## **Frequently Asked Questions**

#### 1. Is HP doing an End of Sale for all VCX 350x IP Phones World Wide?

Yes, HP is announcing the End of Sale for all the model(s) listed above.

#### 2. Is HP going to sell any VCX 350x IP Phones after this end of sale?

No, HP will not continue to sell 350x IP Phones, however HP may sell 350x IP Phone AC Adapters depending on availability.

# 3. Will distributors or resellers have any chance to buy VCX IP Phone part numbers listed in this announcement after June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2014?

No. Please check with your resellers if they have stock.

#### 4. Will HP continue selling the VCX IP Phone software licenses after June 1st, 2014?

Yes, HP will continue to sell VCX IP phone software licenses for a short duration.

# 5. Are any of the HP Microsoft Lync Compatible 41xx Series IP phones affected by this announcement?

No, absolutely not. HP will continue to sell their industry leading HP 41xx Series Microsoft Lync compatible IP phones as part of his Microsoft Lync UC&C strategy. The HP 41xx series phones should be considered as the replacement solution for VCX customers who are migrating to MS Lync.

## 6. Is HP providing any migration options?

Customers can continue to use 3<sup>rd</sup> party SIP Phones using the VCX 3<sup>rd</sup> party Phone Software Licenses if they wish also. Customer can also migrate to a MSLync solution and purchase HP 41xx MSLync Compatible IP Phones.

#### 7. Is HP still supporting existing VCX contracts and customers?

Yes. HP attempts to continue supporting products for 5 years after End of Sale. This time period can vary by product based on the availability of spare parts. As contracts are renewed, customers will be notified if individual products in their system are no longer supported. In some rare cases, customers could be notified that a product cannot be supported through the expiration date of their contract.

## 8. Will there be additional VCX 350x IP Phone maintenance releases?

There are none planned at this point. Software issues discovered during the HP support period will be addressed by the normal support channels and if needed.

### 9. What happens when a customer's VCX or VCX IP Phone contract is going to expire?

- Customers with service contracts will receive renewal quotes approximately 90 days prior to the expiration date.
- If they purchased the service through a partner, the partner will provide the quote to the customer.
- If an individual product has an End of Service Life date set, that line item will have an expiration date set at the End of Service Life date.

#### 10. Who do I contact if I have a question about my service contract renewal?

- If you purchased your service through a partner, contact your partner and they will contact HP.
- If you purchased your service directly from HP, contact your contract administrator identified on your original service quote or on the renewal quote.
