Addendum

The report (1984) of the Group on Quantitative Restrictions and Other Non-Tariff Measures (L/5713), adopted by the CONTRACTING PARTIES at their fortieth session, contains the recommendation that contracting parties should make written proposals by the end of April 1985 regarding quantitative restrictions and other non-tariff measures (paragraphs 44(h) and 65(f)).

The attached communication, dated 15 May 1985, has been received from the Permanent Mission of New Zealand.

I have the honour to refer to the decision taken at the 40th Session of the Contracting Parties to adopt the report of the Group on Quantative Restrictions and Other Non Tariff Measures including, in particular, the recommendations concerning the submission of specific written proposals to achieve the liberalisation and elimination of quantative restrictions and the liberalisation of other non tariff measures.

In pursuance of the above decision, I have the honour to convey to you the attached proposals from New Zealand. These are divided into two parts :

Part I : Proposals in respect to items falling within
New Zealand's Import Licensing Schedule

Part II : Proposals in respect to the QRs or other NTMs of other
Contracting Parties

As noted in Part I, it is the intention of the New Zealand Government to move away from import licensing towards the Customs Tariff as the main form of industry assistance. This will provide increased trading opportunities for all

New Zealand's trading partners. Additional import licences are being allocated by means of tender for all goods apart from those covered by industry development plans. These plans have their own specific liberalisation schemes.

A full key to descriptions is contained on pages 2 to 6 of Part I. The main symbols are as follows :

- (a) "T" Subject to global tendering
- (b) 1-16 Subject to specific industry development plans (e.g. 3 (a) Electronics)
- (c) O Products that are likely to be made exempt from licensing once consultations with industry are completed, otherwise they will be tendered.

KEY TO DESCRIPTIONS

"T" - GLOBAL TENDERING ITEMS

It is the New Zealand Government's intention to move away from import licensing towards the Customs Tariff as the main form of industry assistance.

The Government intends to reduce protection by increasing import licence allocations through a global tender scheme.

In November 1984 licences were tendered to increase the level of access available to 10 percent of the domestic market. The Government also announced in the 1984 Budget that the allocation would be increased annually by 5 percent of the domestic market commencing in 1985. This programme will affect those items marked "T".

The global tendering programme will not apply to those items which are subject to industry studies and details are provided separately of import licence phase-out programmes (where applicable) for those industries.

Final agreement has not yet been reached on the details of how the moves to exemption of individual items will be carried out but consultations are currently under way with the commercial sector on this question and moves towards lowering tariffs. A decision on these matters is expected towards the end of 1985.

INDUSTRY DEVELOPMENT PLANS (1-16)

1. Canned Fruit

The aim of the plan is to achieve an overall liberalisation of imports of canned fruit. Licence is to be tendered over a 3-year period, followed by a 5-year phase-out of import licensing.

2. Ceramics

The plan provided for the exemption of mosaic tiles immediately. Licence was then put up for tender in all ceramic product groups and exemption from licence for these goods will be phased in over a 3 to 7 year period.

3(a) Electronics

The plan which commenced on 1 January 1984, is designed to stimulate the electronics industry by diverting it from its present emphasis on consumer goods towards more sophisticated high technology areas. Import licensing will be gradually phased out through the allocation of increasing amounts of licence by tender over a 3-year tariff-testing period, before final exemption.

The Normal rates of duty will be held at current levels during the tariff-testing period, but DC preferences will largely be removed.

3(b) Electric Motors

Import licences are to be considered under the Manifestly Excessive Price/Quality/Technology Differentials policy with a manifestly excessive margin of 40%, 30% and 20% (above the duty-paid import price) in years 1 to 3 respectively. Import licensing controls will be completely removed at the end of the third year. The Normal rate of duty of 30% and DC preference rate of 15% will be retained over the 3-year period.

4. Footwear

The plan which is to run for 7 years from 1 July 1983, provides for better access to imported raw materials and components, and a liberalisation of imports of finished footwear through the tendering of an additional 6 percent of the domestic market.

5. Glassware

The plan is to run for 6 years with a 3-year tariff-testing period followed by a 3-year phase-out of import licensing. Heat-resistant glassware of a kind used for cooking purposes was exempted on 1 July 1983. The remainder of heat-resistant glassware, excluding cups, saucers, plates and dishes, was exempted on 1 July 1984. Other glass tableware was also exempted on that date. Drinking glasses, small glass containers and lighting glassware have been tendered.

6. Margarine

Consultations have been started with the object of reactivating the study.

7. Motor Vehicles

The Motor Vehicle Plan, which was announced on 12 December 1984, covers a 4-year period with a review at the end of the third year. The plan provides for gradually increasing access for built-up vehicles and componentry. Its aim is to encourage efficiency and competitiveness within the industry while at the same time providing continued assistance through the tariff and increased export opportunities.

8. Packaging

The plan was designed to identify and encourage those packing operations which can operate on an internationally competitive basis. The initial tariff-testing period, during which time goods are tendered to establish appropriate duty rates has been completed for some products and a range of goods were exempt on 9 March 1984, and duty rates adjusted.

9. Plastics

The overall aim of the 6-year plan which commenced in 1982 is to encourage the industry to achieve a higher level of efficiency. There is an initial tariff-testing period of 3 years, during which time interim tariff levels are being tested to establish final levels for the following 3 years, when import licensing will be phased out altogether.

10. Rubber Goods

The plan provided for the immediate exemption of bicycle tubes and certain cycle tyres as well as moulds for making general rubber goods products, other than tyres. The revised tariff was implemented on 1 January 1984. Tender licence has been made available on the basis of 2.5 percent of domestic production. Three tenders rounds have been completed, with the fourth due in September 1985.

11. Shipbuilding

The plan, which is designed to assist the development of the shipbuilding industry in a manner complementary to the development of the fishing industry, introduced a variety of assistance measures, notably a bounty scheme.

12. Starch and Related Products

The plan is designed to encourage the sole New Zealand producer, New Zealand Starch Products Ltd, to reduce costs through a restructuring of its operations and by increasing its throughput. Present tariff levels, excluding those for Australia, on all products covered by the study will remain unchanged during the phase-out of import licensing, and will be reviewed prior to licensing exemption on 1 July 1989. Wheat gluten was exempted on 1 March 1984.

13. Textile

The plan is designed to reduce the cost disadvantages of the apparel industry, hitherto inherent in the use of domestic materials, to the point where garment manufacturers have a better base upon which to mount sustainable export growth while at the same time servicing the domestic market under justifiable levels of community cost.

14. Tobacco

The industry study indicated an over-supply situation. The Government has taken steps to encourage growers to reduce production but the proposal to move the industry gradually from import licensing to tariff protection has not yet been implemented.

15. Tyres

The plan provides for the phasing-out of import licensing control over a 6-year period, through gradually increasing the amount of licence tendered. Interim duty measures have been introduced for the first 3 years, to be reviewed on the basis of information provided by tendering. Tariff levels set in the review will apply from 1 January 1989.

16. Writing Instruments

The plan is aimed at replacing import licensing with the tariff as the major means of protecting domestic manufacturers of low-cost pens. The plan is being modified to provide for long-term tariffs to be set in January 1986 and for import licensing to be phased out. High-cost pens which are not made in New Zealand, are exempt from import licensing. Parts and fittings of writing instruments and refills and writing cartridges, school chalks and sheepmarking crayons will be exempt from 1 July 1985.

OTHER ITEMS NOT TENDERED

1. A = Approval items

At the discretion of the Minister of Customs 'Approval' items are free of duty and normally exempt and therefore not subject to licensing.

2. OD = Other than may be determined

These items are not manufactured in New Zealand. They are able to enter free or at low rates of duty.

3. G1 = global licence on demand

Requests for licence are granted on demand.

4. Sp = SPARTECA

The tendering of goods under SPARTECA has been deferred until consultations are completed with Pacific Forum Island countries.

5. SA = Sugar Agreement

Currently subject to negotiation with New Zealand Sugar Refinery.

6. WA = Wheat Agreement

The wheat and flour industry is the subject of a review which was agreed to by the Cabinet Development and Marketing Committee on 10 October 1984. Special arrangements have been made in line with the review.

7. O = Proposed exemptions

Products which are likely to be made exempt once consultations with industry are finished, otherwise they will be tendered.

8. SD = Special deferment

As a result of New Zealand Steel developments these items are under review.

9. * = These items have not yet been tendered nor are they covered by any industry development plan.
