Repertoire Suggestions for Rehearsing in Small Groups or Sections

Choir rehearsals will likely be different when we resume in the fall. One of the scenarios being considered is meeting in smaller groups for shorter periods of time. This could be advantageous or not, depending upon the skills of your singers. If a group is advanced in singing in harmony, rehearsing with two or three voice parts in smaller groups would further improve their independence. Younger singers may have less experience, making part-singing more difficult with 15 or less in the room. I would like to suggest some songs that offer the option for rehearsing by section in unison. When combined, the sections create a pleasing song in parts. These suggestions range from easy to medium difficulty. Most of these songs are folksong based and lend themselves well to solfege instruction! Several pieces have been around for decades and have stood the test of time while other arrangements are relatively new. I hope this list is helpful!
