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QUELQUES ASPECTS ECOLOGIQUES  
CONCERNANT LA CONSTRUCTION DE RECIIFS ARTIFICIELS DANS LES ZONES  
COTIERES DE LA PARTIE NORD-OUEST DE LA MER NOIRE

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Abstract - This paper is arguing the necessity of building artificial reefs in the north-western part of the Black Sea, where great ecological changes have taken place in the past fifteen years. The author considers that a fragment of the marine coastal ecosystem - lying in front of some sectors of economic or social importance - could be fitted up with man-made habitat and its quality could be improved by means of the artificial reefs. The final part of the paper summarizes some of the ecological benefits foreseen as a result of developing artificial reefs.

La partie nord-ouest de la mer Noire entre les limites établies par Zaitsev (19) représente une zone demi fermée, soumise à une forte pression écologique exercée surtout par l'intermédiaire des fleuves tributaires (Danube, Dniestr, Dniepr, Boug). Localement, à faible profondeur, les facteurs de risque écologique augmentent d'autant plus sous l'effet des influences anthropiques (développement industriel, concentration démographique dans les zones littorales, développement des transports maritimes, construction de nouveaux ports, aménagement des plages et des falaises, exploitation des ressources marines biologiques, minérales et énergétiques, etc.), sans rappeler les nombreuses activités sur le continent, activités qui influencent indirectement les écosystèmes marins par l'intermédiaire des fleuves ou de l'atmosphère. Les pressions de ces facteurs perturbants sont apparues et se sont développées dans la mer Noire, comme dans toutes les mers, surtout pendant les 10-15 dernières années. On a pu ainsi mettre en évidence, à partir de 1970, toute une série de dérèglements structuraux et fonctionnels dans les écosystèmes côtiers, dérèglements qui ont leur point de départ dans le processus complexe d'eutrophisation-pollution (3, 4, 5, 10, 11, 12, 13, 17). Ces dérèglements se déroulent tels une réaction en chaîne, qui diffuse dans l'écosystème entier, et ils se reflètent le mieux au niveau du benthos (5), où s'exerce aussi l'influence du plancton. Par rapport à l'intervalle 1960-1965 où la stabilité écologique était élevée (1), la situation actuelle du benthos dans les étages infralittoral et circalittoral supérieur de la partie nord-ouest de la mer Noire (où dominent surtout les fonds sédimentaires), se caractérise par :

1. un processus continuuel d'appauvrissement qualitatif et quantitatif de la flore et de la faune ;

2. un processus accentué d'uniformisation biocénotique, avec formation d'un "continuum" à *Mya arenaria* L. et *Cardium edule lamarecki* Reeve, superposé aux 4 ou 5 autres biocénoses d'autrefois (dont il reste à présent des "noda" sur des espaces très restreints, variables avec le temps et avec des peuplements très appauvris) ;

3. un développement exubérant et une nette domination des peuplements de quelques organismes résistant aux nouvelles conditions de pression et de chocs écologiques répétés. Ces organismes ont une grande plasticité écologique, et sont même opportunistes (les algues *Enteromorpha* et *Cladophora*, le bivalve *Mya arenaria*, le polychète *Melinna palmata* Grube, etc.)

4. d'importantes oscillations quantitatives dues à l'intensification des mortalités en masse, effet majeur des floraisons toujours plus fréquentes et plus puissantes.

L'augmentation du degré de pollution des eaux littorales parallèlement à l'accélération du processus d'eutrophisation, les conséquences négatives des phénomènes de floraison, la réduction de la capacité du biofiltre naturel (par la disparition de quelques espèces) ont abouti, par la diminution des peuplements d'autres espèces, à une sévère réduction, qualitative et quantitative, de la macroflore et au développement intense du gastéropode prédateur *Rapana* qui détruit les bancs de moules. Ces faits, ainsi que l'augmentation locale de la turbidité de l'eau et l'oblitération brutale dans les zones où on pratique des aménagements côtiers et des travaux d'ingénierie marine, l'accentuation des phénomènes d'érosion des plages et des falaises, etc., réclament une rapide série de mesures en vue d'annihiler certains effets négatifs et pour conserver et améliorer les écosystèmes déréglés. Or, à première vue, le problème de l'amélioration des écosystèmes marins semble impossible à résoudre.

On sait que l'écosystème constitue une entité intégrée en espace, caractérisée par l'existence de composants biotiques et abiotiques interdépendants, liés par le flux d'énergie et le circuit de la matière, l'échange permanent entre les éléments organiques et inorganiques et seulement entre ceux vivants, ainsi que par des mécanismes de régulation homéostatique. On considère qu'en milieu marin cette unité fonctionnelle fondamentale de la biosphère comprend, verticalement, le domaine pélagique ainsi que le domaine benthique,



(selon son étagement) et, horizontalement, l'espace occupé par un certain type de substrat et par une association majeure d'organismes benthiques. Ainsi, l'écosystème marin occupe un vaste espace tridimensionnel, d'une grande complexité, dont les frontières sont difficiles à établir et qui, certes ne peut être entièrement protégé et amélioré. Mais un fragment de l'écosystème, situé dans un secteur limité, où apparaissent ou sont envisagés des dérèglements de l'équilibre écologique (secteur présentant un intérêt économique ou social, par exemple les plages touristiques), peut certainement être amélioré.

L'une des méthodes d'amélioration de la qualité de certains fragments d'écosystèmes marins littoraux est la construction de récifs artificiels. La littérature actuelle concernant les modifications du milieu marin par la construction de récifs artificiels dans les zones à faible production dépourvues de substrat solide (14, 15) atteste les résultats positifs des recherches d'amélioration de la productivité biologique marine.

Jusqu'à présent, dans la mer Noire, on n'a pas fait d'expérimentations sur la construction, le comportement ou l'efficacité des récifs artificiels. Mais il existe assez de données qui prouvent que, dans ce bassin, les associations épibiontes des zones à substrat dur, rocheux, ont en conditions normales une grande diversité spécifique, une haute productivité biologique et un rôle écologique beaucoup plus important que ceux des fonds meubles (1). De plus, on a constaté que, sur les supports artificiels durs (métal ou béton) le rythme de formation des communautés épibiontes est extrêmement grand, les organismes développés en quelques mois sur le nouveau substrat atteignant jusqu'à  $35 \text{ kg/m}^2$  (8). Même en haute mer, à 80 m de profondeur, où les peuplements naturels des organismes sessiles qui forment des communautés épibiontes manquent généralement, le système colonisateur formé pendant un an et demi sur substrat artificiel (où domine *Mytilus*) peut avoir un poids supérieur à  $60 \text{ kg/m}^2$  (9).

Les recherches que nous avons entreprises sur les stabilopodes qui protègent les digues au large du port de Constantza ont prouvé qu'en moins d'un an des communautés épibiontes extrêmement riches du point de vue quantitatif et qualitatif (dont les moules seules peuvent enregistrer des densités supérieures à  $15\ 000$  exemplaires/ $\text{m}^2$  et des biomasses de  $7,6 \text{ kg/m}^2$ ) se forment sur le substrat artificiel (tableau 1).

Si l'on tient compte qu'à présent, sur les fonds sédimentaires la biomasse du plus fort filtreur (*Mya arenaria*) arrive à peine à  $648\text{g/m}^2$  en moyenne (7), on peut mieux se rendre compte de la grande productivité des systèmes épibiontes sur substrats durs naturels et artificiels. De plus, ces systèmes épibiontes ont une grande capacité de régénération après avoir été détruits par diverses causes. Par exemple, en 1977, la faune pétricole d'Agigéa s'est régénérée après les mortalités massives de l'été 1975, sous l'effet de la floraison massive des eaux avec *Exuviaella cordata* (6), les densités et les biomasses atteignant des valeurs moyennes de 123 000-263 000 individus/m<sup>2</sup> et 11,2-14,3 kg/m<sup>2</sup>. Les principaux organismes épibiontes (*Chiton marginatus* Penn., *Mytilaster lineatus* (Gmelin), *Mytilus galloprovincialis* Lam. et *Balanus improvisus* Darwin), représentaient environ 12-14% du nombre total des benthon-tes et leur poids était supérieur à 99% (16).

Les quelques données ci-dessus en disent long en vue d'accepter l'idée d'utiliser le grand potentiel écologique représenté par la faune et la flore épibiontes afin d'améliorer la qualité des écosystèmes côtiers sur fonds meubles.

Un calcul estimatif prouve qu'un élément de récif artificiel formé par exemple de 5 stabilopodes d'un poids de 4,5 tonnes (largement utilisés à présent pour protéger les digues et les bâtiments portuaires externes), occupe une surface de fond d'environ  $13 \text{ m}^2$ , développant verticalement environ  $54 \text{ m}^2$ , c'est à dire une surface 3 à 4 fois plus grande. Si l'on tient compte que sur les stabilopodes vont se former des peuplements de moules dont les densités dépassent  $15\ 000 \text{ individus/m}^2$ , et qu'une moule peut filtrer environ 8,4 litres d'eau par jour, sur une surface moyenne de fond où l'on a construit un récif artificiel les moules vont représenter une vraie bio-pompe qui filtre 36 000 litres d'eau par jour. Afin de pouvoir accomplir son rôle, on préconise que le récif soit construit à 5 m de profondeur, de manière que la colonne d'eau située au-dessus du récif (3m) soit filtrée plus de 125 fois par jour. De plus, on n'a pas tenu compte des autres aspects liés au rôle des moules dans l'écosystème, ni de celui des autres organismes.

Ainsi, par la construction de récifs artificiels dans certains secteurs à faible profondeur ayant des fonds meubles, tels la partie nord-ouest de la mer Noire, on préconise de réaliser l'amélioration de la qualité des écosystèmes dans les fragments aménagés par :

- l'augmentation de la capacité biologique portante du milieu marin dans le secteur aménagé, en créant un substrat dur développé verticalement sur une large superficie ;
- la formation d'une barrière filtrante (où *Mytilus*, *Mytilaster* et *Balanus* auront un rôle important de bio-pompe et de convertisseur à la fois), afin de purifier les eaux côtières saisies de floraison et de convertir la riche production primaire microphytique en biomasse dont le potentiel puisse être mis en valeur ;
- la protection des plages et de falaises soumises à l'érosion croissante et la création d'une source certaine de matériel coquillier pour régénérer les dépôts des plages ;

- la création de lieux d'attraction, d'abri et de nourriture pour de nombreux poissons (Gobiidae, Labridae, mais aussi Mugilidae, etc.) ;
- l'augmentation de la diversité écologique du fragment de l'écosystème aménagé (à côté de la faune sédimentophile pauvre de la zone se développent les riches associations épibiontes d'invertébrés, de poissons et aussi d'algues) ;
- l'augmentation et l'amélioration de la productivité biologique générale de la zone littorale et surtout de la base trophique des poissons ;
- la création de zones où l'on peut facilement adapter certaines installations suspendues pour l'élevage des organismes marins.

Par la construction de récifs artificiels, la situation écologique actuelle va certainement s'améliorer par endroits, mais aussi on va accumuler un riche matériel informationnel, constituant le fond de données écologiques strictement nécessaires en vue de pronostiquer l'évolution des écosystèmes côtiers dans la perspective des grandioses projets visant l'aménagement de la partie nord-ouest de la mer Noire, projets dont nous citons seulement le barrage du liman du Dniestr et du Dniepr (18).

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
