There are eight (8) Trust Funds. The largest is the School Trust Fund. Land and mineral revenues are determined, collected, verified, deposited and transferred by this division into these trust funds. Each trust has two (2) sub-funds. One is named the Permanent Fund (non-expendable) and the other is named the Income Fund (expendable).

Trust revenues are divided into six (6) receipt classes. Each sub-fund is a depository for three (3) receipt classes.

- A. Permanent Fund revenues are received from:
 - 1. (a) Sales of Land
 - (b) Principal portion of Certificate of Purchase Land Contract amortization payments.
 - (c) Payment received from the Federal Government for land taken under eminent domain.
 - 2. Consideration received for Rights-of Way granted across State Lands.
 - Royalties and bonus received as the result of the depletion or the anticipated depletion of oil, gas, geothermal, coal, gravel, or other mineral resources.

NOTE: Monies deposited into the School Permanent Fund are invested by the Treasurer. The fund is never depleted, it is a constantly growing investment base and provides a perpetual interest annuity for the School Income Fund. The Permanent Fund Investment as reported by the Treasurer for June 30, 1983 was \$113,974,156. Earnings on Investments were \$11,418,283.

- B. Income Fund revenues are received from:
 - Rentals for surface land, oil, gas, geothermal, cosl, gravel and other mineral rights given under lease contracts.
 - 2. Monies received for Timber Contracts and Permits.
 - Interest portion of Certificate of Purchase Land Contract amortization payments, plus delinquent interest on late mineral royalty payments.

NOTE: Money deposited into the School Income Fund is distributed pro-rata to the different school districts by the Department of Education.

Revenue from State Forest leases is disbursed based on percentages derived from these acreages.

E. On May 23, 1983, a Notice of Condemnation by the United States of America for approximately 27,223.21 acres of State-owned land in Las Animas County became effective. Since the transaction had not been completed as of June 30, 1983, the acreage statistics for Las Animas County were not changed for this report.
