INTRODUCTION

A discrepancy will appear in some cases in the number of students enrolled among different tables. This is a result of the vagaries of the computer system which does not void a student's enrollment if he drops all his classes prior to the twelfth day. Most tables include these students, while the ethnic data usually does not. The differences are small and do not distort the gross trends.

At the lower division level the number of S grades is significant in English and Math (because of 3121). At the upper division S grades are significant in Curriculum and Instruction and in Health and Physical Education (because of practice teaching). At the graduate level progress grades (P) and incompletes (I) distort the distributions somewhat.

The percentage of F's was added to the percentage of W's to give an indication of the number of students who failed to successfully complete the course. The department having the smallest number of F + W's was ranked number one.
4. Grade distributions were excluded at the graduate level for departments which do not offer a degree at that level because the numbers were too small for meaningful comparisons.
