DX INFORMATION

5U - Adrien, F4IHM is on a mission in Niamey, Niger, and plans to be QRV as 5U4IHM on 40 and 20 metres CW using a straight key. «I'm a beginner in CW, sorry about that», he says. QSL via home call, direct or bureau.

9G - Matteo, IZ4YGS has extended his stay in Ghana [425DXN 1526] and now expects to remain QRV as 9G5GS until 22 September. QSL via Club Log's OQRS, LoTW, eQSL, or direct to home call.

A9 - The Bahrain Amateur Radio Society will run special event station A91WFAD on 10-14 September for this year's World First Aid Day. QSL via LoTW, or via EC6DX. Organized annually by the International Federation of Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies, the World First Aid Day promotes the importance of first aid training in preventing injuries and saving lives.

CE - Members of the Chilean Pacific DX Group will be active during September as XR210CHI to commemorate the 210th anniversary of the establishment of the First Government Junta (18 September 1810), the earliest step in the Chilean struggle for independence from Spain. QSL via Club Log's OQRS, LoTW, or via XQ7UP.

DL - Special callsign DK70DARC is active until 31 December to celebrate the 70th anniversary of the Deutscher Amateur Radio Club, the German IARU society. QSL via the bureau; direct cards should be sent to DK50N.

F - For the 69th year the Association des Radioamateurs de la Sarthe (F6KFI) will operate a special event station for the 24 Hours of Le Mans. Look for TM24HC on 6-20 September, with activity on various bands and modes (SSB, CW, RTTY, PSK, FT8). This year's race

has been postponed from June to 19-20 September owing to the COVID-19 pandemic, hence the "C" in the suffix. QSL via F6KFI.

F - Andre, F6IGY and others will be active as TM4IT from Tombelaine Island (EU-156) on 12 September. They will operate QRP on 40, 30 and 20 metres SSB and CW. [TNX F8REF]

F - Tom, DL1ASA has been active as F/DL1ASA/p from Ile de Re (EU-032) since 31 August. He operates CW and SSB mainly on 40 and 20 metres. On 12-16 September he will be active from Banc d'Arguin (EU-159). QSL via home call, direct or bureau. [TNX DX Newsletter]

F - Marc, F6HQP will be vacationing in the Finistere Department on 14-20 September. 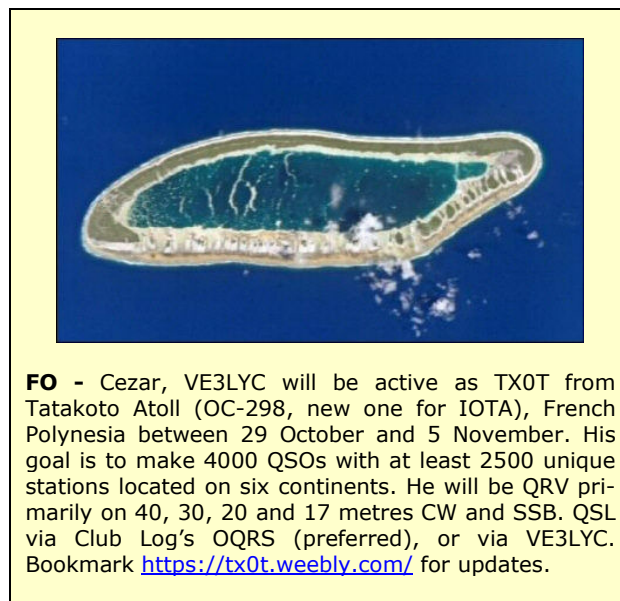
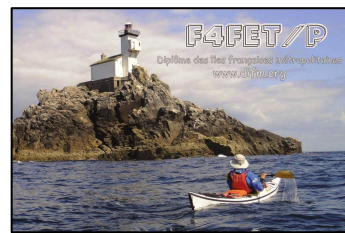

AT062), Brunec (EU-094, DIFM AT063), Guiautec (EU-094, DIFM AT122), Cigogne (EU-094, DIFM AT061), Queffen (not IOTA, DIFM AT133) and Rat (not IOTA, DIFM AT134). He will operate SSB on 40 and 20 metres. QSL via Club Log's OQRS, or via home call.

F - The Charente DX Group will be active as TM7R from Ile de Re (EU-032) from 26 September to 3 October. Six operators (namely F4GBD, F5LOW, F5MNM, F5NBQ, F6HKA and ON4ZD) will be QRV on the HF bands CW, SSB and digital modes. QSL via Club Log's OQRS (preferred), or via ON4ZD, direct or bureau. F - Special callsign TM82ALC will commemorate the 290th anniversary of the death of the French explorer and adventurer Antoine Laumet de la Mothe, sieur de Cadillac (1658-1730). The car brand Cadillac was named after him, who had founded Detroit in 1701. Look for SSB, CW and digital modes activity on 9-13, 16-20 and 23-27 October. QSL via eQSL, LoTW, or via F4ELR. 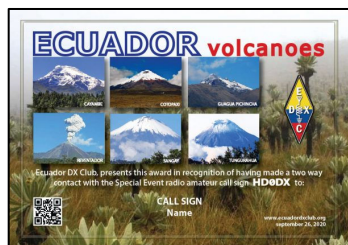
G - David, M0VDL will be active from Lundy Island (EU-120) between 26 Sep-

The main goal of the operators (LA8FTA, LB8IH, LB8CG, LA7WRA, LB7PI, LB1RH and LB9EH) is to participate in the SSB leg of the Scandinavian Activity Contest (10-11 October).

JW - Erwann, LB1QI plans to be active as JW/LB1QI from the JW5E club station in Longyearbyen (EU-026), Svalbard on 15-18 October. He will operate CW and SSB on 160-6 metres. QSL via home call (direct or bureau) and LoTW.

W - K1A will be operated as a special event station for the Amateur Radio Software Award from 25 September through 4 October. Look for activity on 20 and 40 metres SSB.



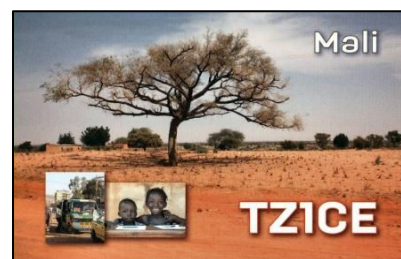
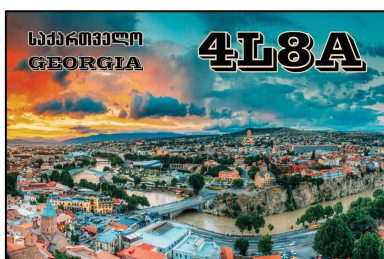
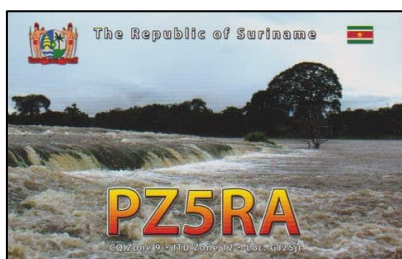

4V5H • Announced for May 2020 and then postponed twice [425DXN 1519], the 4V5H DXpedition to Haiti has been «cancelled indefinitely due to COVID-19 pandemic and current world airlines' uncertainty». [TNX DX World]



DX WORLD • «As there is not much DX news nor DXpeditions taking place nowadays», DX World has added a couple of new features to the popular *DX World QSL of the Day* (interesting, rare or unique QSL cards) and *DX World IOTA of the Day* (pictorial views of various islands) that were introduced a few weeks ago. Whilst the *Weekly Quiz* puts your DX knowledge to the test (<https://www.dx-world.net/quiz/>), *DXCC Entities or Islands by Drone* is a collection of videos «showcasing particular entities or IOTA using only drone footage». Preceded by Revillagigedo (XF4), Jan Mayen (JX) and Greenwich Island (AN-010, South Shetlands), the episodes so far include Eritrea (E3), Flores Island (OC-151, Indonesia) Lakshadweep (VU7), Mangaia Island (OC-159, South Cooks), Nepal (9N), Niue (E6), Nuuk (NA-018, Greenland), Ogasawara (JD1), San Blas Archipelago (NA-170, Panama), Tuvalu (T2), Uzbekistan (UK) and Zanzibar Island (AF-032, Tanzania). Three new drone videos will be published every second day.

INDEXA • The International DX Association's Officers for the 2021 Fiscal Year are Bob Schenck N200 (President), Jerry Rosalius WB9Z (Vice President) and Dick Williams W3OA (Secretary-Treasurer). The Directors are Bob Allphin K4UEE, Ralph Fedor K0IR, Hal Turley W8HC, Lou Dietrich N2TU (Chairman), Franz Langner DJ9ZB, Gary Dixon K4MQG, John Scott K8YC, Adrian Ciuperca KO8SCA, Steve Sullivan KZ2I, Valerie Hotzfeld NV9L and Otis Vicens NP4G.



The Summer 2020 issue (#130) of the Newsletter is now available for download on the INDEXA website (<https://indexa.org/newsletters.html>). «DX material is very scarce right now», so «this issue is about history» (the beginnings of INDEXA and the first sponsored DXpedition in 1984, to the Kermadecs), plus a spotlight on Yasuo "Zorro" Miyazawa (JH1AJT), the recipient of the 2020 Hamvention Amateur of the Year Award. The International DX Association (<https://indexa.org/>) is an amateur radio organization dedicated to working DX and making DX possible. In 35+ years of service to the DX community it has sponsored over 240 DXpeditions to rare and semi-rare countries.



IOTA: REPORT AN ACTIVATION • IOTA activators are encouraged to submit information about their past operations by logging in to <https://iota-world.org> and using the form available at SUPPORT -> REPORT AN IOTA ACTIVATION. Each entry must include the callsign, island name, IOTA reference, as well as the date and time of the first and last QSOs for each contiguous time window of operation. All entries will be checked by the Validation Team. It is hoped that «such reporting becomes standard before not too long». [TNX VE3LYC]

JX0X • The unexpected news that Erik, LA2US/JX2US is going on a 6-month work assignment to Jan Mayen [4215DXN 1532] «puts the JX0X project in a difficult situation», Ken LA7GIA posted to Facebook on 11 September. «While there are several differences between a 6-month single-op trip and a 2-week tent and generator DXpedition, for us this is a matter of if we are 1) able to raise the remaining funds, and 2) willing to sign an expensive vessel contract with all the added uncertainties.



With this added info we are hesitant to sign the vessel contract without knowing the result of the support from the DX community. We need more time, while we carefully consider what to do. In the meantime, we encourage everyone who wants to have a good low band show next fall to support us upfront, and donate to our PayPal account [jx0x\[@\]la7gia.com](mailto:jx0x[@]la7gia.com). We offer 100% refund of all donations in case DXped is cancelled. We expect a final decision to go will be taken in a few months, dependent on the financial situation».

The JX0X DXpedition is expected to take place between 15 September and 5 October 2021. Plans are for six operators to run up to four stations simultaneously for two weeks; the main modes will be CW and digi, plus some SSB, with a focus on 160, 80, 60, 40 and 30 metres.



LOTW NEW USER GUIDE • «Keen to get going on LoTW, but not sure how? Help is at hand!», Gary, ZL2IFB says. «I was asked to write 'simple step-by-step instructions' for amateurs struggling with computers, so it ended up at 30-odd pages with lots of pictures». This version has new features as well as corrections for defects found since TQSL 2.5.4 was released. This release also includes an update to the most recent TQSL configuration file. TQSL 2.5.5 can be installed to upgrade any older version. On all three supported platforms (Windows, MacOS and Linux), installing TQSL 2.5.5 will replace older versions of Trusted QSL while preserving your Callsign Certificates, Station Locations, and preferences.

VP8PJ: FINAL PRESS RELEASE • «We have closed the books on the VP8PJ DXpedition to the South Orkney Islands (AN-008)», the Leadership Team announced on 13 September. «Due to the global pandemic our equipment was returned to California about two months later than planned. 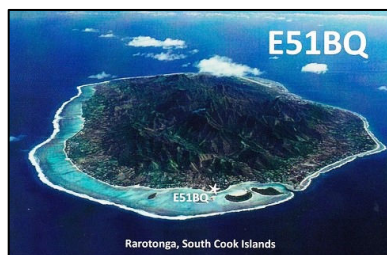

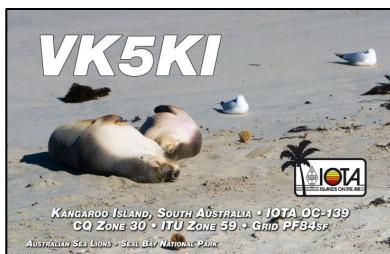
