

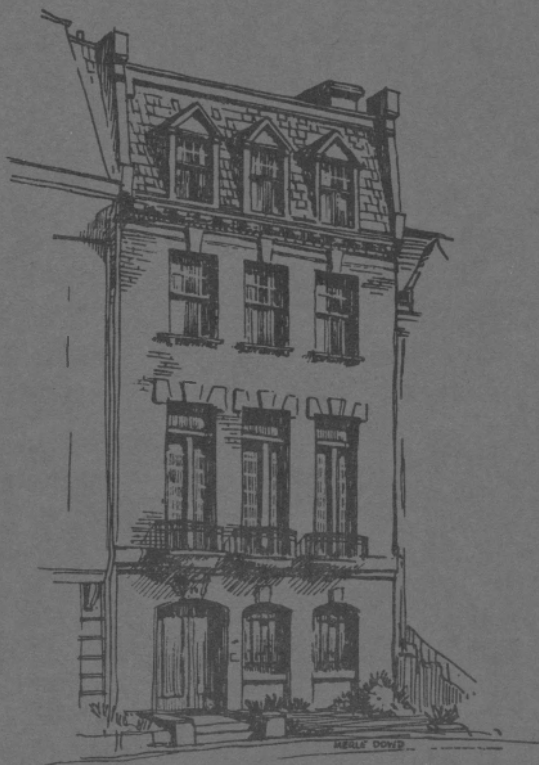

# CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS

## American Newspaper Women's Club, Inc.

Constitution revised September 28, 1953 and May 22, 1967. By-laws revised September 28, 1953; March 28, 1955; May 28, 1956; March 25, 1957; March 29, 1965; May 22, 1967; and April 26, 1971.

### CONSTITUTION

#### Article I

##### Name

This organization shall be known as the American Newspaper Women's Club, Inc.

#### Article II

##### Aims

The aims of this club shall be to promote professional pursuits and good fellowship among its members, to maintain a meeting place for its members, and to encourage friendly understanding between the members and those whom they must contact in their profession.

#### Article III

##### Membership

This club shall consist of women whose qualifications, according to the provisions of the By-laws, are established in one of the following classes: Active, Inactive, Associate, and Honorary.

#### Article IV

##### Board of Governors, Officers, and Committees

*Section 1.* The Board of Governors, comprised of the duly elected officers of the club, and such other members as shall be provided for in the By-laws, shall be the governing body of the club, and as such shall have supervision over all of its activities.

*Section 2.* The Officers of this club shall consist of a President, First Vice President, Second Vice President, Recording Secretary, Corresponding Secretary, Treasurer, Historian.

*Section 3.* There shall be such standing and other committees as shall be provided for in the By-laws.

#### Article V

##### Meetings

There shall be an annual meeting, and regular and special meetings, which shall be held at such times as provided for in the By-laws.

### Article VI

#### Amendment of the Constitution

This Constitution may be amended by a two-thirds favorable vote of Active members present and voting at any business meeting, or special meeting called for this purpose by the President or Board of Governors, provided that notice and text of such amendment or amendments shall have been sent to the members at least ten days in advance of the meeting, and provided that a quorum is present.

### BY-LAWS

#### Article I

##### Membership

*Section 1.* Members shall be women whose qualifications establish their eligibility in one of the following classes: Active, Inactive, Associate, or Honorary.

*Section 2.* Active members shall be women of recognized professional achievement who qualify under one of the following subsections:

(a) Those who are employed and have been employed for the preceding twelve consecutive months in one of the following categories:

- (1) Publishers, editors, reporters or correspondents employed full time by newspapers, press associations, news and feature syndicates, regularly published magazines, or national newsletters.
- (2) Writers employed full time on news staffs of radio or television stations, persons who write and broadcast news on their own programs, or news commentators.
- (3) Writers or editors on public information staffs of government departments or non-profit organizations whose full-time employment is the preparation and dissemination of news, either press, periodical, photographic, radio or television.
- (4) Writers of professional journalistic standing self-employed full time in publicity and/or public relations who are sources of information regularly used by the news media or employed full time in publicity and/or public relations by organizations having newsworthy information for the general public.
- (5) Writers or editors of professional journalistic standing employed full time on staffs of regularly published and professionally recognized national publications covering the fields of trade and industry or the professions.
- (6) Photographers or cartoonists employed full time by newspapers, press associations, news or feature syndicates, national magazines or in connection with motion picture or television news reels.

(b) Those employed in one of the above categories whose cumulative employment in one or more of the above categories, including their current work, amounts to two years.



(c) Free lance writers and authors of books whose writings constitute their principal means of support.

(d) Past presidents of the club.

*Section 3.* Inactive members shall be former active members who have been professionally inactive for one year. They may attend all club meetings and participate in discussions. They shall have no vote. Such members re-engaging in professional work which meets active membership requirements shall be reinstated to active classification upon approval by a majority vote of the Membership Committee and the Board of Governors.

*Section 4.* Associate members shall be women in official life who hold high ranking positions in government, either elected or appointed, and who are newsworthy; women, who over a period of years have achieved distinction in their own names by making outstanding newsworthy contributions in the arts, the sciences, education, government, civic affairs or social services, and who are currently active in such fields; or wives of high ranking officials of the United States, foreign governments, or international organizations.

Associate members may attend all club meetings and participate in discussion. They shall have no vote. They shall have a representative on the Board of Governors selected from their number by the President with the approval of the Board and she shall have a vote on the Board only. The number of Associate members shall not exceed the number of Active members.

*Section 5.* Honorary members shall be wives of the Presidents of the United States and women who have achieved national or international distinction.

## Article II

### Election to Membership

*Section 1.* The procedure for nomination and election to membership shall be as follows:

(a) The candidate for Active membership shall be proposed by an Active member in good standing, and seconded by two other Active members in good standing. Application shall be in writing on a form provided for such purpose. The application shall be sent to the Membership Committee Chairman accompanied by sufficient documentary proof including press clippings, tear-sheets, news releases, or scripts, and letters from editors or employers to establish the record of eligibility.

(b) The candidate for Associate membership shall be proposed in the manner prescribed in (a) above, except that samples of work when they do not apply shall not be required. Written qualifications, properly substantiated, shall be supplied by the sponsor. In addition to the above, the Board of Governors by a three-fourths vote of those present and voting at any duly constituted meeting may propose for Associate membership women whose eligibility is unquestioned.

(c) The candidate for Honorary membership shall be selected by a three-fourths vote of the Board of Governors, approved by a three-fourths vote of the Active membership present and voting at any duly constituted meeting, and invited to membership by the President.

(d) Sponsors of any candidate shall hold themselves available to the Membership Committee and to the Board of Governors to answer questions on their candidate.

*Section 2. (a)* The Membership Committee shall pass upon the eligibility of the candidate for membership and, upon election by the Board of Governors (by a two-thirds vote), the candidate's name and a brief statement of her qualifications shall be circulated to the membership. Any member desiring to protest admission of a candidate on the basis of eligibility as outlined in Article I, Section 2 through 5, shall do so in writing to the President and the Chairman of the Membership Committee within one week of the date of circularizing notice. All such protests shall be placed before the Board of Governors for appropriate action.

(b) The elected candidate shall be informed by the Membership Chairman of her election. The President shall personally write candidates of their election.

*Section 3.* Upon payment of initiation fee and annual dues, each member shall be entitled to a membership card and to all the rights, privileges, and advantages, of her class of membership, except that Associate members and Honorary members shall be exempt from initiation fees, and that Honorary members shall be exempt for life from paying dues. Initiation fees and dues shall be sent directly to the Treasurer.

*Section 4.* Candidates who are elected and who accept membership between June 1 and December 31 of any year shall pay the full dues for that fiscal year. Those who accept membership after December 31 shall pay one-half the annual dues, except those accepting membership on or after March 1 shall pay one-fourth the annual dues for that fiscal year.

*Section 5.* In the event a candidate proposed for any classification is rejected, her name may not be proposed for membership in the same classification again for one year.

*Section 6.* Members who have resigned, or who have been dropped for non-payment of dues or non-payment of any other financial obligation to the club, and who wish to resume membership shall comply with all the requirements for new membership except the payment of initiation fees. They shall be required to liquidate all past due accounts before new membership application may be submitted to the Membership Committee by their sponsors.

*Section 7.* In order to give disinterested, objective consideration to membership applications, members of the Membership Committee shall not sponsor or second applications for membership while serving on the committee; nor shall the President sponsor or second applications.

## Article III

### Board of Governors

*Section 1. (a)* The Board of Governors shall consist of the duly elected officers, three elected Governors, who shall be Active members, and one Governor, who shall be an Associate member as provided in Article I, Section 4. In addition thereto, the retiring President shall serve as a governor for the ensuing year.

(b) The Board of Governors shall have direction of the affairs, funds, property, and activities of the club, and the administration of the club office.

(c) The Board of Governors shall meet within two weeks after the Annual Meeting and thereafter shall meet monthly upon call of the President. Six members shall constitute a quorum. Special meetings of the Board may be called at the discretion of the President or by notice signed by any 5 members of the Board and sent to all Board members.

(d) Before April 1 of each year, the Board of Governors shall review the membership roster to determine the active or inactive status of members.

(e) The Board of Governors, in its discretion, may request the resignation of a member thereof who fails to attend three consecutive meetings of the Board without good cause shown.

## Article IV

### Election to Office

*Section 1.* The annual procedure for nomination and election of officers and of the three elective Governors shall be as follows:

(a) A Nominating Committee of three Active members who have been Active members in good standing for the preceding three years, and were not members of the Nominating Committee the previous year, shall be set up. Two of these members shall be elected by secret ballot at the regular business meeting in January and one shall be appointed by the current Board of Governors from its membership. The names of the Chairman and the members of her Committee shall be furnished to the Membership in the February Club Letter.

(b) Active members in good standing may recommend to the Nominating Committee prior to March 15th candidates for office to be elected at the annual meeting in May. After drawing up its slate of candidates, the Nominating Committee shall (1) post the slate on the club bulletin board; and (2) circularize the slate to the membership at least 10 days prior to the regular April business meeting. Nominations of other candidates may be made from the floor at the April business meeting, providing that at least 10 Active members in good standing signify in writing approval of each such nominee. No nominations shall be made without the consent of the nominee.

(c) The names of all candidates nominated shall be circulated to the membership following the April business meeting.

(d) Officers and the three elective Governors shall be elected at the annual meeting in May. Election shall be by secret ballot unless the candidates are unopposed, in which case the Recording Secretary may be directed to cast a unanimous ballot. A majority vote of Active members in good standing present and voting shall constitute election.

*Section 2.* Officers and Governors shall take office immediately upon their election. They shall be elected for terms of one year. No Officer or Governor shall be eligible to serve in the same capacity more than two consecutive years, with the exception of the Treasurer, who may serve at the pleasure of the membership.

*Section 3.* Should the office of President become vacant before the expiration of her term, the First Vice President shall assume the duties of the President for the unexpired term.

*Section 4.* Vacancies in all offices except that of President shall be filled for the unexpired terms by a majority vote of the Board of Governors.

*Section 5.* Only Active members in good standing shall be eligible to vote, hold office, or serve on the Board of Governors, except that under the provisions of Article I, Section 4, one Governor shall be an Associate member.

## Article V

### Duties of Officers

*Section 1.* The President shall preside at all meetings of the Board of Governors and of the Club, be ex-officio a member of all the committees, prepare the monthly club letter and perform such other duties as pertain to that office. Those duties shall include the appointment of a Parliamentarian who shall be a non-voting member of the Board of Governors and who shall advise the President, the Board of Governors and the membership concerning interpretation of the Constitution and By-Laws.

*Section 2.* In the absence or disability of the President, the duties of her office shall devolve upon an Officer in the following order: First Vice President, Second Vice President, Recording Secretary, Corresponding Secretary, Treasurer, Historian.

*Section 3.* The Recording Secretary shall keep a record of all meetings of the club and the Board of Governors. Immediately following the annual meeting at which new officers are elected she shall notify all banks, building and loan associations and trust companies which serve as depositories for club funds, of any change in the officers who are empowered to sign and countersign checks, who may receive statements, or who have access to the safe deposit box. She shall have custody of the corporate seal of the club. She shall perform such other duties as may be prescribed by the Board of Governors.

*Section 4.* The Corresponding Secretary shall keep an up-to-date classified list of the members of the club, see that the mailing list is kept current, prepare and direct the mailing of the annual Membership Directory and conduct correspondence as directed by the President. She shall receive and acknowledge membership resignations and shall report such resignations immediately after receipt to the President, the Treasurer and the Membership Chairman, and to the Board of Governors at its first meeting following receipt of such resignations. She shall perform such other duties as may be prescribed by the Board of Governors and shall make an annual report to the club.

*Section 5.* The Treasurer shall have charge of all funds, securities, and other financial assets of the club. She shall collect all dues and make such disbursements as shall be authorized by the President. All checks shall be signed by the Treasurer and countersigned by the President. In the absence of either officer, the checks may be signed or countersigned by the First Vice President or the Finance Chairman. The Treasurer shall report monthly to the Board of Governors and at each club business meeting on the financial condition of the club. She

shall make a complete report for the fiscal year at the annual meeting, and shall furnish the membership with an annual financial statement. Her books shall be audited annually. She shall be a member of the Finance Committee.

*Section 6.* The Historian shall have custody of all historical matter pertaining to the club. She shall keep an up-to-date historical record of the club, shall prepare an annual report to the club, and may assist the President in preparing the club newsletter. She also shall perform such other duties as may be prescribed by the Board of Governors.

## Article VI

### Committees

*Section 1.* There shall be the following standing committees: Membership, House, Program, Publicity, Finance and By-Laws. The chairman of each of these committees shall be appointed by the President with the approval of the Board of Governors. Each chairman shall appoint the members of her committee, with the approval of the President.

*Section 2.* There shall be such special committees as may be deemed advisable by the Board of Governors. The chairmen of these committees shall be appointed by the President with the approval of the Board of Governors. Each chairman shall appoint the members of her committee, with the approval of the President.

*Section 3.* The President shall outline the duties of all committees to the chairmen thereof.

*Section 4.* The chairmen of the standing committees shall report to the Board of Governors at its monthly meetings, and to the club at the monthly and annual meetings. Chairmen of special committees shall report to the Board or at any business meeting at the request of the President.

## Article VII

### Meetings

*Section 1.* The annual meeting shall be held on the fourth Monday in May of each year when Officers and Governors shall be elected and final reports of Officers and committee chairmen shall be made. A copy of each annual report shall be provided to the Recording Secretary at this meeting.

*Section 2.* Regular business meetings shall be held on the fourth Monday of each month except June, July, August and December, or unless otherwise designated by the Board of Governors.

*Section 3.* Special meetings may be held at any time upon the call of the President or the Board of Governors, provided at least 72 hours notice of such meetings shall have been given to the membership, together with a statement of the purpose or purposes of the call. Only such business as is specified in the call shall be considered at a special meeting.

*Section 4.* Twenty-five Active members in good standing shall constitute a quorum at any meeting of the club.

## Article VIII

### Finance

*Section 1. Funds.* The funds of the club shall consist of the following separate accounts—the General Fund, and the Building Fund.

(a) The General Fund shall be derived from annual dues and other sources and shall be used for club operating expenses. Portions of this fund, if deemed by the Board of Governors to be in excess of operating needs, may be transferred to other funds by a majority vote of the Board of Governors, or used for other club purposes by a majority vote of the Board.

(b) The Building Fund, established for the purpose of obtaining a clubhouse, shall be dispensed only on recommendation of the Board of Governors and by a majority vote of Active members in good standing present and voting at a regular business meeting or special meeting.

*Section 2. Charge Accounts:* Members shall not be permitted charge accounts for club events or for any reason.

*Section 3. Good Standing:* (a) The term "good standing" as used in these By-laws shall be interpreted to mean that a member's current dues are paid and that no indebtedness to the Club is in arrears.

(b) A member who is not in good standing shall not be eligible to vote, hold office, serve on the Board of Governors nor on committees, and may, upon determination by the Board of Governors, lose all privileges of the club. For special rules pertaining to dues delinquencies see Article IX, Section 5.

## Article IX

### Dues and Initiation Fees

*Section 1.* The annual dues of the club shall be:

(a) Active or Inactive members residing within the Washington Metropolitan Area as herein defined \$30.00, provided, however, that persons who have been active members of the club for at least ten years, upon becoming inactive in their profession and reaching 65 years of age, shall pay dues in the amount of \$15.00.

(b) Active or Inactive members residing outside the Washington Metropolitan Area as herein defined, \$15.00.

(c) Associate members, \$50.00.

(d) Honorary members shall pay no dues.

As referred to herein the Washington Metropolitan Area is defined as the area within a radius of 50 miles from the center of Washington.

*Section 2.* The initiation fee for Active members shall be ten dollars (\$10.00), payable at the time invitation for membership is accepted. ~~Associate and~~ Honorary members shall pay no initiation fee.

*Section 3.* Members who are affected by illness, retirement, or other special circumstances may be exempt from payment of dues at the discretion of the Board.

*Section 4.* The fiscal year shall be from June 1 to May 31. All dues are payable by July 1.

*Section 5. Arrears:* (a) Notice of arrears in dues shall be mailed September 1.

(b) Any member delinquent in dues November 1 shall lose all privileges of the club until dues are paid in full. A final notice shall be sent by the Treasurer on November 1 to all members delinquent on that date.

(c) If dues are not paid by November 15, the names of delinquent members shall be posted in the clubroom for two weeks.

(d) Any member in arrears on December 1 shall be dropped from membership and shall be so notified by the Treasurer.

## Article X

### Amendment of the By-Laws

These By-laws may be amended at a regular or special business meeting by a two-thirds favorable vote of Active members in good standing present and voting, provided that a quorum is present and that notice and text of such amendment or amendments shall have been sent to the membership at least ten days in advance of the meeting.

## Article XI

### Parliamentary Authority

The rules contained in Robert's Rules of Order shall govern this club in all cases to which they are applicable and in which they are not inconsistent with these By-Laws.
