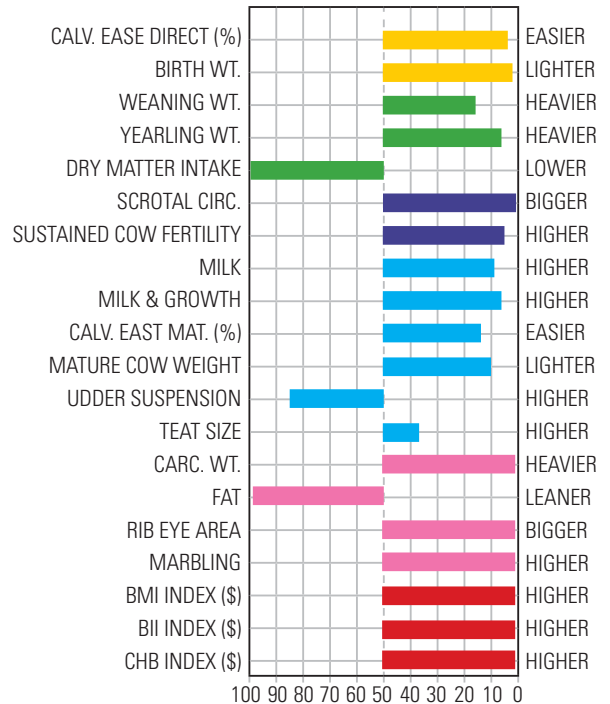

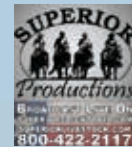

Hereford Juniors Awarded Scholarships and Achievement Awards

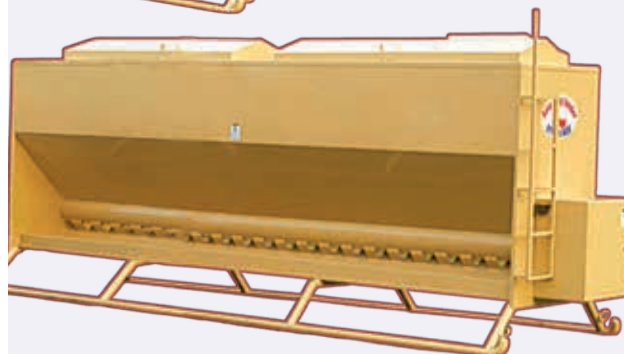

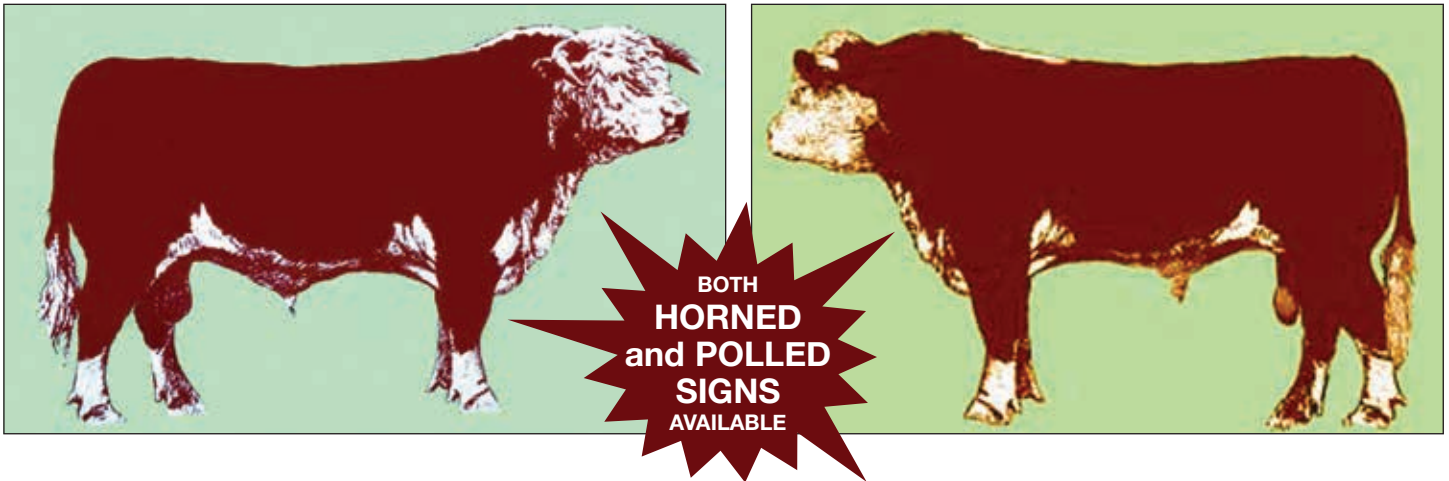
