### LAMP AND FILTER REPLACEMENT INSTRUCTIONS

### INTRODUCTION

Use the following instructions when replacing the lamp or filters in any of the projectors listed in Table 1, below. The lamp is located at the rear of the projector (below the input panel) and can be accessed by opening the lamp door. Use only a Christie approved *Lamp and Filter Kit* for your specific projector model.

### WARNINGS

Lamp replacement MUST be performed by a qualified service technician.

Cool the lamp completely and handle by the housing only.

Install the correct wattage lamp supplied by Christie (Refer to Table 1. Projector Models) and read the Lamp Replacement Procedure in its entirety before proceeding.



Do not touch the glass surface of the lamp. Fingerprints left on the surface can lead to an intense accumulation of heat known as a "hotspot", which could potentially result in the lamp shattering. It is recommended to wear clean, lint-free gloves and a face shield when working with the lamp.



### LAMP REPLACEMENT PROCEDURE Please read before proceeding.

### 🗥 WARNING 🛝

Always power down and unplug the projector prior to servicing. Allow the lamps to cool before handling.

### STEP 1 - TURN THE LAMP OFF

Press (power) to turn the projector off. Allow the cooling fans to stop automatically (approximately five minutes) before proceeding with Step 2. This wait period is also required to allow the lamp to sufficiently cool before handling.

### STEP 2 - UNPLUG THE PROJECTOR

When the cooling fans have stopped, turn the projector's main switch off and unplug from the main power source.

### STEP 3 - OPEN THE LAMP DOOR



### Protective gear required. Wear a face shield.




Figure 1. Open Lamp Door

Use a #2 Phillips screwdriver to loosen the ¼-turn lock screws (2) securing the lamp door, located at the rear of the projector below the input panel. Refer to Figure 1.

### STEP 4 - REMOVE LAMP RETAINING BAR




Figure 2. Remove Retaining Bar

Use a #2 Phillips screwdriver to remove the two screws that secure the retaining bar along the bottom edge of the lamp module. Refer to Figure 2. Swing the bar to the side - it is hinged on the left.

### STEP 5 - REMOVE THE LAMP MODULE




Figure 3. Remove Lamp Module

Firmly grasp the handle and pull the lamp module straight out of the projector, as shown in Figure 3. Discard the lamp using safe disposal/recycling practices.

**STEP 6 - INSERT THE NEW LAMP MODULE** 




Improper installation could cause a serious meltdown inside the projector.

### NOTE

The lamp module must make full contact with the lamp connectors. Increased resistance indicates initial contact with the connectors – push firmly at this point to make full contact.




Figure 4. Alignment Guides

Align the base plate of the new lamp module under both side alignment guides. Refer to Figure 4. Slide the module fully into the projector in the same orientation the old lamp module was removed. Push with normal force until the resistance increases and then firmly push the module another  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch.

### STEP 7 - RE-INSTALL LAMP RETAINING BAR

(a) Position the retaining bar along the bottom edge of the lamp module, with the ends positioned under the alignment guides. If the bar does not fit, push the lamp module in further.



- (b) Secure screw **B** until just engaged.
- (c) Secure screw A until just engaged.




Figure 5. Install Retaining Bar

- (d) Go back and forth between **A** and **B** to lock the bar in place with even pressure and correctly position the lamp module. Refer to Figure 5.

### STEP 8 – CLOSE LAMP DOOR

Close the lamp door and lock the ¼-turn lock screws (2).

# The lamp module is calibrated for maximum performance and brightness in this projector. Do not attempt to re-align or adjust the lamp module.

### **STEP 9 - INSTALL THE AIR FILTER**

While the projector is still off, replace the air filter. For more information, refer to the *Filter Replacement Procedure, on page 6.* 



### STEP 10 - RECORD THE SERIAL NUMBER OF THE NEW LAMP



- Plug in the projector and power it up. (a)
- In the Lamp menu, select "Change Lamp". Refer to Figure 6, shown below. (b)
- (C) In the Lamp S/N text box, enter the serial number.
- Press ENTER to record the number and to reset the lamp timer. The timer will now (d) begin to log time for the new lamp.

### FILTER REPLACEMENT PROCEDURE

### NOTE

## This procedure should be undertaken immediately after Step 8 of the *Lamp Replacement Procedure*.

The filter, located at the front side of the projector, should be changed whenever the lamp is replaced. If operating in an extremely dusty environment the filter may have to be replaced sooner. Use the filter provided in the Christie approved *Lamp and Filter Kit* for the specific projector model. For more information, refer to Table 1. Projector Models.

### STEP 1 – TURN OFF THE PROJECTOR, COOL and UNPLUG

Before removing or installing a filter, turn off the projector and allow it to cool for five minutes before unplugging.

### **STEP 2 - REMOVE FILTER DOOR**

### **NOTE** When operating a Roadster S+20K also remove the triangular metal filter brace.





Figure 7. Remove Filter Door

Loosen the ¼-turn screw at the top of the filter grille/door. Lift the door away from the projector. Refer to Figure 7.

### STEP 3 - REPLACE FILTER




Figure 9. Installing the Angled Air Filter (ROADSTER S<sup>+</sup>20K ONLY).

Remove the old filter and insert a new one. Follow the airflow arrows for correct orientation. Refer to Figure 8. The Roadster S+20K model has a rhomboid-shaped filter; therefore, insert the sharply angled corner first – place fully back on the left. Ensure the triangular metal filter brace is installed after the filter has been positioned. Refer to Figure 9.

- 003-000-310: Five pack filter kit for 3.0kW projectors

### STEP 4 - RE-INSTALL THE FILTER GRILLE/DOOR

Tighten the single top screw to secure the filter grille/door.





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
