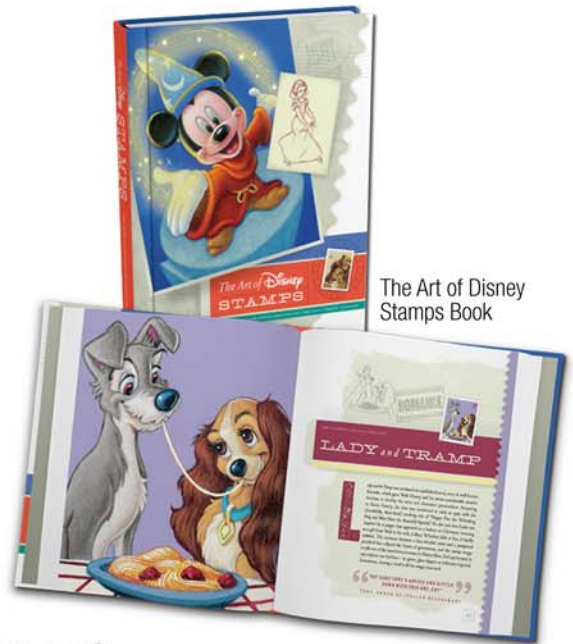

DMM Revision: New Address Requirements for Automation, Presorted, and Carrier Route Flat-Size Mail

Effective March 29, 2009, we are adopting new address standards for Periodicals, Standard Mail[®], Bound Printed Matter, Media Mail[®], and Library Mail flat-size pieces mailed at automation, presorted, or carrier route prices. Some of these revisions also apply to automation and presorted First-Class Mail[®] flats.

The new address placement standards require the delivery address in the upper portion of all Periodicals, Standard Mail, Bound Printed Matter, Media Mail, and Library Mail flat-size pieces mailed at automation, presorted, or carrier route prices. Mailers may place the address parallel or perpendicular to the top edge, but not upside down as read in relation to the top edge. The new standards define “upper portion” as the top half of the mailpiece. Mailers are encouraged to place the address as close to the top edge as possible, while maintaining a 1/8-inch clearance from every edge.

In addition, mailers must address all presorted, carrier route, and automation flat-size mailpieces, including First-Class Mail items, using a minimum of 8-point type or, if the mailpiece bears a POSTNET[™] or Intelligent Mail[®] barcode with a delivery point routing code, a minimum of 6-point type in all capital letters. In addition, for all automation pieces, the characters in the address must not overlap, the address lines must not touch or overlap, and each address element may be separated by no more than five blank character spaces.

The new standards enable more efficient processing and delivery of flat-size pieces. The improved type size and line spacing requirements support accurate and efficient delivery and redirection services and ensure carriers can readily read the addresses and delineate delivery stops.

Addressing Requirements. The fact sheets include additional illustrations for each type of mail. We also posted a scripted presentation that walks mailers and employees through the address changes and provides examples of addresses that do and do not meet the new standards.

We are revising *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service, Domestic Mail Manual (DMM®)* as explained below.

1.2 Delivery and Return Address

[Revise 1.2 as follows:]

The delivery address specifies the location to which the USPS is to deliver a mailpiece. Except for mail prepared with detached address labels under 602.4.0, the mailpiece must have the address of the intended recipient, visible and legible, only on the side of the piece bearing postage (Periodicals do not display postage, and the address may appear on either side). Use at least 8-point type (each character must be at least 0.080 inch high). A sans-serif font is preferred. Addresses printed in all capital letters are also preferred. See additional standards in 2.0. A return address is required in specific circumstances (see 3.2 and 602.1.5 for more information about return addresses).

2.0 Address Placement

2.1 Basic Standards

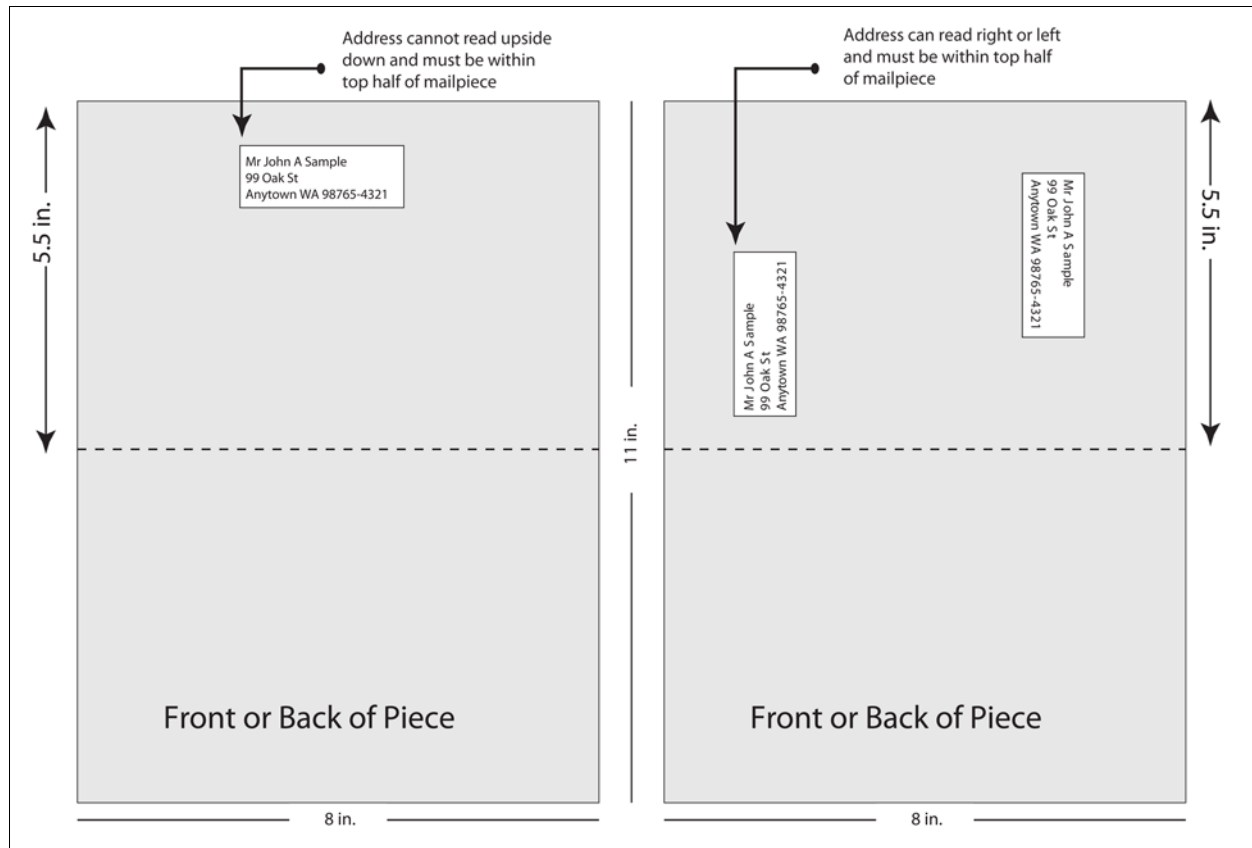
On all Periodicals, Standard Mail, Bound Printed Matter, Media Mail, and Library Mail flats mailed at presorted, automation, or carrier route prices, mailers must place the deliv-

ery address at least 1/8 inch from any edge of the mailpiece. For the purposes of these standards, the “delivery address” is the recipient’s name or other identification; the company information line; the street and number, and any necessary secondary information; and the city, state, and ZIP Code. The delivery address may appear on the front or the back of the mailpiece (but must be on the side bearing postage, except for Periodicals), parallel or perpendicular to the top edge, but it cannot be upside down as read in relation to the top edge. See 2.2 for additional standards for enveloped or polywrapped pieces, and card-style pieces; and 2.3 for bound or folded pieces not in envelopes or polywrap.

2.2 Address Placement on Enveloped or Polywrapped Pieces

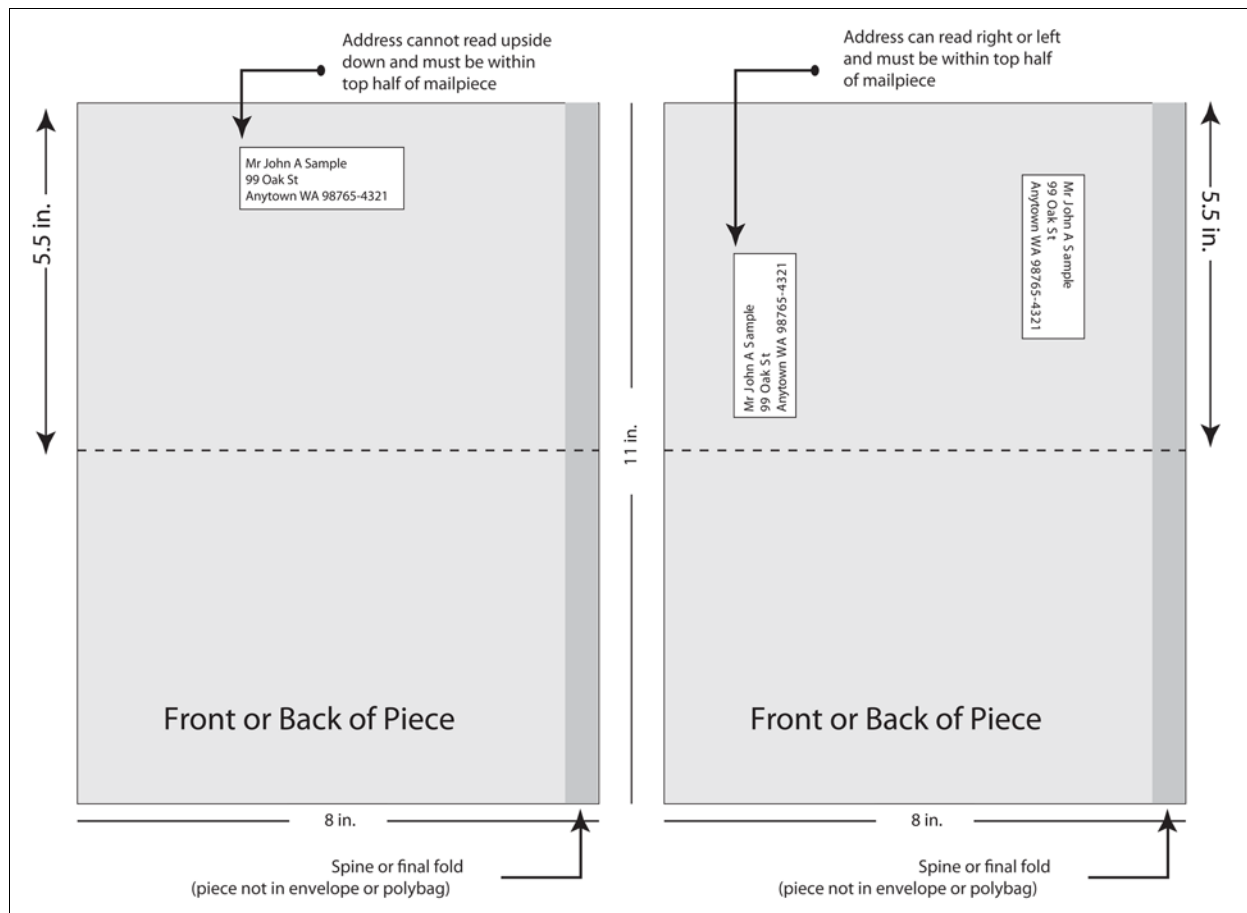
The following standards apply to enveloped, polywrapped, or card-style Periodicals, Standard Mail, Bound Printed Matter, Media Mail, and Library Mail flats mailed at presorted, automation, or carrier route prices:

- a. The “top” of the mailpiece is either of the shorter edges.
- b. The entire delivery address must be within the top half of the mailpiece (see Exhibit 2.2), except under 2.2c or 2.2d. Optimal placement is at the top edge (while maintaining the 1/8-inch clearance requirement).
- c. If a vertical address will not fit entirely within the top half, the address may cross the midpoint if it is placed within 1 inch of the top edge.
- d. If the delivery address is placed on an insert polywrapped with the host piece:
 1. The address must not appear on a component that rotates within the bag.
 2. The address must remain visible throughout the addressed component’s range of motion.
 3. The insert must be affixed to maintain the address entirely in the top half throughout processing and delivery or, if not affixed, the insert must maintain at least the beginning 0.5 inch of the address in the top half. The “beginning 0.5 inch” means the first half-inch of the recipient, delivery address, and city/state/ZIP Code lines, and not the end of each line.

Exhibit 2.2 Delivery Address on Enveloped, Polywrapped, and Card-Style Pieces**2.3 Address Placement on Bound or Folded Pieces**

The following standards apply to bound or folded Periodicals, Standard Mail, Bound Printed Matter, Media Mail, and Library Mail flats mailed at presorted, automation, or carrier route prices not in envelopes or polywrap (see 2.2 for all card-style pieces):

- a. The "top" is the upper edge of the mailpiece when the bound or final folded edge is vertical and on the right side of the piece. Exception: For Carrier Route (or Enhanced Carrier Route) saturation pieces, the "top" of the mailpiece is either of the shorter edges.
- b. The entire delivery address must be within the top half of the mailpiece (see Exhibit 2.3), except under 2.3c. Optimal placement is at the top edge (while maintaining the 1/8-inch clearance requirement).
- c. If a vertical address will not fit entirely within the top half, the address may cross the midpoint if it is placed within 1 inch of the top edge.

Exhibit 2.3 Delivery Address on Bound or Folded Pieces**2.4 Type Size and Line Spacing**

On all First-Class Mail, Periodicals, Standard Mail, Bound Printed Matter, Media Mail, and Library Mail flats mailed at presorted, automation, or carrier route prices, mailers must print the delivery address using at least 8-point type (each character must be at least 0.080 inch high). A sans serif font is preferred. Addresses printed in all capital letters are also preferred. These additional standards apply to automation pieces:

- The individual characters in the address cannot overlap. The individual lines in the address cannot touch or overlap. A minimum 0.028-inch clear space between lines is preferred.
- Each element on each line of the address may be separated by no more than five blank character spaces. One or two blank spaces is preferred.

For example, "ANYTOWN US 12345," *not* "ANYTOWN US 12345." A "blank" character space can equal the width of the widest character in the address.

- For pieces that bear a POSTNET barcode with a delivery point routing code under 708.4.2 or an Intelligent Mail barcode with a delivery point routing code under 708.4.3, mailers may print the delivery address in a minimum of 6-point type (each character must be at least 0.065 inch high) if all capital letters are used.

IMM Revision: Expansion of Express Mail International With Guarantee Service to Include Great Britain, Northern Ireland, and Spain

Effective March 2, 2009, the Postal Service™ is revising *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service, International Mail Manual (IMM®)* part 221 to add Great Britain, Northern Ireland, and Spain to the list of countries to which Express Mail International® With Guarantee Service is available. Currently, this service is only available to Australia, China, Hong Kong, Japan, and the Republic of Korea (South Korea).

We will incorporate this revision into the next printed version of the IMM and into the monthly update of the online IMM, which is available via Postal Explorer® at <http://pe.usps.com>.

Forms

PS Form 6014 Discontinued

Effective immediately, PS Form 6014, *Certification of Move Update Compliance*, is no longer a valid form. All references to PS Form 6014 should be removed from Postal Service™ manuals and handbooks. Employees who perform business mail acceptance should not require or accept PS Form 6014 from any customers.

PS Form 6014 was originally created jointly through a Mailers Technical Advisory Council (MTAC) work group at the request of the industry. The intent of the form was to provide mail verification from clients that Move Update was

being conducted, and transfer responsibility to the mail owner. PS Form 6014 was always voluntary.

Since implementation of the new Move Update requirements in November, we have reevaluated use of the form and determined that accountability for Move Update compliance is a provider/client responsibility.

Revised PS Form 3533, Application for Refund of Fees, Products and Withdrawal of Customer Accounts, Modified With Barcode

Effective March 7, 2009, all Post Offices™, postal retail units, and business mail entry units (BMEUs) are to use the August 2008 edition of PS Form 3533, *Application for Refund of Fees, Products and Withdrawal of Customer Accounts*. Previous versions of PS Form 3533 dated before August 2008 are obsolete and must be disposed of properly.

The Scanning and Imaging Center (SIC) will only accept and process the August 2008 versions of PS Form 3533 that are properly completed and authorized with signatures. All previous versions or incomplete versions with missing signatures of PS Forms 3533 sent to the SIC will not be processed and will be returned to the unit.

The revised PS Form 3533 will no longer be available to the public at www.usps.com. Therefore, Post Offices, postal retail units, and BMEUs are advised to order the hardcopy version of the revised PS Form 3533 to have available for our mailing agents and customers. Hardcopies of PS Form 3533 are available at the Material Distribution Center (MDC) (See “Ordering PS Form 3533” below).

PS Form 3533 is revised with a barcoded invoice number making each form unique. *Make sure no duplicate copies are made of blank PS Form 3533 for future use.* Each PS Form 3533 is unique, and one form is used per customer refund or reimbursement.

PS Form 3533 is revised as follows:

1. There is a 20-digit “unique barcode invoice number” on each form, therefore, each customer refund or reimbursement transaction must be processed on a separate PS Form 3533. *Do not make duplicate copies of blank PS Form 3533 for future use.*
2. In section Request Disbursement For:
 - Refund Postage and Fees (AIC 553).

- Post Office PVI Error — Issued Locally: New instructions provide for the following: (If actual PVI Label is attached, no witness signature is required). Refund claims with no PVI Label attached must include a witness signature.
 - Refund of Permit Postage and Fees (AIC 528): Check one of the two new check boxes:
 - Postage Affixed in BRM Pieces.
 - Damaged Mailings, Refund of Annual Fees.
3. In Part 2: Verification of Disbursements, see Note: Customer Signature Required in Part 1.
 4. In Part 3: Postage Affixed on BRM or Meter Stamps (excluding PC Postage):
 - The last sentence is revised as follows: Charges for postage affixed on BRM pieces or meter stamps are assessed at 10 percent off the face value of the indicia, if the total is \$350 or less. If the total face value is more than \$350, a charge of \$35 per hour is assessed for the actual hours to process postage affixed on BRM pieces or meter stamp refunds; the minimum charge is \$35.
 - A refund is requested only for the postage meter number (must be the same as Part 1). This requires one PS Form 3533 per postage meter number. Do not commingle multiple postage meter numbers.
 5. In Part 6: Disbursements Processed by the Accounting Service Center (ASC):
 - Bullet 5 to read: Maintain a copy of PS Form 3533 locally as a support document for PS Form 1412.

The primary change in the revised PS Form 3533 is the “unique barcode invoice number” on the top right-hand side of the form. The barcode will be used to track individual customer refund transactions initiated at the Post Office

or postal retail unit with POS ONE, IRT, or eMOVES reporting system. BMEUs will also use the revised PS Form 3533 and process it as usual.

Authorized refunds of more than \$500 or withdrawal of any amount from a customer trust account will require reporting the amount into AIC 280, Disbursement to ASC. POS ONE, IRT, and eMOVES require the scanning or input of the “unique barcode invoice number” into the reporting system at the time of transaction. At the close of business, submit PS Form 3533 to the SIC for the reimbursement process.

Business Mail Entry Units

BMEUs will ensure that the revised PS Form 3533 is completed and authorized with signatures, and will process it as usual. Submit completed PS Form 3533 with supporting documentation and system-generated PS Form 3533-X to the USPS® SIC.

POS ONE Offices

Following is the process for POS ONE offices:

- a. In the refund workflow, enter one customer refund or reimbursement.
- b. If the refund amount is more than \$500 or there is a withdrawal of any amount from a customer trust account, the POS software will tender the transaction using AIC 280, Disbursement to ASC.
- c. The POS software will prompt you to enter the customer name, address, and account number and to scan or input the “unique barcode invoice number” of the revised PS Form 3533 for this individual customer refund.

IRT Offices

Following is the process for IRT offices:

- a. Install the IRT version update floppy disk.
- b. Enter each individual customer refund or reimbursement to the appropriate AIC.
- c. If the refund amount is more than \$500 or there is a withdrawal of any amount from a customer trust account, offset this transaction using AIC 280, Disbursement to ASC.
- d. IRT will prompt you to enter the customer name, address, and account number and to scan or input the “unique barcode invoice number” of the revised PS Form 3533 for this individual customer refund.

eMOVES Offices

Following is the process for eMOVES offices:

- a. Enter each individual customer refund or reimbursement to the appropriate AIC.
- b. If the refund amount is more than \$500 or there is a withdrawal of any amount from a customer trust

account, enter the offset using AIC 280, Disbursement to ASC.

- c. The eMOVES application will prompt you to enter the customer name, address, and account number and to input the “unique barcode invoice number” of the revised PS Form 3533 for this individual customer refund.

After the completed PS Form 3533 has been scanned/entered in POS, IRT, or eMOVES, submit the form along with proper documentation (PS Form 3544, *Post Office Receipt for Money*, or PS Form 1412, *Daily Financial Report*) to the SIC at the following address:

Verifying U.S. Postal Service Money Orders

Follow these steps to cash a Postal Service™ money order:

1. Check that the amount does not exceed the legal limit: \$1,000 for domestic, and \$700 for international postal money orders.
2. Check that the proper security features are present:
 - When held to the light, a watermark of Benjamin Franklin is repeated from top to bottom on the left side.
 - When held to the light, a dark line (security thread) runs from top to bottom with the word “USPS” repeated.
 - There should be no discoloration around the dollar amounts, which might indicate the amounts were changes.

These appear in Postal Service Notice 299, *U.S. Postal Money Order Reference Card*, or online at <http://www.usps.com/missingmoneyorders/security.htm>.

3. If the money order seems suspicious, call the U.S. Postal Service Money Order Verification System at 866-459-7822.

Please provide this information to local banks and retailers, as they also receive Postal Service money orders for cashing.

Note: Mail order catalogs are prohibited as SAM or PAL mail.

A. Securities, currency, or precious metals in their raw, unmanufactured state are prohibited. Official shipments are exempt from this restriction.

A1. Mail addressed to "Any Servicemember," or similar wording such as "Any Soldier," "Sailor," "Airman," or "Marine"; "Military Mail"; etc., is prohibited. Mail must be addressed to an individual or job title such as "Commander," "Commanding Officer," etc.

B. PS Form 2976-A is required for all mail weighing 16 ounces or more, with exceptions noted below. In addition, mailers must properly complete required customs documentation when mailing any potentially dutiable mail addressed to an APO, FPO, or DPO regardless of weight. The following are exceptions to the requirement for customs documentation on nondutiable mail that weighs 16 ounces or more:

- Known mailers are exempt from providing customs documentation on non-dutiable letters, and printed matter weighing 16 ounces or more. (A known mailer is anyone who legally applies a permit imprint to a mailpiece. Mail with meter postage is not considered to be from a known mailer.)
- All federal, state, and local government agencies are exempt from providing customs documentation on mail addressed to an APO, FPO, or DPO except for those APOs/FPOs/DPOs to which restriction B2 applies.
- Prepaid mail from military contractors is exempt, providing the mailpiece is endorsed "Contents for Official Use — Exempt from Customs Requirements."

B1. PS Form 2976 or 2976-A is required. Articles are liable for customs duty and/or purchase tax unless they are bona fide gifts intended for use by military personnel or their dependents. When the contents of a parcel meet these requirements, the mailer must endorse the customs form, "Certified to be a bona fide gift, personal effects, or items for personal use of military personnel and dependents," under the heading, Description of Contents.

Exceptions: All other exceptions listed in restriction B above are applicable to this restriction.

B2. All federal, state, and local government agencies must complete customs documentation when sending mail addressed to or from this APO, FPO, or DPO weighing 16 ounces or more.

C. Cigarettes and other tobacco products are prohibited.

C1. Obscene articles, prints, paintings, cards, films, videotapes, etc., and horror comics and matrices are prohibited.

D. Coffee is prohibited.

E1. Medicines or vaccines not conforming to French laws are prohibited.

E2. Any matter depicting nude or seminude persons, pornographic or sexual items, or nonauthorized political materials is prohibited. Although religious materials contrary to the Islamic faith are prohibited in bulk quantities, items for the personal use of the addressee are permissible.

E3. Radio transceivers, cordless telephones, global positioning systems, scanners, base stations, and handheld transmitters are prohibited.

F. Firearms of any type are prohibited in all classes of mail. See definitions of firearms in DMM 601.11.1.2c. This restriction does not apply to firearms mailed to or by official U.S. government agencies. The restriction for mail to this APO/FPO/DPO ZIP Code does not apply to firearms mailed from this APO/FPO/DPO ZIP Code, provided ATF and USPS regulations are met. Antique firearms are a separate category defined in DMM 601.11.2 and ATF regulations; they do not require an ATF form.

F1. Privately owned weapons addressed to an individual are prohibited in any class of mail.

F2. Importation of firearms is restricted to one shotgun and one single shot.22 caliber rifle per individual.

G. Only letters, flats, and Periodicals are authorized. Parcels of any class are prohibited.

H. Meats, including preserved meats, whether hermetically sealed or not, are prohibited.

H1. Pork or pork by-products are prohibited.

I. Mail of all classes must fit in a mail sack. Mail may not exceed the following dimensions:

- Maximum length 20 inches.
- Maximum width 12 inches.
- Maximum height 12 inches.

The maximum length and girth combined may not exceed 68 inches.

This restriction does not apply to registered mail and official government mail marked MOM.

I1. This restriction does not apply to registered mail.

I2. This restriction does not apply to official government mail marked MOM.

J. Parcels may not exceed 108 inches in length and girth combined.

K. Mail that includes in the address the words, "Dependent Mail Section," may consist only of letter mail, newspapers, magazines, and books. No parcel of any class containing any other matter may be mailed to the Dependent Mail section. This restriction does not apply if the address does not include the words "Dependent Mail Section."

L. All official mail is prohibited.

M. Fruits, vegetables, animals, and living plants are prohibited.

N. Registered mail is prohibited.

O. Delivery status information for Extra Services is not available on USPS.com.

P. APO is used for the receipt and dispatch of official mail only.

Q. Mail may not exceed 66 pounds, and size is limited to 42 inches maximum length and 72 inches maximum length and girth combined.

R. All alcoholic beverages, including those mailable under DMM 601.8.0, are prohibited.

R1. Materials used in the production of alcoholic beverages (i.e., distilling material, hops, malts, yeast, etc.) are prohibited.

T. Mailings of case lots of food and supplemental household shipments must be approved by the sender's parent agency prior to mailing.

U. Parcels must weigh less than 16 ounces when addressed to Box R. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped."

U1. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail weighing 13 ounces or less when addressed to Box R. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped." Videotapes are prohibited when addressed to Box R, regardless of weight.

X. Personal mail is limited to First-Class Mail items (to include audio cassettes and voice tapes) weighing 13 ounces or less. This limitation does not apply to official mail.

Y. Mail is limited to First-Class and Priority Mail items only. All Periodicals, Standard Mail items, and Package Services items (including SAM and PAL) are not authorized. This restriction also applies to official mail.

Z. No outside pieces (OSPs).

Z1. The following restriction is applicable only to International Service Centers (ISC)/Exchange Offices. An Anti-Pilferage Seal (Item No O817E or O818A) is required on all pouches and sacks.

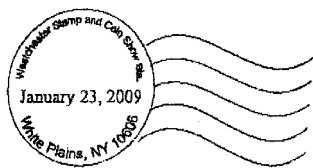
People attending these local events may obtain the postmark in person at the temporary Post Office™ station established there. Those who cannot attend the event but who wish to obtain the postmark may submit a mail order request. Pictorial postmarks are available only for the dates indicated, and *requests must be postmarked no later than 30 days following the requested pictorial postmark date.*

All requests must include a stamped envelope or postcard bearing at least the minimum First-Class Mail® postage. Items submitted for postmark may not include

postage issued after the date of the requested postmark. Such items will be returned unserved.

Customers wishing to obtain a postmark should affix stamps to any envelope or postcard of their choice, address the envelope or postcard to themselves or others, insert a card of postcard thickness in envelopes for sturdiness, and tuck in the flap. Place the envelope or postcard in a larger envelope and address it to: PICTORIAL POSTMARKS, followed by the NAME OF THE STATION, ADDRESS, CITY, STATE, ZIP+4® CODE, as listed below.

How to Order the First Day of Issue Digital Color or Traditional Postmarks

Customers have 60 days to obtain the first day of issue postmarks by mail. They may purchase new stamps at their local Post Office™, by telephone at 800-STAMP-24, or at The Postal Store® website at www.usps.com/shop.

Traditional Postmarks

Customers should affix the stamps to envelopes of their choice, address them to themselves or others, or provide a self-addressed return envelope with sufficient postage large enough to accommodate the canceled item. Mail the request to the corresponding city of issuance. There is no charge for the first 50 postmarks. There is a 5-cent charge for each additional postmark over 50. Customers should submit a check, money order, or credit card for payment. After applying the first day of issue postmark, the Postal Service™ will return the envelopes to the customer by U.S. Mail.

All postmark requests should go to the first day of issue city. The first day of issue city Post Office will then forward in bulk all postmark requests to Cancellation Services, Stamp Fulfillment Services, P.O. Box 449992, Kansas City, MO 64144-9992 by respective Post Offices.

Digital Color Postmarks

Only select stamp issues offer a digital color postmark. Customers may submit #6 or #10 envelopes constructed of paper rated as "laser safe." The Postal Service recommends envelopes of 80-pound Accent Opaque, acid-free, 9/16" side seams with no glue on the flap. The maximum

size of all digital color postmarks is 2" high x 4" long. Allow sufficient space on the envelope to accommodate the postmark. Do not use self-adhesive labels for addresses on the envelope. Two test envelopes must be included. There is a minimum of 10 envelopes at 50 cents per postmark required at the time of servicing. Customers should submit a check, money order, or credit card for payment.

The Postal Service reserves the right to not accept hand-painted and other cachet envelopes that are not compatible with our digital color postmark equipment. The Postal Service also reserves the right to substitute traditional black rubber postmarks if use of non-specified envelopes results in poor image quality or damage to equipment.

Customers should affix the stamps to the envelopes and address them to themselves or others for return through the mail. Or, they may include an additional self-addressed return envelope, large enough to accommodate their canceled items, with sufficient postage affixed for return of their postmarked items. Mail the request for a first day of issue digital color postmark to the corresponding city of issuance. Post Offices will then forward all customer requests for digital color postmarks to Cancellation Services, Stamp Fulfillment Services, P.O. Box 449992, Kansas City, MO 64144-9992.

After applying the first day of issue postmark, the Postal Service will return the envelopes to the customer by U.S. Mail.

This article publishes the Stamps by Mail® print run cut-off schedule for the entire '09 fiscal year. Each date has a designation whether it is for the year-round (YR) brochure, the holiday (HOL) brochure, or the price change (Price Change) brochure. FY '09 print cycle dates:

- April 2, 2009 (Price Change).
- May 5, 2009 (YR).
- June 25, 2009 (YR).
- August 20, 2009 (HOL).

Company must receive orders placed by mail by close of business the day of the print run cut-off date listed here. Orders received after the cut-off date will be processed the next print run date.

All local Post Offices™ and centralized sites should follow the ordering instructions contained within this article and utilize local funds.

For Orders Exceeding 10,000

Use eBay to process both centralized and decentralized brochure orders that exceed \$10,000.00. In the Purchasing Method field, select "Route Req to Supply Mgmt", then in the After Approval Route field, select "Eastern Services CMC (Memphis, TN)". Include completed PS Form 3227-O with imprint information with the eBay order.

Note: These approved eBay orders must be received by Supply Management at least 10 days prior to a published run cut-off date to be included in that run.

Cyril-Scott Company will deliver orders within 35 calendar days after printing. Printing begins 1 week after the deadline date, and actual receipt of the order will depend on the ultimate destination and the corresponding delivery service standard. You should save copies of all orders placed at your local Post Office until the order has been received. Ensure procedures are in effect locally for proper verification of receipt.

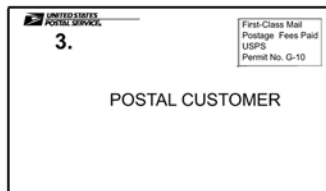
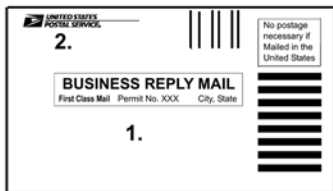

USPS Headquarters Managers and Field Installation Heads: Semi-Annual Capital Property Reviews

USPS® has instituted a new policy that requires Headquarters (HQ) and field units to conduct a review of randomly sampled capital property assets selected by HQ, Accounting Policy, and transmitted by Supply Management twice a year. The Semi-Annual Capital Property Reviews will identify discrepancies between what is reported on the corporate books and what can be physically verified. The Semi-Annual Capital Property Reviews will steadily improve the data integrity of our accounting systems and, consequently, bring the USPS into compliance with the Sarbanes-Oxley Act (SOX).

The next Semi-Annual Capital Property Review will commence on March 2, 2009, and is to be completed by March 20, 2009. The actual list of items to be verified by

each finance number selected will be sent out by e-mail from "Materials, Customer Service — Topeka, KS."

The district material management specialists (DMMSs) will provide instructions and guidelines on how the Semi-Annual Capital Property Reviews are to be conducted by the field and by the Material Service Centers (MSCs) for the HQ groups. Until Handbook AS-701, *Material Management*, is revised, the instructions and guidelines provided by the DMMSs and MSCs will supersede Handbook AS-701 where there are conflicts.

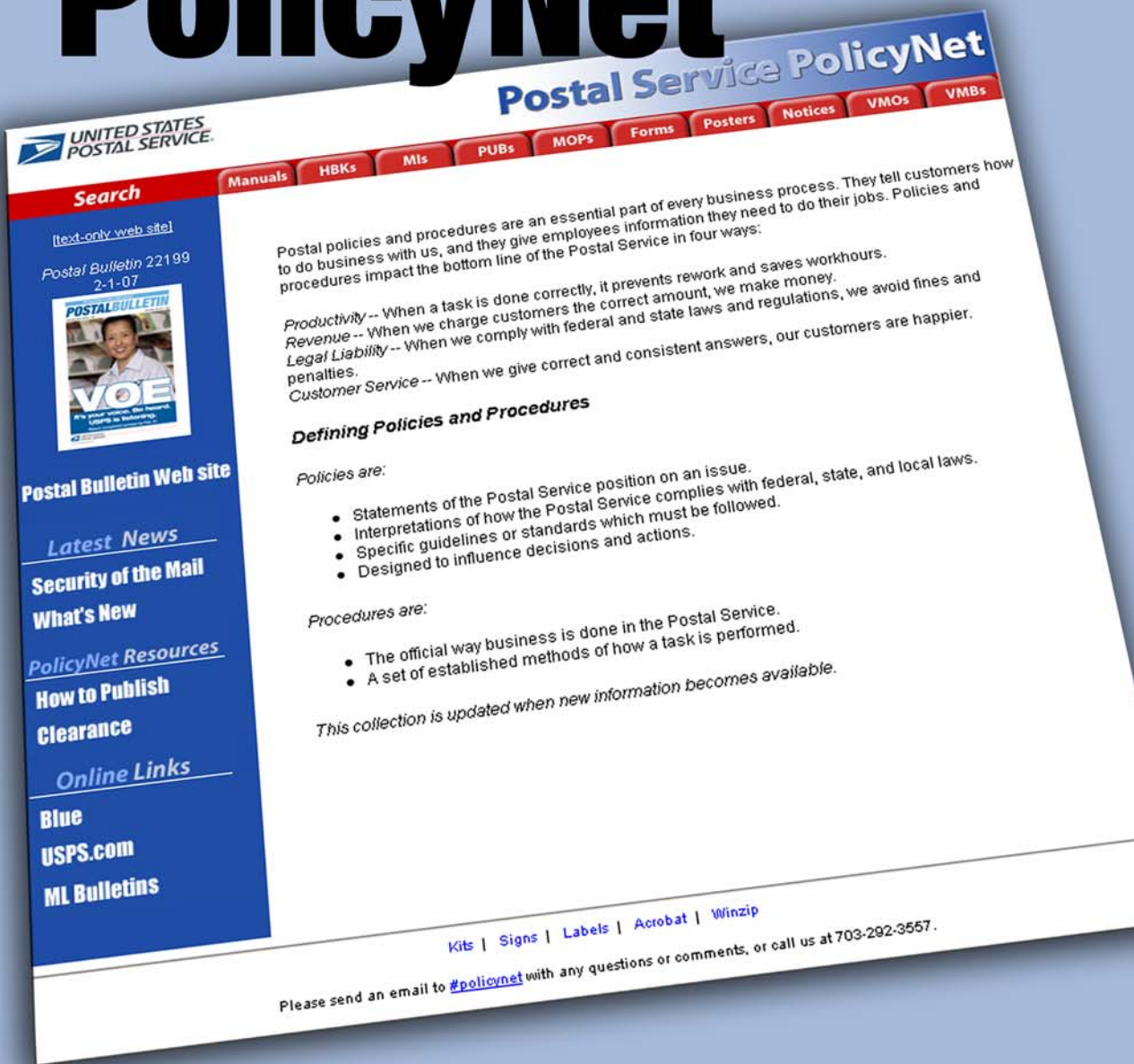
