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ENQUIRIES

Of all the tables produced from the 1982 Survey, only the more frequently used ones have been selected for publication in this report. The tabulation programme of the 1982 Survey also includes a number of other tables classified by various economic attributes. Detailed statistics showing the breakdown of various component items in principal statistics are also available. I. Introduction

1. Background

From April 1983 to early 1984, the Census and Statistics Department conducted an Annual Survey of Industrial Production covering the activities of mining and quarrying, manufacturing, and the supply of electricity, gas and water in respect of 1982. Similar surveys were conducted for the years 1973, 1976, 1977, 1978, 1979, 1980 and 1981. The coverage of all these enquiries conformed with Major Divisions 2, 3 and 4 of the United Nations International Standard Industrial Classification of All Economic Activities (I.S.I.C.). For 1974 and 1975, the surveys covered the textiles and clothing industries only.

2. Objectives of the Survey

The objectives of the 1982 Survey were to collect statistics required for assessing industrial performance, structural changes and intra- and inter-industry comparisons; to estimate value added for updating the contribution of the industrial sector to Hong Kong's Gross Domestic Product; and to collect commodity details of industrial production so as to depict changes in output level and product mix.

3. Legislation

The 1982 Survey was conducted under the authority of the Census and Statistics (Annual Survey of Industrial Production) Order 1981, which was approved by the Governor in Council under the Census and Statistics Ordinance (Chapter 316) and published in the Government Gazette as Legal Notice No. 18/81 on 30th January 1981. The said Ordinance provides for the collection of specified data from respondents, and obliges the Department to preserve the confidentiality of information of individual establishments.

4. Survey coverage

The frame for conducting the Survey was a comprehensive register of all manufacturing establishments which was maintained and kept up-to-date by the Department using information from the Business Registration Office of the Inland Revenue Department and the factory registration system of the Labour Department. The list of mining and quarrying establishments was furnished by the Mines Division of the Labour Department while that of welfare institution workshops, which included those run by the Social Welfare Department and some non-profit institutions, was furnished by the Social Welfare Department. The list of Government industrial undertakings, consisting of 2 quarries, 1 printing house, 17 prison workshops, 2 abattoirs and 1 water works establishment, and that of electricity and gas companies were compiled by the Census and Statistics Department.

5. Sample design

The sampling frame for the Survey was stratified by industries and by employment size ranges. All manufacturing establishments engaging 100 or more persons were enumerated fully. For those establishments engaging fewer than 100 persons, the sample size and structure for each of the 149 constituent industries were determined by the method of optimum allocation

according to a desired level of precision for the value added estimate in each industry. Individual sampling units were then drawn out by systematic selection with a random start. The sample size for the manufacturing sector was 7 865 establishments. The total number of establishments operating in 1982 was estimated to be 45 194.

6. Enumeration and data processing

The method of postal enquiry coupled with field follow-up visits was adopted for enumeration. Survey questionnaires were mailed to sampled establishments in April 1983, while visits by field officers were made between May 1983 and March 1984 by the end of which 6 203 completed returns were received. There were 1 627 deletion cases which were closures, untraceable removals, branches without separate returns, establishments outside the scope of the Survey etc. The balance of 35 cases were non-responses or partially completed returns requiring office imputations, representing 0.4% of the manufacturing establishments initially sampled. The number of deletions in the sample, such as inactive establishments and those outside the scope of the Survey, provided an estimate of the number of similar cases in the register. The register included 50 714 establishments at the time of sample selection.

Completed questionnaires underwent thorough checking by office staff as well as data validation checks by the computer before tabulation. Dubious reported data were clarified by telephone enquiries or field verification visits.

Altogether 96 statistical tables were produced by the computer, of which only 20 more basic ones were selected for publication in this report due to limited printing space. Enquiries on the unpublished statistics may be directed to the Industrial Production Statistics Section of the Census and Statistics Department.

Notes to statistical tables

- (i) All the statistical tables in this report, except Table 20 on standard errors, relate to "all establishments" which also incorporate the economic contributions of non-reporting establishments. "Non-reporting establishments" refer to those establishments which operated during part or whole of the reference period but which ceased operation during the survey operation such that data could not be obtained in respect of them. The economic contributions of non-reporting establishments were imputed from their employment levels as recorded in a regular employment enquiry, with due reference to the cost and production patterns displayed by reporting establishments of the same industry and employment size. Establishments operating for only part of 1982 were imputed with a lesser economic contribution than a similar one operating throughout the year. The number of non-reporting establishments, however, denotes an actual count of those factories.
- (ii) Table 20 presents the sampling errors for some of the key economic variables of "reporting" establishments. Sampling errors for "all" establishments have not been compiled.
- (iii) In order to ensure that information relating to individual establishments is not disclosed, data cells containing one or two establishments are suppressed, showing only the number of persons engaged. An additional cell with the smallest value added is also suppressed to prevent the deduction of a suppressed cell from the total.
- (iv) An asterisk denotes statistics being suppressed for confidentiality reasons. The statistics are, nevertheless, included in the respective totals at some broader level of classification.
- (v) N.E.C. means not elsewhere classified.
- (vi) Individual entries of a column may not add up exactly to the **respective** totals due to rounding.

Definitions of Statistical Terms

1. Establishment An establishment is ideally an economic unit which engages, under a single ownership or control, in one or predominantly one kind of economic activity at a single physical location.
- Where separate figures relating to different activities or different locations under the same management are not available, a combined return is accepted and in this case, the reporting unit is treated as an establishment.
2. Number of persons engaged equals the total number of working proprietors, active business partners, unpaid family workers and employees, averaging over the four quarters covered by the reporting period
3. Compensation of employees equals wages to operatives
plus salaries to other employees
plus payments in kind and employer's social security expenditure
plus payments to outworkers
4. Miscellaneous operating expenses equals rents and rates
plus interest payments
plus quota transfer payments
plus payments for non-industrial services
5. Sales and work done equals sales of goods produced
plus machinery produced for own use
plus resales of goods in same condition as purchased
plus receipts for work performed or industrial services rendered to others
6. Other receipts equals rents received
plus quota transfer receipts
plus income from other sources
7. Gross output equals sales and work done
plus changes in stocks of work in progress and finished products
8. Census value added equals gross output
less consumption of materials, supplies and industrial services
9. National accounts value added equals gross output (net of stock appreciation for work in progress and finished products)
less consumption of materials, supplies and industrial services (net of stock appreciation for materials/supplies and goods for resale)
plus other receipts (except quota transfer receipts)
less miscellaneous operating expenses (except interest payments and quota transfer payments)
10. Gross surplus equals census value added
plus other receipts
less compensation of employees
less miscellaneous operating expenses

Industrial classification for "broad" industry group
and industry group

For the purpose of analysis by industry, establishments in the 1982 Survey were classified into 149 industries. The industries were aggregated into 23 industry groups and further into 10 "broad" industry groups.

The descriptions and codes for the "broad" industry groups and industry groups are given below, whilst those for the 149 industries can be found in Table 18 of this report.
