DISCLOSED THAT COLONEL THO, THE BRIGADE COMMANDER, PLUS AN ADDITIONAL 15 OFFICERS WERE REPORTEDLY CAPTURE. IN ADDITION, THE ASSISTANT BATTALION COMMANDER OF THE 2ND BATTALION AND FOUR MAJORS WERE INCLUDED IN THOSE CAPTURED. THE USE OF INCORRECT COORDINATES BY THE 1ST INFANTRY BATTALION WAS DISCLOSED BY BINH TRAM 33 WHEN THE BINH TRAM STATED THAT UNSPECIFIED FIRE WAS STRIKING \$CIVILIANS\$, AND DIRECTIONS TO FIRE AT NEW COORDINATES (XD 493 329, 16-34N 186-23E) WERE NOTED. OTHER COMMUNICATIONS FROM BINH TRAM 33 TO ALL UNITS ON 26 FEBRUARY WARNED OF CHEMICAL ATTACKS. THE BINH TRAM STATED THAT A COMMUNIQUE FROM THE 559TH TRANSPORTATION GROUP ON 19 FEBRUARY REVEALED THAT UNITS OF BINH TRAM 41 WERE ATTACKED BY F-4'S AND A-4'S 19 TIMES. THE BINH TRAM ALSO DISCLOSED THAT THERE WAS AN INCREASED USE OF INCENDIARY BOMBS. CONCEERNING POSSIBLE CHEMICAL ATTACKS, THE FOLLOWING INSTRUCTIONS WERE GIVEN, USE FACE CLOTHS, WATER CANTEENS OF WATER-PROOF MATERIAL AND REVIEW THE HEMICAL PROTECTIVE MEASURES RECOMMENDED BY THE MEDICAL PERSONNEL.
