New & Improved & Still Remote!
Live PGC trainings for Adults has re-
turned. Remote option ends Sept/2021

The Child Advocacy office is now providing 'live' weekly PGC trainings on Zoom through Virtus. Just go to the usual Virtus.org, the 'Live Training' tab and 'Pre-register for an upcoming live training session' – and you will find the schedule for adults to complete their PGC requirement with the Archdiocese of Boston via Zoom (Braintree). You will also see that other Live sessions are being offered throughout the diocese so an individual may find one either in their own parish or close to home. If your parish would like to offer a live training through Zoom, please let us know if you need help with how to best do that.

If an individual is able to join one of the above live trainings, then this would take the place of the online combined PGC + Mandated Reporter trainings that have been required during covid precautions. So if you take the live training, you do not have to take the online Mandated Reporter training since it is included in the live training.

Moises Rodrigues will be providing these live trainings weekly through June. There will be a couple of weeks off in July, but then he plans to return offering two weekly trainings starting in the end of July with one being available on the weekends to allow for more accessibility for participants.

Live trainings, be it in-person or on Zoom (or some other platform), are preferable because they allow for questions and discussion which is where much of the learning takes place. We encourage everyone who is able to take part in a live training. Also know that, assuming that covid restrictions continue to be lifted, in September of 2021 we will be eliminating the temporary option for taking the online training instead of a live training.

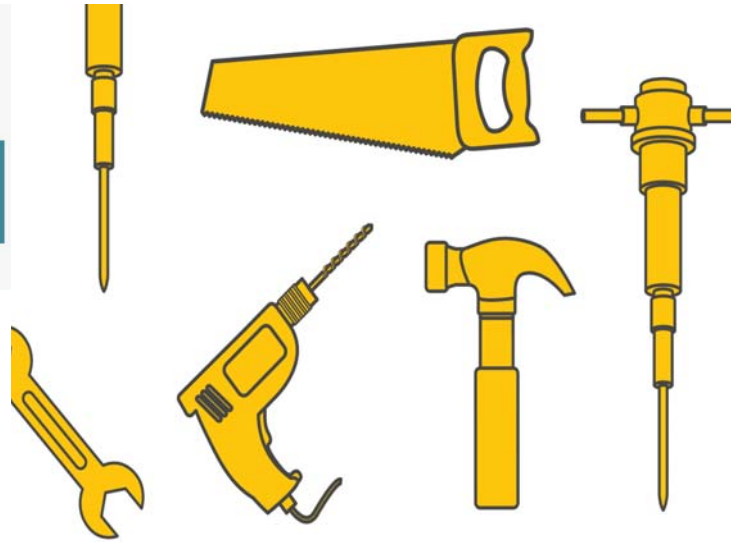

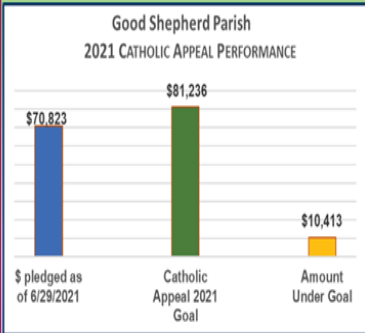

Effective June 5th

The Archdiocese of Boston Office of Risk Management:

Given the new State of Massachusetts protocols that go into place on May 29, the following guidance is issued for the parishes of the Archdiocese of Boston.

General Guidelines

- **As of May 29, 2021**, vaccinated people are no longer required to wear masks or socially distance in our parishes.
 - This statement applies to worship and other parish activities, but not to schools and not to the office space. Further guidelines will be issued for those two areas.
 - Parishes and pastors will not be policing the population. Every parishioner and every family will be expected to make a sound, reasonable decision about when they are ready to take off their masks and be near other people. No pastor and no parish will be expected to ask people whether or not they have been vaccinated.
 - All parishes must publish something like the following statement: "As of May 29, masks are no longer required for vaccinated people in the State of Massachusetts. The State does advise that non-vaccinated people continue to wear masks." The statement should be published in bulletins and on web sites, and announced at Mass.
 - All parishes should strongly consider communicating the following points clearly to their parishioners:
 - The dispensation from the obligation for coming to Sunday Mass has been lifted effective 6/20/2021, if a parishioner is feeling ill they should remain at home.
 - It is understood that different people will be ready to take off their masks and sit near one another at different times.
 - Parishes should communicate that they are prepared to accommodate those who are ready to take off their masks and sit near others, and those who are not.
- Some people who are comfortable dropping social distancing may not yet be comfortable taking off their masks. It should be communicated to people that they are free to continue to wear masks as long as they like, and that they will be respected if they choose to do so.

Regarding the Setup of Churches

- Respectful signs in the church should make clear how different sections of the church are being used.
- **It is no longer necessary to regularly disinfect surfaces. Some pastors may decide to continue to do so for a time, but it is not required.**

Regarding the Celebration of the Mass

- Registration for Masses is no longer required, although pastors may desire it to continue for a period while they adjust the seating in their churches.
- Congregational singing is allowed, as are choirs.
- Altar servers may be used.
- **Communion under both species is still not allowed at this time.**

Regarding other Parish Activities

- Food and drink may be served at parish activities.

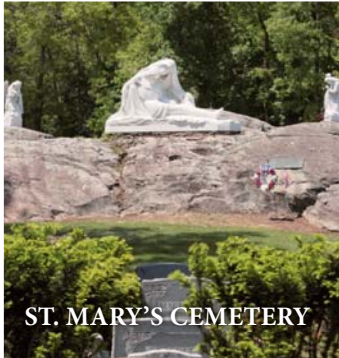
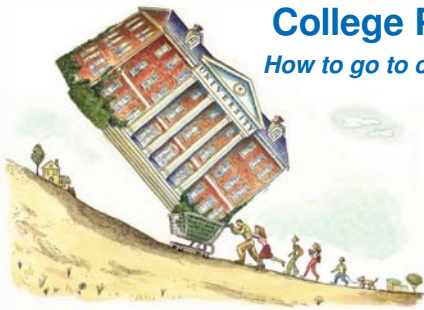
