

Through this arrangement, Anne-Marie Soulliere, the Foundation Director, is indirectly compensated for her services devoted to the Foundation. The amount of her compensation properly allocable to work for the Foundation was \$43,412.

Background

- ◆ Since the founding of Fidelity Investments in the 1940s, the company has had a tradition of charitable giving, the Foundation formalized that commitment. The Fidelity Foundation was established in 1965 by Edward C. Johnson 2d, founder of Fidelity Investments, and Edward C.
