Dear Parents/Guardians of Fourth & Eighth Grade Students:

The Wisconsin Student Assessment System (WSAS) is a statewide accountability program developed by the Department of Public Instruction (DPI) to provide schools and parents information on the knowledge and skills students have learned. Both federal and Wisconsin laws require that students in grades 4, 8 and 10 take the Wisconsin Knowledge and Concepts Examination (WKCE) in the subject areas of science and social studies.

This standardized test is composed of some items specifically designed for Wisconsin and some commercially developed questions used in schools across the country. Each subtest requires students to demonstrate their knowledge by selecting responses to questions in the subject areas of science and social studies.

The Lake Country board-adopted Promotion Policy requires students to earn points for promotion from fourth and eighth grade. Students may earn points toward promotion based on their performance on each WKCE subtest.

This year's testing window runs from October 27 thru November 7. Testing schedules are as follows:

Grade 4	Tuesday, October 28 & Wednesday, October 29 (mornings)
Grade 8	Monday, October 27 (afternoon)

Please make a concerted effort to have your child at school during scheduled testing sessions. Testing needs to be completed and submitted to the testing company by November 7, 2014. If your child is absent during the testing period, a make-up opportunity will be scheduled which will require your child to be pulled out of class. You can help your child do well on the tests by:

- Encouraging your child to give his/her best effort
- Ensuring your child gets a good night's rest prior to testing
- Having your child eat a nutritious breakfast

Scores from the WKCE are reported in the proficiency categories of "Advanced", "Proficient," "Basic," and "Minimal" based on score ranges established by the State Superintendent of Public Instruction. The WKCE results will be available to parents in February of 2015. If you have any questions or concerns or if your child(ren) will be absent during testing, please contact your child's teacher or me as soon as possible to schedule alternative testing times.
