



## Young Leadership Council Accomplishments

### STATS:

- Founded in summer 2016
- 67 members from 18 states
- 2 co-chairs in NYC and Los Angeles
- 1 event chair in NYC

- All funds raised support young investigators at the Basser Center

- 3 small groups for deeper engagement: Community Group, Event Group, & Science Group

### Science Group

The Science Group focuses on summarizing and simplifying the latest BRCA research and news coverage. (Think theSKIMM for BRCA-related science.) Science Group members also have the opportunity to research and present on one or more Basser Young Investigators in order to prepare the YLC to vote on whom to fund via the YLC Young Investigator Award.

Members of this group review and summarize 2-4 scientific articles per month; summaries are included in the monthly email to YLC members.

### Event Group

The YLC holds a biennial fundraising event, and at least one outreach/educational event each year.

### Community Group

The Community Group focuses on building and strengthening the YLC community through recruitment, outreach, a standardized onboarding process, and stewardship. Members of this group speak fluently about the mission of the Basser Center and the YLC, and have a good grasp on the scientific accomplishments and current research at the Center. Training and materials are provided.
