# Laurel's Miranda Beard joins mission to build community center in Dominican Republic

Miranda Beard, NSBA Immediate past president, was selected to participate in the January 2018 Lifetouch Memory Mission, an intensive volunteer effort to build a new community center and cafeteria in Rio Grande, Dominican Repub-

The Domini-Republic can Lifetouch Mem-Mission began in 2011 with the first floor of the Cecaini K-8 school and returning in 2012, 2014, 2015, 2016 and 2017. Over the



six years of construction, the volunteers finished the second floor of the school, built a two-story vocational school and a two-story K-8 school in Rio Grande. The 2018 Lifetouch Memory Mission will consist of 46 volunteers that include 29 educators and 16 Lifetouch employees from around the country. The volunteers will depart on January 15 and return on January 23.

**About Lifetouch Memory Mission** 

Since the inception of the Lifetouch Memory Mission in 2000, Lifetouch employees have traveled to destinations around the world for a week of intensive volunteer service. Lifetouch hands have helped rebuild a village in war-ravaged Kosovo, repair homes in Appalachia, establish a children's center in Jamaica, and constructed a bridge in the land of the Navajo in Arizona.

Joined by school administrators and personnel from around the county, Lifetouch Missions have built thirteen schools across Haiti and the Dominican Republic. Memory Mission volunteers have also provided on-site assistance to victims of natural disasters throughout the United States, including Hurricane Katrina in New Orleans, floods in the Dakotas, fires in California, and tornadoes across the Midwest.

"Lifetouch brings more than muscle and hard work to each Memory Mission," said Jan Haeg, directori of Lifetouch Memory Missions at Lifetouch. "It's also about learning new things and developing relationships. More than anything else, it is our mission to bring hope to the families we serve. ## Laurel's Office Depot becomes the store of the future

As you walk into the newly remodeled Office Depot in Laurel, one of the first things you will notice is how bright and open the store is. The entire floorplan has been revamped.

"This is our store of the future, and the only one in the state of Mississippi," exclaimed Office Depot Business Pro Ed Ludt, who is also the pastor of Errata Presbyterian Church. "It has a brighter more open concept with a stronger emphasis on technology. We wanted to make the store where when people came in they didn't feel lost. Everything has its place and everything is brightly lit. The aisles are wide and you can shop easily. I say come in and play. We've got our entire tech in the center here and it's fully accessible. People can type away, poke away, and point away all they want and there is always an associate nearby ready to help."

Ludt said they actually decreased the square footage of merchandise and focused on the products and services that were most commonly needed by the community based on customer feedback.

Ludt's position as Business Pro is also new and unique to the Laurel store and is only found in a limited number of stores throughout the country.

After five interviews and a month of training, Ludt became Laurel's first and only Business Pro who visits with entrepreneurs and business owners on a daily basis, helping them with their business needs. Ludt said Office Depot has recently shifted their emphasis from being retail oriented to re-emphaizing their mission to help businesses - especially small to medium size businesses.


