, 0-2) then turned it over on downs deep in their own territory and Braeden West's 25-yard run capped the scoring on the next play.

Trey Quinn caught 15 passes for 116 yards and two TDs and Sutton finished with seven catches for 112 yards and two scores for SMU.

UConn trailed 21-10 at halftime but cut the deficit to one with 10-straight third-quarter points and tied it at 28 early in the fourth.

Bryant Shirreffs passed for 408 yards and two TDs for the Huskies but was sacked eight times.
