Residents and businesses in a large section of the Lower Ninth Ward-Holy Cross area will experience low water pressure Wednesday through Friday March 18-20 and Monday, March 23, 2015 from 8 a.m. 4 p.m. all four days. A contractor working for the Sewerage and Water Board will tie in a new 24" water main that serves the area.
