And what a night it was! The grand master of ceremonies, Jack "The Rapper" Gibson, was in rare form as he carried the evening's festivities along at a smooth-asvelvet pace. Of course, the Rapper managed to throw the honoree a few of his own distinctive curves. But it was all in the spirit of camaraderie born of decades of working together as pio-

So while we say a reluctant farewell to Al as he gracefully bows out from active participation in the industry, we know that his legacy will always be there to guide and inspire.

ders and Chief Executives of Philadelphia International Records.

Remarked Menon, "I am absolutely delighted at the alliance between Manhattan and Philadelphia International. We regard Kenny and Leon as exceptional talents and are most excited and honored to form this association with them and their distinguished roster of artists."

Commenting on the new merger, Kenny Gamble noted that it reunited the Gamble-Huff team with Bruce Lundvall, among others, with whom they had formerly worked during their highly successful association with CBS. Gamble added that Menon has pledged "the full support of his entire organization, as well as his personal commitment, to the success of this union."

An August release is scheduled for a new album by the O'Jays, Love Fever, the first under the new agreement.

Baton Rouge: In an effort to raise the consciousness of young people about the dangers of child abduction, a new record produced by two Baton Rouge-based deejays, collectively known as "Reality," has debuted on Royal Shield Records.

"My experiences have also shown me how important radio is to black people.

"Although churches and community newspapers remain an important source of information about local events," she continued, put something on radio and it can be heard all over in seconds, inform people on either side of the country. "With black people having

limited access to televi-sion," she further said, "radio is one of our best tools to get information to a large number of black people. No other medium can do that.

For the last nine plus years, Logue-Henry has been employed at Unity, coming to the company first as the director of public relations for the National Black Network (NBN).

NBN serves more than 100 affiliates nationwide with potential to reach 75% of the country's black popula-tion. It is but one of Unity's multi-media properties and operations.

The job grew, and eventually she began to handle public relations and promotion projects for special projects.

She became responsible for developing the network's image in the press, formulating public information strategies, corporate relations and other promotional activity.

In her current position, which she's held for the past two years, Logue-Henry has added to her plethora of responsibilities keeping tabs on important legislation pertaining to the broadcast industry and administrative proceedings of the Federal Communications Commission (FCC).

She's perhaps best known for her co-founding of the World Institute of Black Communications, Inc., Unity's non-profit organization established in 1978 to broaden opportunities in the communications industry for Afro-Americans.

The most visible program sponsored by WIBC is the annual CEBA Awards, which honors those members of the marketing and advertising industry who have shown innovation and excellence in communicating messages to the large consumer audience that is black America.

Logue-Henry's background is as diverse as the many hats she now wears at Unity.

In addition to working as sales consultant for KLM Royal Dutch Airlines, she was an educator and administrative intern with the Yon-

kers Board of Education.

If that's not enough, she was also statewide coordinator of the women's division for the Howard Samuels for Governor campaign. She performed advance publicity work on the presidential campaign by Democratic Sen. Morris Udall.

In keeping with her thirst to contribute to the community, Logue-Henry has also served as a board member of the Westchester Civil Liberties Union and the Nigerian-American Society. She^Ts also been a New York State delegate to the convention of the National Women's Political Caucus and a dele-gate to the White House Conference on Small Business.

Commenting on how her current activity is but a continuum of her previous civic contributions, Logue-Henry said, "Communications, providing information people want and need, is a civic

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THE POINTER SISTERS: IN "CONTACT" AND ON TOP

by Gary Jackson

"The cream always rises to the top." That's an axiom that has held true in many phases of life - but nowhere does it ring louder or clearer than with the music industry and one group of superb vocalists in particu-lar - The Pointer Sisters: Ruth, Anita and June. Since 1973, when the Pointers released their first album, they have experienced the usual peaks and valleys that accompany any music career. But if you can point to one circumstance that literally forced the hands of fate to cause their career to truly skyrocket, then that has to be the musical "contact" of the Pointer Sisters and their exclusive producer since 1978, Richard Perry. "Contact" just so happens

to be the name of the Pointer Sisters' newest album on the RCA label -- following the triple-platinum success of 1984's "Break Out," which saw the Pointers gather armsful of awards and accolades.

For instance: "Break Out" contained four Top-Ten hits, including "Jump (For My Love)," "Automatic," and two singles that had new life breathed into them: "I'm So Excited," a semi-hit several years ago that became a smash in 1984, and "Neutron Dance," a song that wasn't projected to make any kind of noise until it became the anthem for Eddie Murphy's blockbuster movie, "Beverly Hills Cop." Add to those songs a solid black radio hit called "I Need You," and you have one of the strongest sides ever committed to

Recognition in the music industry was quite over-whelming as the Pointers walked away with Grammys for Best Vocals by a Pop Group ("Jump") and Best Vocal Arrangement ("Automatic"). The Sisters also copped top honors for Best Black Video Group and Best Black Recording Group at the American Music Awards at the begin-

ning of 1985.

To get back to the pivotal point of the Pointer Sisters' success story, Richard Perry is perhaps the most natural producer to work with such a group since George Martin produced all of those smash albums by one highly acknowledged supergroup - the Beatles. A complete empathy with the para-

meters of a group is needed for the chemistry to come together. Fortunately, Richard Perry has, in the Pointer Sisters, a group whose vocal flexibility knows no boundaries. Their highly charged vocals add excitement to even the most mundane arrangements.

A background steeped in the rich tradition of gospel music -- compliments of their father, the late Reverend Elton Pointer -helped to empower the Pointer Sisters to tackle any musical assignment fearless-Their father tried to distract the Sisters from blues and jazz: 'the devil's music.' Only thing that kept the Reverend from succeeding was the fact that he picked a bad (from the church's point of view) location to have children, that is, the music-rich environs of the Bay Area of Oakland, San Francisco and Berkeley, California.

The Bay Area had a cornucopia of groups such as Tower of Power, the Jeffer-son Airplane, Santana, the Grateful Dead, Elvin Bishop and more, all of whom played at the now legendary Fill-more West. Most of these groups had heard of the vocal prowess of the Pointer Sisters and often used them as backup vocalists for both live and studio sessions. It was only a matter of time before someone would commit the Pointer Sisters to vinyl, and that came in 1973.

Blue Thumb Records signed

the group and released a self-titled album to an avalanche of accolades that touted the group as the best thing to happen to vocals since Edison invented the phonograph. Those claims were substantiated by the fact that the first two Pointer Sisters albums went gold and one of the songs, "Fairy Tale," from the second album, "That's A Plenty," won a Grammy for Best Country Vocal Tune. The song, incidentally, was written by Anita and Bonnie Pointer, thus showing that the Sisters had a flair with

the pen, too.

The direction of music favored by the Pointers by the Blue Thumb producers gravitated primarily toward jazz and scat vocal forms, with a slight dip into country. After several years of the same thing, the Pointer Sisters found themselves on a musical treadmill going nowhere. Their forays into nostalgia continued to impress a devoted, but small, listenership that was not enough to support four sisters who also had their own families to feed and clothe. The breaking point came in 1978 when Bonnie split from the group to try her hand at a solo career.

1978 was also the fortuitous year when the Three P's came together: Perry, Pointers and Planet Records. The Pointers were the first group signed to the label, which has since been ab-sorbed by RCA. Such a phenomenally successful marriage as that between Richard Perry and the Pointers could only have been made in music heaven.

Since that time, the Pointers have enjoyed critical and popular acclaim with such hits as "Fire," "Happi-ness," "He's So Shy," and "Slow Hand." Richard Perry has wisely selected material for the Pointer Sisters from a diverse group of songwriters, including Bruce Springsteen, James Ingram, Barry Mann & Cynthia Weil and an assortment of newer talent such as Richard Page, Andy Goldmark, Steve George and others, thus insuring a consistently fresh approach with each album and song.

An important key to Richard Perry's production success is his intuitive ability to keep up with the latest trends in music, from the newest in technological equipment to what's happening on the streets. He has also wisely retained the gospel tradition that started the Pointer Sisters on the road to success. Equally significant is Perry's decision to spread the lead vocal chores evenly throughout the album -- assigning three songs apiece to Ruth, Anita and June. Thus, "Contact" is simply an extension of what got the Pointers to the top and what will keep

them there.
"Contact" picks right up where "Break Out" left off.
"Twist My Arm" rocks right out of the box with searing vocals by Anita and a blistering intro by guitarist Howie Rice. A funky bottom keeps the street sound intact and vital. "Hey You" is one of the Pointer Sisters' few forays into what can be considered social commentary. For example: "Don't you see the lonely children/ beggin' but nobody sees/Hey you/Tell me/What's been going on."
"Pound, Pound, Pound" is a teasingly playful cut sung

by June, who wants more than a call on the phone. "Back In My Arms" is a powerful vocal rendition by Ruth, with strong production throughout. "Burn Down the Night" features raunchy vocals by Anita, complemented by a smoking sax solo.
"Bodies and Souls" reflects
the tempo of the streets
with its 'scratch' intro that flows smoothly into a semi-calypso feel. It must

PALO ALTO/TBA RECORDS PREPARE HOLIDAY RELEASES: SIGN WITH FOREIGN TERRITORIES



It is prudent to prepare for the high holidays in early winter during the searing heat of late summer.

That's exactly what Palo Alto/Tba Records is doing, according to label president Dr. Herb Wong. The executive recently

The executive recently completed recording volume II of his tentatively titled "More Mistletoe Magic," featuring artists such as Dianne Reeves performing "Christmas Waltz." Also planned are Christmas improventries by artists such as Chico Freeman, McCoy Tyner, Phil Woods, and vocal group Rare Silk which features the stylings of Shelia Jordon, Bobbe Norris with Larry Dunlap.

Wong noted that "This is the first time we have four vocal attractions" on one LP.

Last year, Volume I of the holiday album featured

singer Meredith d'Ambrosia accompanied by pianist Hank Jones.

Volume I also featured the Elvin Jones Quintet, Free Flight, the Larry Vuckovich Sextet, the Full Faith and Credit Big Band, the Richie Cole Quintet, the Mal Waldron Quartet and the Les de Merle Sextet.

The holiday LPs are the outgrowth of Wong's annual six-hour Christmas special on KJAZ-FM in San Francisco, where he has been an air personality for nearly 20 years.

"After the first album, we received a lot of mail requesting additional, fresh material," he said, adding, "With this volume, we're seeking different musical environments and interpretive styles."

The LP and cassette will carry an \$8.98 suggested list.

In other news from the label, Palo Alto/Tba also has signed exclusive distribution pacts for Canada, Mexico and the Philippines, and has also renewed an arrangement in Japan.

The label's director of sales, Don Lupo, commenting on the pacts, said that the agreements are part of an aggressive effort to strengthen international distribution this year based on the company's strong sales performances with product by George Howard, Maynard Ferguson, Rare Silk, David Diggs, McCoy Tyner and Victor Feldman's Generation Band.

Bobby Weiss and his One



World of Music company, Palo Alto's exclusive international representative, arranged the licensing pacts.

Starting Aug. 1, the new Canadian distributor is A&M Records Canada Ltd. The company's president, Gerry la Coursiere, signed the deal with PA for manufacturing and distribution of LPs, cassettes and compact discs when they become available for the company later this year.

That same day is the start of a renewed Japanese agreement with Victor Music International, a division of Japan Victor Co. The same

deal applies for this territory.

Two deals that have just gone into effect are with Discos Real in Mexico and Ivory Records Corp. in the Philippines.

Mupo said that pacts in Mexico and the Philippines mark the first time such agreements have been entered in those territories.

Other territories currently selling PA product include Singapore, Hong Kong, New Zealand, Australia, Manila, Malaysia, Thailand, the UK and in Europe.

Under negotiation currently are licensing agreements with Israel, Nigeria, and

Ghana.

be a killer when performed live because of its highly festive mood.

The title cut, "Contact," features staccato background vocals that propel Ruth's husky vocals to raging heights of urgency. Then there's the first single release, "Dare Me." It combines pop sensibilities with a streetwise funk bottom. It's a strong and straightforward song sung with emotional toughness by June (Baby Sister.) A very powerful song. Wrapping up "Contact" is "Freedom," a step away from the rollicking fun that permeates the album.

It's a somber tune that pleads for a lover's attention. A simple yet effective statement on the need for communication in a relationship.

The Pointer Sisters have successfully followed one powerful album ("Break Out") with another equally powerful one ("Contact"). Surely, there must lie more Grammy and American Music awards in the future for the Pointer Sisters and Richard Perry a winning combination that is certainly in "contact" with contemporary musical tastes and trends -- and on top because of it.







"I believe black music is spiritual. That's why Go-Go Music is happening... and blacks that have refused to take part in it thus far will be more than glad to do so once it becomes stylish by way of Mr. Charlie bringing it through his way with his incredible marketing arms and advertising strength and dollars. In Europe, Go-Go is already big and it's only a matter of time before it takes over

time before it takes over here," Kidd said.

The release of "Good to Go," an Island Trading Company feature film scheduled for a Sept. I national debut, features TTED Go-Go Bands: Chuck Brown and the Soul Searchers, Experience Unlimited (EU), Redds and The Boys (see photo), and Trouble Funk. The film promises to capture the essence of what makes Go-Go such a phenomenon with its fans from eight to fifty. ART GARFUNKEL portrays a local reporter who blames Go-Go music for a teen's murder and rape. Later, he realizes his mistake and becomes an advocate for the Go-Go movement.

Other labelmates not in the movie include: MASS EX-TENSION, YUGGIE (the only by Ralph Brown



female Go-Go group), and HOT, COLD SWEAT.

While in Go-Go City, I observed literally thousands of pre-teens, teens and young adults at several clubs one evening that book Go-Go acts. I must say it was a little scary at first to see so many people packed

in each club, dancing to the Go-Go beat, as though they were mesmerized by the multi-percussive, polyrhythmic funk, cowbells and staccato-jabbing rab born lines.

jabbing råb horn lines.
Unlike the Hip-Hop movement (where many major labels exercised a wait-and-see posture before getting

involved with rap music), the Go-Go movement has attracted major label interest - although the music has not become a national phenomenon to date. Shortly after Island Records chief Chris Blackwell signed seven TTED acts to Atlantic (distributors of Island and its independent offshoot, 4th & Broadway Records) and announced plans to film a Go-Go movie, several major labels jumped on the Go-Go andwagon and signed other Go-Go artists right out of Chocolate City.

With millions of dollars invested to date in Go-Go music, perhaps as the old Brook Benton hit suggests, 'it's just a matter of time' before Go-Go starts bustin' loose nationally and becomes a commercial success. I would not want to bet against Go-Go becoming the next dance music craze. What about you black deejays and

retailers?
At press time, MAXX KIDD stated: "TTED Records will not be distributed by Island Records as originally planned. Presently, we are shopping and talking to other major labels. WEA will probably distribute our product."

NEW YORK WATCH

Reliable sources say a new urban pop station is coming to the Big Apple soon, with former WBLS PD, the legendary FRANKIE CROCKER, slated for the PD slot. Inner City Broadcasting chairman PERCY SUTTON reportedly has put together a 1.2 billion bid for Capital Cities TV stations in Detroit (WXYZ), Buffalo (WKEW-TV), and Tampa (WFTS-TV.) The objective is to give minorities a toehold in the TV business, even if it means giving up the lucrative WLIB-AM and WBLS-FM to help raise venture capital. An East Coast pressing plant pioneer is scheduled to open offices in the Apple in the near future. (Stay tuned...)


