IT ALSO DOES NOT SUPPORT COMMERCIAL, INDUSTRIAL, INFORMATIONAL, OR EDUCATIONAL WORK.

THIS PROGRAM AWARDS PRODUCTION GRANTS TO EMERGING ARTISTS WHO MAKE CREATIVE USE OF THEIR RESPECTIVE MEDIA. THE FOUNDATION SUPPORTS ARTISTS WHOSE WORK SHOWS PROMISE OF EXCELLENCE. THESE ARTISTS WILL MOST OFTEN BE IN THE EARLY STAGES OF THEIR CAREERS AND WILL NOT HAVE HAD THE SUPPORT NEEDED TO ACHIEVE MAJOR RECOGNITION FOR THEIR WORK. ONLY APPLICANTS WHO HAVE TOTAL CREATIVE CONTROL OF THEIR PROJECTS QUALIFY FOR SUPPORT. THIS PERSON IS USUALLY IDENTIFIED AS THE DIRECTOR.

THE SERVICE PROGRAM REPRESENTS THE DONATED TIME OF FOUNDATION STAFF AND RELATED EXPENSES TO OTHER NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATIONS, INDIVIDUAL ARTISTS, GOVERNMENTAL AGENCIES, AND NON-PROFIT TASK FORCES AND COMMITTEES.
