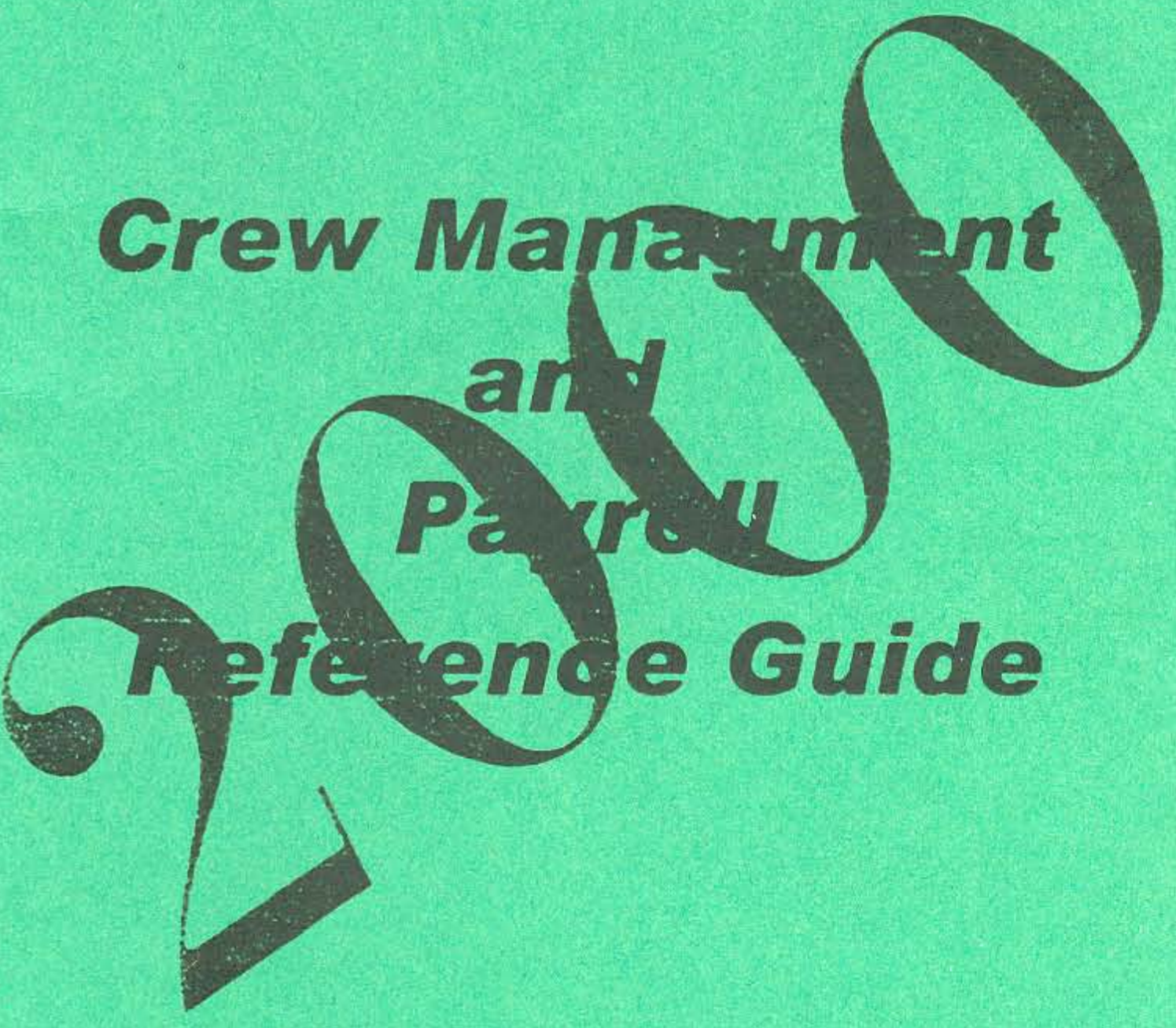

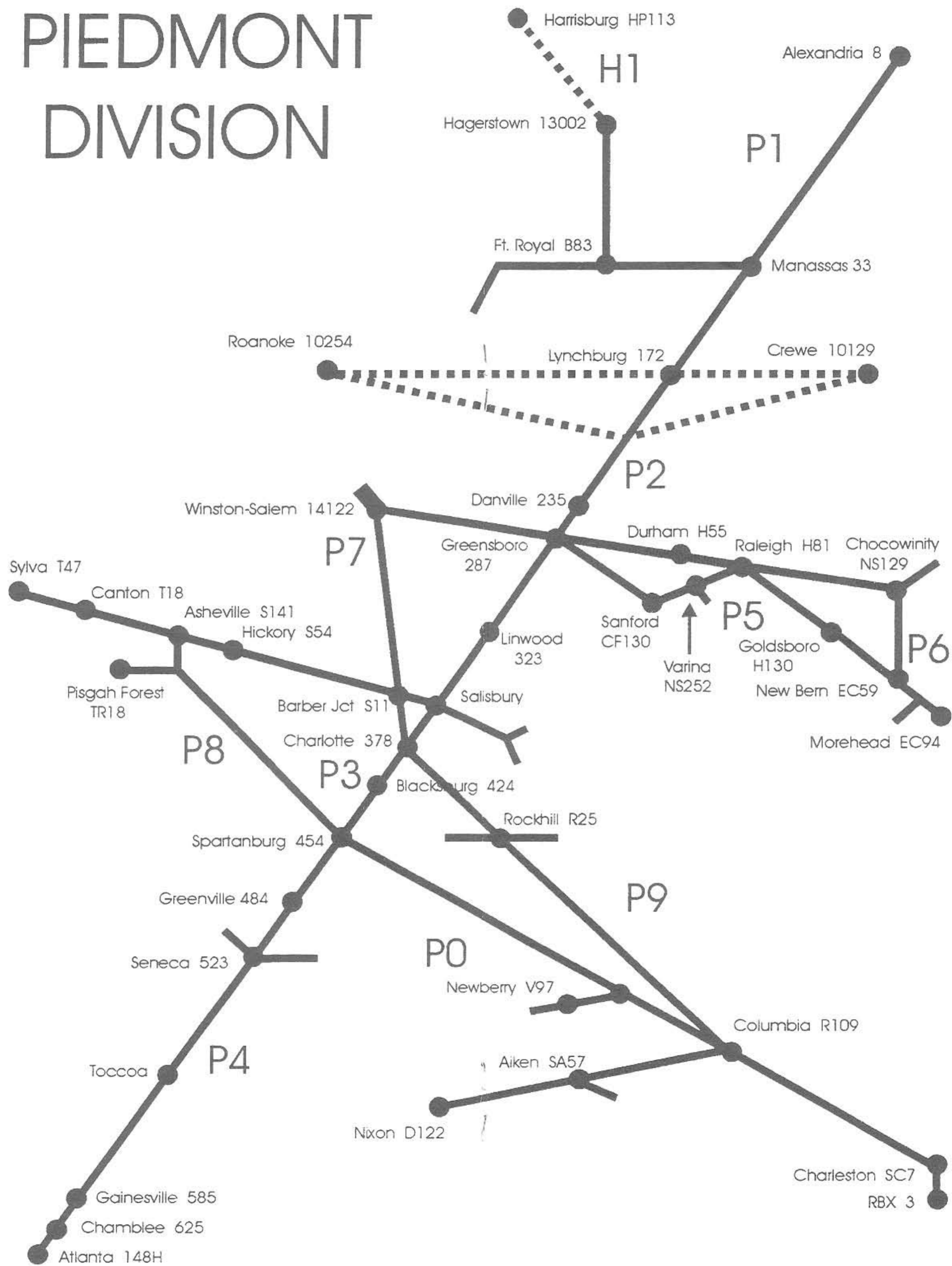

Deadhead Instructions

In order to compensate employees more accurately for deadheading, each deadhead move will be assigned a deadhead symbol at the time it is called, which will be used by the payroll department to calculate pay. This **deadhead symbol will be in one of two forms.**

(1) A number starting with 470-489 or X70-X89 followed by the line segment and day of the month the deadhead is called. This format is used when an entire crew is being deadheaded terminal to terminal and will require one member of the crew to tie-up the symbol just as you would a service time slip. An example of this is 478V321

When called to deadhead from terminal to terminal on a series 470-489 or X70-X89 train symbol, you must:

Tie-up the deadhead symbol just as you would a service time slip. Enter payroll claims associated with this deadhead on the deadhead tie-up screen. Complete the FRA Hours of Service reporting on this tie-up.

(2) The other type of deadhead symbol starts with the letters DH, followed by three sequence numbers, then two more numbers representing the day of the month the deadhead is called. This format is used for individual deadheads and would have to be tied up by the individual that is deadheading. An example of this is DH09114.

When called to deadhead individually to protect an assignment at another location you should receive a deadhead symbol that starts with the letters DH and you must:

Tie-up the deadhead symbol just as you would a service time slip. Enter payroll claims associated with this deadhead on the deadhead tie-up screen. Complete the FRA Hours of Service reporting on this tie-up.

Deadheads to or from a point on line of road resulting from hours of service relief will not be given a deadhead symbol. These will be reported in your total time on duty (Note: A separate deadhead report for FRA hours of service is still required.)

Deadhead symbols will be used regardless of whether you are called in combined or separate service and regardless of whether the deadhead is for one individual or an entire crew. At tie-up time, a screen will be presented for tying up both deadheads and service trips. Payroll claims associated with deadheads back to the home terminal, such as detention time ('DE'), personal auto miles ('DM') or meals ('M1' or 'M2'), should be made on the deadhead symbol just as you would report claims in connection with your service trip.

Calculation of pay for combined deadheads:

Payroll will combine the time/miles on combined service deadheads and service trips when the records are processed in the payroll system. The deadhead record will remain on the database but display no money as that has been paid on the service trip.

Calculation of pay for separate deadheads:

Payroll will pay separate deadheads under the deadhead authority symbol.

Additional Instructions

When performing hours of service relief outside switching limits, the following information explains how this service must be reported and the instructions you must follow in submitting applicable claims:

1. Called in Freight Service - For road service crews required to perform relief service outside switching limits, at the initial terminal prior to the service trip or at the final terminal after your service trip, enter claim code PH on your service time slip.

Any penalty claims for relief service outside the switching limits must be made on the secondary tie-up screen of the relief train using claim code 'PH' (Penalty - Relief Service). You must enter remarks that include the information detailing the location and miles to the turning point of the train being relieved. This claim will be routed for approval.

2. Called in Relief Service - When called to perform relief service only, Crew Management will report you on one train symbol. Any claims for a second day's pay under the short trip and turn-around provisions of your agreement should be made using claim codes 'RM' (Short Turn Around - Miles) and 'RT' (Short Turn Around - Time). Both codes must be entered on the secondary tie-up screen as follows:

Additional Instructions (Cont'd)

Claim Code 'RM' - Enter the claim code 'RM', and in the amount field, enter the miles claimed for the first day. All miles run in excess of this will be paid on the second day if you have performed qualifying service. If you have made multiple trips, a logical breaking point would be the start of the trip wherein you are claiming your second day under this rule. The miles run to this point would be reported under 'RM'. The time reported under 'RT' should correspond to your mileage reported under 'RM'. Remarks Required.

Claim Code 'RT' - Enter the claim code 'RT', and in the amount field, enter the clock time (example: 0300p) you left the terminal to make your subsequent and/or final turn. The time reported should correspond to the miles reported under 'RM'. In the remarks field, enter the train numbers, locations and times for all the trains you relieved. Remarks Required.

3. Yard Service Employees - Employees in yard service who are required to relieve a crew outside switching limits, in connection with hours of service relief must not tie-up on their yard assignment. Any claims for additional pay must be made using claim codes 'OY' (Yard Crews Relieving Hours of Service - Report Hours) and 'OZ' (Yard crews Relieving Hours of Service - Report Miles). Both codes must be entered on the secondary tie-up screen as follows:

Claim code 'OY' - Enter the claim code 'OY' and in the amount field enter the amount of time spent outside the switching limits in relief service.

Claim code 'OZ' - Enter the claim code 'OZ' and in the amount field enter the number of miles run outside the switching limits in relief service.
