Northwest has not lost a matchup with the Northeastern State RiverHawks in 12 games in the all-time series between the two programs. In the 10 matchups between the Bearcats and RiverHawks since Northeastern State joined the MIAA, Northwest has enjoyed an average winning margin of 46.5 points per game. Northwest has scored at least 36 points in each of the last 10 games with the RiverHawks. NSU's high point total against Northwest came in a 74-29 loss on Oct. 15, 2016.

HARRIS LEADS MIAA IN RUSHING, ALL-PURPOSE YARDS; RANKS NO. 2 IN NATION IN RUSHING

Jay Harris leads the MIAA in rushing yards (1,193), rushing yards per game (132.6), all-purpose yards (1,222) and all-purpose yards per game (135.8). Harris ranks T-No. 2 in the nation in rushing yards. Harris ranks T-No. 2 in the nation in rushing yards per game.

A MIGHTY FINE STREAK OF NINE FOR HARRIS

Sophomore running back Jay Harris moved his consecutive games of rushing for 100 yards or more to nine in a row with a 123-yard effort against Washburn. Former Northwest running back Xavier Omon put together a streak of 13 consecutive 100-yard rushing games in 2006 and 2007. Omon rushed for 100 or more yards in the last four games of the 2006 season and in the first nine games of the 2007 season. Omon completed his Bearcat career with 40 100-yard rushing games and a program-best 7,073 rushing yards. No Bearcat has ever rushed for 100 yards in every game of a season.

YOUNG HITS ON HIS OWN 100-YARD GAME

Sophomore running back Tank Young tallied his first career 100-yard rushing game with 109 yards on only 12 carries against Washburn. Young had a long carry of 35 yards and averaged 9.1 yards per carry vs. the Ichabods. Young has now posted a 100-yard receiving game and a 100-yard rushing game this year. Young was credited with 102 receiving yards in a win at Missouri Western.

ONE MORE WIN TO ENSURE 28 STRAIGHT WINNING SEASONS

With its next victory this season, the Bearcat football program will have clinched its 28th straight winning seasons. Northwest's run of 27 straight winning seasons is the longest active streak among NCAA Division II programs. Practice

All practice sessions are open to media and public unless otherwise posted. On days when post-practice interviews are conducted, media may gather and view the final 20-30 minutes of practice before the workout is complete. Media members wishing to film practice must contact the Media Relations office two days prior to coming to practice. All media must wear issued credentials to practice to film or take pictures.

Credentials

Media credentials should be requested via e-mail at least one week in advance of game and will be mailed if time permits. Otherwise, credentials can be picked up at the Media Will Call at the base of the middle elevator shaft on the press box side of Bearcat Stadium on game day. Media Will Call opens two and half hours prior to game time. Media seating is limited, so credentials will be issued according to the following protocol:

1. Local newspapers, wire services, national publications and newspapers regularly covering the Bearcats and opponent.
2. Other daily newspapers with a preference to those covering the Bearcats on a regular basis.
3. Radio and television personnel reporting but not broadcasting.
4. Scouts from professional teams.
5. Non-daily publications with a preference to those covering the Bearcats on a regular basis.
6. Magazines and newsletters focusing primarily on one team with a preference to those covering the Bearcats on a regular basis.

Game Day Interviews

Northwest's locker room is closed to the media at home and on the road. For NCAA playoff games, the non-advancing coach and players will be available first followed by the advancing team and coach. Any individuals selected for postgame press conference cannot do any other interviews prior to press conference.

Photographers

Photo credentials should be requested in the same manner as regular media credentials. Camera persons must stay out of the team area on both sidelines or they will be escorted from the stadium. Photo credentials will be issued according to the following protocol:

1. Local newspapers, wire services, national publications, local TV stations regularly covering the Bearcats and/or the opponent.
2. Other daily newspapers and television stations with preference to those covering Northwest on a regular basis.
3. Non-daily newspapers and other publications with a preference to those covering Northwest on a regular basis.

RARE FOUR-LOSS SEASON

Northwest has posted a winning season in 27 straight seasons and this year marks only the fourth time in that stretch that Northwest has lost four or more games.

Northwest went 6-5 in 1995, 7-4 in 2001 and 11-4 in 2005.

The Bearcats sit at 5-4 with two games remaining in the 2023 season.

Northwest has suffered four MIAA losses for the first time since the 1994 season when the Bearcats went 0-9 in league play. It is only the 19th time in program history that Northwest has lost four or more MIAA games in a season.

58TH TIME OF 50 OR MORE

Northwest has scored 50 or more points in a game 58 times in the history of the program. Northwest scored 52 points in Saturday's 52-21 win at Washburn.

It is the 14th time Northwest has scored 50 or more points since head coach Rich Wright took over in 2017.

HALFTIME LEADS ARE SECURE

Northwest is a perfect 50-0 under head coach Rich Wright when the Bearcats lead at the half.

Northwest has won 78 straight games when leading the half.

The last time Northwest lost a game it led at the half came Nov. 22, 2014, in an NCAA playoff game

In his third career start, Olesen recorded a sack on Northwest's first defensive play of the game. He added an interception on Washburn's fifth offensive play of the game.

KEEPING JAY'S STREAK STRAIGHT

Running back Jay Harris surpassed the 100-yard mark again with another 123-yard performance in a 52-31 win at Washburn.

Harris also had a 123-yard

effort in a 28-7 loss at home to Pittsburg State.

Harris eclipsed the 100-yard rushing mark with a 105-yard effort in a 27-23 win at Missouri Western.

Harris went for a career-high 274 yards and tallied four touchdowns in a 34-21 win over Central Oklahoma.

Harris rushed for 131 yards in week one at Missouri Southern. He came back with 120 yards rushing against Emporia State. Harris added 104 rushing yards at Fort Hays State. Harris totaled 105 yards vs. Lincoln. Harris gained 108 rushing yards against Central Missouri

Harris has carried the ball 198 times for 1,193 rushing yards. He also leads the Bearcats with 12 rushing touchdowns.

Harris has totaled 1,579 career rushing yards with 21 career rushing touchdowns in 17 games as a Bearcat.

Harris is the only running back in the country (all NCAA divisions) to begin the 2023 season with nine consecutive 100-yard rushing games. Harris is one of three players to have rushed for 100 yards in every game played this season - Jhequay Chretien (Aurora - NCAA Div. III) with six games and Jordan Embry (St. Olaf - NCAA Div. III) with seven games.

Sophomore running back Jay Harris tied for the fifth-highest single game rushing total in program history against Central Oklahoma. Harris carried the ball 22 times for 274 yards and four touchdowns in a 34-21 victory over the Bronchos.

His 274-yard effort ranks as the second-best NCAA Div. II single-game rushing performance this season.

Harris was named the MIAA Offensive Athlete of the Week for his performance against UCO.

Harris's effort was the 26th time a Bearcat has produced a 200-plus rushing game in program history.

Miller completed a 22-yard touchdown strike to Ra'Should Shelton in the third quarter of Northwest's 41-38 loss at UCM. It was also Shelton's first career touchdown reception as a Bearcat.

BEARCAT DEFENSE PRODUCED SIX SACKS AT UCM

A pair of redshirt freshman running backs in Wentric Williams III and Eric Richardson each scored their first collegiate touchdowns against Lincoln.

Williams III, a transfer from Western Illinois, had 15 carries for 42 yards and a four-yard touchdown run against the Blue Tigers.

Richardson had nine carries for 71 yards, including a 12-yard touch-

Wright has named running back Jadon Brady (Savannah, Mo.), defensive lineman Jake Fisher (Smithville, Mo.), quarterback Mike Hohensee (St. Charles, Ill.), linebacker Andrew Dumas (Olathe, Kan.) and linebacker Isaac Vollstedt (Iowa City, Iowa) as team captains.

HUGHES FAMILY FIELDHOUSE

Located just northwest of College Park and Bearcat Stadium on the Northwest campus, the Carl & Cheryl Hughes Fieldhouse serve as a host site for a wide range of University and community activities. The project represents the single largest public-private partnership in Northwest's 114-year history – and one of the largest public-private partnerships ever in the region.

The Hughes Fieldhouse features:

- 137,250 square-foot recreation and multipurpose facility featuring recreation and exhibition space,
- indoor flooring system,
- 90-yard practice turf,
- 300-meter indoor track,
- spectator seating and
- tiered meeting rooms

The Hughes Fieldhouse is an estimated \$20 million project with multiple financing sources, including commitments from the University, private support and community support. The facility is named for the Carl and Cheryl Hughes family, who committed a significant gift to the project through the Hughes Family Foundation.

'CATS TABBED SECOND IN PRE-SEASON MIAA POLLS

The Northwest Missouri State University football team has been projected to finish second in the preseason MIAA coaches' and media polls.

The Bearcats picked up three first-place votes in the Coaches' poll to record 93 points. Pittsburg State was chosen as the preseason favorite by the coaches with 98 points and eight first-place votes.

Northwest added seven more first-place tallies in the Media poll and secured 302 points. PSU was also the top selection in the media poll with 22 first-place votes and 320 total points.

HEAD COACH RICH WRIGHT

2014 & 2015 DII PROGRESS COORDINATOR OF THE YEAR • SEVENTH SEASON

HEAD COACH

Richard Wright was named head coach at Northwest Missouri on Dec. 19, 2016. He arrived at Northwest in 2004 as the defensive line coach and coordinator of special teams. In 2011, Wright was named defensive coordinator and assistant head coach.

Wright guided the Bearcats to their 31st MIAA regular season crown in 2021. It was the 21st outright MIAA title for the Bearcats and first outright title since 2016. The Bearcats have claimed seven of the last nine MIAA crowns.

In 2022, Northwest also earned its 26th berth into the NCAA Division II playoffs. Northwest has reached the NCAA playoffs in 18 consecutive seasons. Northwest recorded a resounding 47-17 road playoff win over No. 3-ranked Ouachita Baptist in the opening round of the playoffs. Senior Elijah Green was named the MIAA Defensive Player of the Year, marking the third straight season a Bearcat has won the award.

In 2021, senior defensive lineman Sam Roberts claimed the Cliff Harris Award, which is given to the nation's best small college defensive player. Roberts also earned the MIAA's Defensive Player of the Year Award. Roberts became the seventh Northwest football player to be selected in the NFL Draft. The New England Patriots chose Roberts in the sixth round of the 2022 NFL Draft.

The 2019 Bearcats had five first-team all-MIAA selections in Spencer Phillips, Tanner Owen and Blake Bay-er. Phillips was named the MIAA Defensive Player of the Year.

The 2018 Bearcats had five first-team all-MIAA selections in Austen Eskew, Zach Flott, Anthony Lane, Tan-ner Owen and Sam Roberts. Braden Wright was named the MIAA Freshman of the Year.

Northwest ranked No. 6 in the nation in scoring defense (14.6 ppg) and No. 7 in rushing defense (89.1 yards/game). Northwest had a streak of 19 straight games without giving up a rushing touchdown that stretched from the 2016 season into the 2018 campaign. All four starters on the defensive line earned all-MIAA honors - Austen Es-kew (first team), Sam Roberts (first team), Mike Ehke (honorable mention) and Spencer Phillips (honorable mention).

The Northwest defense continued to be dominating in 2017. The Bearcats ranked first in the nation in scoring defense (9.3 ppg), total defense (212.8 yards/game), blocked punts (7) and third down conversion defense (19.9 percent). Northwest limited the opposition to 62.0 yards per game on the ground. The Bearcat defense did not allow a rushing touchdown in 2017. In fact, Northwest was the only NCAA school to not allow a rushing touchdown all of last season - including FBS, FCS, Division II and Division III. The Northwest defense had three players named to the All-MIAA First Team in defensive lineman Austin Eskew, linebacker Ben Althoff and defensive back Marcus Jones.

DEFENSIVE COORDINATOR

In 2016, Northwest's defense led the nation in total yards (240.9), rushing yards (67.7), scoring (12.0) and blocked kicks (13). Four Bearcats earned first-team All-MIAA honors and four earned All-America honors. On five occasions, the Northwest defense held opponents under 200 yards of total offense and 12 times held rushing attacks under 100 yards. The Bearcats' four playoff opponents averaged just 54.7 rushing yards, 170.5 passing yards, 225.5 total yards and 9.0 points per game.

The Bearcats' 2015 national championship featured one of the most well rounded defensive units in histo-ry. Northwest led the nation in six categories including total defense, scoring defense, team sacks, rushing defense, team passing efficiency defense and third-down conversion percentage defense. The team finished atop the MIAA

in 15 defensive categories as well, leading to six first-team All-MIAA selections. Collin Bevins earned the third-consecutive MIAA Defensive Player of the Year award for the Bearcats, setting school records in sacks (15.5) and tackles for loss (26.5).

One of the most dominant defenses at any level of football could be found under Wright in 2014. The Bearcats led the nation in total defense and were ranked second in rushing defense, team pass efficiency defense and third down conversion defense. Northwest ranked third in first down defense, fourth in passing yards allowed and fifth in scoring defense. Five Bearcat defensive players earned first team All-MIAA honors including Matt Longacre who was named the MIAA Defensive Player of the Year in 2013 and 2014.

In 2013, Wright's defense was ranked ninth in the NCAA in total defense, allowing just 292.5 yards per game. The Bearcat defense led the MIAA defensively in pass yards allowed, sacks, pass efficiency defense, turnovers gained, third down percentage defense, blocked kicks, blocked punts and total defense.

The 2012 Bearcat defense was nothing short of spectacular, ranking among the nation's elite in scoring defense (second), turnover margin (third), pass efficiency defense (seventh), pass defense (12th) and total defense (17th).

In his first season as the defensive coordinator, Josh Lorensen became the 10th All-America defensive lineman to play under Wright. The 2011 season also saw his defensive unit hold opponents under 100 yards rushing four times and under 100 yards passing three times.

ASSISTANT COACH

Northwest tied for the most sacks in the nation in 2009 when 19 Bearcats combined for 48 sacks. Former player and current graduate assistant Kendall Wright enjoyed one of the most decorated seasons as a return specialist in 2008, earning All-America accolades.

Three former players have been on NFL rosters, Longacre, Dave Tollefson and Steve Williams. Each have spent time with the Kansas City Chiefs, Carolina Panthers and New England Patriots. Tollefson is a two-time Super Bowl Champion earning his first ring with the New York Giants in 2007 and again following the 2011 season.

Wright began coaching during the 1991 season at Cortland State before spending time at Dana College (Neb.) from 1993-94. Covering several facets of coaching, Wright has been an offensive coordinator, linebackers coach, wide receivers coach and special teams coordinator.

PERSONAL

A native of Hamilton, N.Y., Wright earned his bachelor's degree at Dana College in 1995 and his master's at Northwest in 1996. Wright resides in Maryville with his wife, Sarah, who is also a Northwest alum, and their daughters, Grace and Kate.
