

Please see the map below for your collection day, based upon the location of your home, beginning January 2, 2018,

Effective January 1, 2018, UWS will be the exclusive waste hauler in the unincorporated area of Valencia County.

HOW MANY CARTS WILL I GET AND WHEN?

Each household will receive the same number of carts that you currently utilize for your trash collection service. If there is a discrepancy in the number of carts delivered or you would like to order additional carts, please contact us and we will make the correction.

Basic service includes:

- Once-a-week automated trash collection service
- One 96 gallon trash cart
- Special Assistance Program for our senior citizen, handicapped, and special needs customers
- Financial Assistance Program for qualifying low-income households
- Senior Citizen Discount Program for qualifying senior citizen home-owners
- Bulky Item Program
- Free recycling opportunities at the Conejo Collection Center

WILL MY COLLECTION DAY CHANGE?

Your collection day will may change. Please refer to the map in this document to determine your collection day, based upon the location of your home.

WHERE DO I SET MY CARTS OUT FOR COLLECTION?

Carts should be positioned at the edge of the street. The handle of the carts should face your house. When your carts are delivered, they will be placed at the best location for pickup. After collection, roll your carts to a safe storage location. Do not leave the carts on the side of the street or road.

WHEN DO I SET MY CARTS OUT?

Carts should be set out for collection by 7:00 a.m. on your collection day. You may set your carts out the night before, but no earlier than 5:00 p.m. After collection, you should remove your carts from the curb by 8:00 p.m. the day of collection and store them in a convenient place near your house. IF YOUR GARBAGE PICKUP IS MISSED, call us at (855) UWSOFNM (855-897-6366). We will return the same day if you call before 3:00 p.m., or on the next collection day if you call after 3:00 p.m.

WHAT ABOUT ITEMS THAT WON'T FIT IN THE CART?

Universal Waste Systems, Inc. (UWS) provides each subscribed household with 2 vouchers so you can take bulky items to the Conejo Collection Center at no charge twice per year. The Conejo Collection Facility is located at 1100 Manzano Expressway in Los Lunas. Examples of bulky items include discarded furniture (chairs, sofas, mattresses, box springs,) and appliances (refrigerators, ranges, washers, dryers, water heaters, etc.) Members of our Special Assistance Program will receive one free on-demand bulky item collection per year at their home. Customers should contact the UWS office to schedule the pickup.

WHAT IF MY CART IS DAMAGED OR STOLEN?

The carts are property of UWS and we expect residents to take reasonable care. They should not be painted, mutilated, altered or modified in any way. If the collection truck damages or destroys your cart, it will be replaced at no cost to you. If the responsibility for the damage of a cart cannot be determined, UWS will replace it free of charge. Customers may be charged for cart replacement upon the second occurrence. Homeowners are encouraged to report cart damage to their insurance company.

Mobile Home Park Owners

Valencia County Ordinance 2017-02, Chapter 50, Solid Waste Management, classifies mobile home waste collection as residential collection and requires that owners provide .5 cubic yards per mobile home per week. Please contact us to schedule an appointment. We will be happy to visit your site and recommend waste solutions.
