LEADING OFF

SEC TOURNEY TIME

- Newly crowned SEC champion Arkansas opens play in the SEC Tournament against Texas A&M on Wednesday, May 24, at Hoover Metropolitan Stadium.
- First pitch between the Hogs and Aggies will be thrown 30 minutes after the conclusion of the game between LSU and South Carolina, which is scheduled to begin at 9:30 a.m.
- The game will broadcast on SEC Network with Dave Neal (play-by-play) and Ben McDonald (analyst) on the call.

HERE'S THE SITUATION

- The winner of the Arkansas-Texas A&M game will play the winner of the LSU-South Carolina game in a double-elimination game scheduled for 4:30 p.m. Thursday, May 25.
- The losers of Wednesday's games, meanwhile, will play at 9:30 a.m. Thursday in a win-or-go-home game.

HOGS IN HOOVER

- The Hogs, who won the SEC Tournament for the first time in program history in 2021, are 26-29 in Hoover under Dave Van Horn.
- Arkansas has reached the semifinals in three of the last five tournaments (2017, 2018 & 2021) and played for the title twice in that span (2017 & 2021).

HISTORY LESSON

- Arkansas is 49-46 all-time against Texas A&M, including a 1-0 mark against the Aggies in the SEC Tournament.
- Under Dave Van Horn, the Hogs are 21-14 overall, including a win in Hoover, against Texas A&M.
- The only previous meeting between the Razorbacks and Aggies in the SEC Tournament came in 2014.
- Arkansas picked up a 4-0 win in the opening round behind a combined shutout by Trey Killian (6.0 IP, 4 SO) and Zach Jackson (3.0 IP, 4 SO).

SEC CHAMPS

- Under three-time SEC Coach of Year Dave Van Horn, the Razorbacks won their fourth SEC championship (1999, 2004, 2021 & 2023) in school history.
- Arkansas also won its eighth SEC Western Division crown (1999, 2004, 2007, 2011, 2018, 2019, 2021 & 2023) in program history and fourth since 2018.
- Arkansas, winners of 20 SEC games for the fourth time in program history, posted their sixth consecutive season with 18 or more SEC wins.
- LSU is the only other team in SEC history to record at least six consecutive seasons of 18 or more SEC victories, doing so in 10 straight seasons from 1996-2005.



Designated hitter **Kendall Diggs**, a Second Team All-SEC selection, has hit 13 career home runs, including six three-run home runs and a pair of grand slams.

HOGS DON'T REBUILD, HOGS RELOAD

- The Razorbacks' 39-man roster features 26 newcomers, including 15 new position players and 11 new pitchers.
- Offensively, Arkansas replaced 73.6 percent of its home run production and 72.9 percent of its RBI production from 2022.
- Returning position players INF Brady Slavens (16 HR, 58 RBI), INF Peyton Stovall (6 HR, 31 RBI), OF Jace Bohrofen (3 HR, 17 RBI) and INF/OF Kendall Diggs (3 HR, 14 RBI) combined for just 28 of the Hogs' 106 total home runs (26.4 percent) and just 120 of the Razorbacks' 443 total runs batted in (27.1 percent) one year ago.
- On the mound, Arkansas was tasked with replacing ace RHP Connor Noland, who was selected by the Chicago Cubs in the ninth round of the 2022 MLB Draft. The right-hander went 8-6 with a 3.65 ERA with 113 strikeouts in 116.0 innings last season for the Razorbacks.
- The Hogs returned a pair of Freshman All-Americans in LHP Hagen Smith and RHP Brady Tygart as well as a pair of veterans in RHP Will McEntire and LHP Zack Morris, but lost RHP Jaxon Wiggins to injury.

J BO KNOWS

- OF Jace Bohrofen is one of the Hogs' three team captains in 2023.
- The Oklahoma City, Okla., native battled injuries and played in just 32 games with 24 starts last season, slushing .228/.333/.435 with three homers and 17 runs batted in on the year.
- Fully healthy in 2023, Bohrofen has lived up to the hype by slushing a team-leading .332/.449/.631 with a team-best 14 home runs and 46 RBI through 53 games this season.
- His 62 baseball hits, 14 doubles and 118 total bases on the year are the most among all Razorback hitters.
- Bohrofen came to Arkansas from Oklahoma, where he spent his true freshman season in 2021. That season, he played in 35 games with 29 starts and slushed .252/.347/.408 with two home runs, 18 RBI and a team-leading three triples.
- A highly regarded prospect in high school, Bohrofen was ranked by Perfect Game as the No. 33 overall prospect and the No. 10 outfielder in the class of 2020. He was the No. 3 overall prospect and the No. 1 outfielder in the state of Oklahoma by Perfect Game.
- His high school accolades include All-America honors from Under Armour and ABCA/Rawlings in 2018 and 2019, when he was named the Perfect Game Player of the Year in Oklahoma.

GETTING DIGGSY WITH IT


- DH Kendall Diggs earned All-SEC second-team honors, becoming the 55th player in school history to earn All-SEC praise.
- The Olathe, Kan., native is slushing .314/.451/.566 with 10 home runs and a team-leading 56 RBI through 51 games this year.
- The true sophomore, who leads all Razorback batters in walks with 41, has racked up 55 hits, including 12 doubles and one triple.
- During SEC play, Diggs has posted a .291/.437/.495 slash line with three homers and a team-high 33 RBI in 30 league games.
- For his career, Diggs has swatted 13 career home runs, six of which have been three-run homers. He has also hit two grand slams.
- Diggs was a highly touted prospect when he arrived at Arkansas. Ranked by Perfect Game as the No. 141 overall prospect and the No. 5 third baseman in the class of 2021, He was the No. 2 overall prospect and No. 1 third baseman in the state of Kansas by Perfect Game.

POWER TO THE POPS

- OF Jared Wegner, a graduate transfer from Creighton, is the Razorbacks' big bat in the middle of their batting order.
- For the year, Wegner is slushing .328/.471/.689 with 12 home runs and 44 RBI through 36 games. The Kearney, Neb., native was named the SEC Player of the Week after he began his Razorback career by slushing .545/.643/1.365 (6-for-11) with four extra-base hits, including two home runs, and eight RBI over three games in the College Baseball Showdown at Globe Life Field.
- Wegner, however, suffered a hairline fracture in his left thumb against Little Rock on April 11 and was not in lineup for 19 games before returning for the series opener at Vanderbilt on May 18.
- In 2022 at Creighton, Wegner was a force. He slashed .343/.459/.635 with a team-leading 11 home runs and 53 RBI over 49 games to earned First Team All-Big East honors at the year's end.
- As a true freshman, Wegner was a Second Team All-Big East selection after finishing with a .264 batting average, 20 RBI, seven doubles, one home run and eight multi-hit games in 43 games.

Pitcher **Hagen Smith** is the first Razorback starting pitcher to earn All-SEC first-team honors since Ryne Stanek accomplished the feat in 2013.

H. SMITH

- LHP Hagen Smith is the Razorbacks' certified ace.
- The first Arkansas starting pitcher to earn All-SEC first-team honors since Ryne Stanek in 2013, Smith began the 2023 campaign as the Razorbacks' No. 1 starter and transitioned to a "wild card" role at the start of SEC play due to injuries to the pitching staff before settling back into the Hogs' starting rotation.
- For the year, Smith has made 15 appearances with nine starts, including five in SEC play, and boasts an 8-1 record with a team-leading 2.56 ERA and two saves over 63 1/3 innings on the mound.
- The true sophomore has struck out a team-high 93 batters and limited opposing hitters to a .191 batting average this season.
- Smith is a semifinalist for the Golden Spikes Award as well as the College Baseball Foundation National Pitcher of the Year Award.
- The Bullard, Texas, native was the Razorbacks' No. 2 starter as a true freshman last season, going 7-2 with a 4.66 ERA, six quality starts and two saves in 77.1 innings over 20 appearances (15 starts).
- The left-hander struck out 90 batters on the year, helping Arkansas set a new school record with 674 strikeouts in 2022.
- Down the stretch, Smith pitched out of the Razorback bullpen and was even more dominant. He went 1-0 with a 3.38 ERA and two saves in 10.2 innings of work in the NCAA Tournament, striking out 16 and limiting opposing hitters to a .184 batting average.
- At the year's end, Smith was named a Freshman All-American by both Collegiate Baseball Newspaper and Perfect Game.

BIG MAC

- RHP Will McEntire began the 2022 season as an afterthought, but quickly turned into one of the Razorbacks' most valuable pitchers.
- This season, the veteran right-hander has made 17 appearances with 10 starts and racked up a 6-3 record with two saves and 76 strikeouts over 73.0 innings of work on the mound.
- As a reliever, McEntire is 1-1 with a 3.65 ERA in 24.2 innings. The Bryant, Ark., native has fanned 31 and limited opposing hitters to a .231 batting average when pitching out of the Razorback bullpen.
- As a starter, McEntire threw a nine-inning complete game with six strikeouts against Louisiana Tech on March 11. He was named the SEC Pitcher of the Week and was the first Razorback pitcher since Dominic Taccolini in 2016 to twirl a nine-inning complete game.

DOUBLE H

- LHP Hunter Hollan, a junior college transfer, has made an immediate impact since stepping foot on campus at Arkansas.
- The left-hander, who was selected by the Milwaukee Brewers in the 15th round (No. 447 overall) of the 2021 MLB Draft, transferred into Arkansas from San Jacinto College.
- In 2022 at San Jac, Hollan made 18 starts, going 9-3 with a 3.59 ERA and 96 strikeouts in 80.1 innings. He recorded double-digit strikeouts in three games during the 2022 season.
- Hollan, who has made 13 appearances (all starts) on the mound, began this season as Arkansas' Sunday starter and moved into the Friday role when Hagen Smith was briefly shifted to the bullpen.
- He made his first start as a Razorback against #9 Oklahoma State (Feb. 19) in the College Baseball Showdown, striking out five over four innings of one-run ball to earn his first win of the season.
- He recorded the Hogs' first quality start of the year against Wright State (March 5) with six innings of one-run ball and five strikeouts.
- Hollan leads the Hogs in quality starts this season with five, including a nine-inning complete game against #6 South Carolina (May 15), the first complete game against SEC opponent by an Arkansas pitcher since the 2016 campaign.

GOT THAT WOOD

- RHP Gage Wood was named to the Freshman All-SEC Team, becoming the 56th player in program history to earn an All-SEC distinction.
- The Batesville, Ark., native is 2-0 with a 3.81 ERA and 41 strikeouts over 28 1/3 innings in relief work this season. He has limited opposing hitters to .184 batting average on the year.
- The right-hander has emerged as the Razorbacks' closer and leads the team in saves with five, all of which have come in SEC play.
- All five of his saves are also of the multi-inning variety.
- Wood is just the fourth Arkansas freshman pitcher since 2003, head coach Dave Van Horn's first year at Arkansas, to record at least five saves in a season.

- The Razorbacks' 15-game winning streak earlier this season marked Arkansas' longest in-season winning streak since head coach Dave Van Horn took over at the helm of the program in 2003.
- It was also the longest in-season winning streak in program history since the Razorbacks won the first 18 games of the 1996 season.

HOME SWEET HOME

- Arkansas is 30-4 (.882 winning percentage) at Baum-Walker Stadium this season, including 13-2 at home in SEC play. It is the Hogs' fourth 30-win season at home since the stadium opened in 1996.
- Excluding 2020, the Hogs have won 28 games or more at home in six consecutive seasons, including a program-record 34 wins in 2018.

- Arkansas was off to an 11-2 start at home (.846 winning percentage) in 2020 before the season was canceled due to the pandemic.

HOGS BOAST TOP 2023 RECRUITING CLASS

- For the first time in program history, Arkansas has landed the nation's top-rated recruiting class.
- The Razorbacks' 2023 signing class is ranked No. 1 nationally by both Baseball America and Perfect Game.
- Previously, Arkansas' highest-rated class was No. 2 by Perfect Game (2014) and No. 3 by Baseball America (2017 & 2020).
- It is the seventh consecutive year that head coach Dave Van Horn, assisted by hitting coach/recruiting coordinator Nate Thompson and pitching coach Matt Hobbs, has brought in a top-10 class in Perfect Game's recruiting rankings.
- 13 of Arkansas' 21 signees are among Perfect Game's top 100, an all-time high in the publication's rankings history. Perfect Game's recruiting class rankings began in 2011, according to its database.
- The Hogs' recruiting class features 11 pitchers, eight position players and a pair of two-way players, all coming from the high school ranks.
- The 21 signees hail from two countries - United States (20) and South Korea (1) - and represent 11 different states - Alabama (1), Arkansas (2), California (3), Colorado (1), Florida (2), Hawaii (1), Missouri (3), North Carolina (1), Oklahoma (2), Texas (2) and Wisconsin (2).

FORZA FLETCH!

- Former Hog and current Arizona Diamondback outfielder Dominic Fletcher suited up for Team Italy in the 2023 World Baseball Classic.
- Fletchcer, who played alongside his brother, David, an infielder for the Los Angeles Angels, slashed .368/.478/.632 (7-for-19) with two doubles, a home run and four RBI over five games.
- In Italy's quarterfinal loss to Japan, Fletcher had a two-run single against 2021 AL MVP and two-time All-Star Shohei Ohtani as well as a solo homer against five-time MLB All-Star Yu Darvish.
- Fletcher, who played at Arkansas from 2017-19, is the second former Hog to participate in the World Baseball Classic.
- Drew Smyly, who pitched for the Razorbacks from 2009-10, represented Team USA in the 2017 World Baseball Classic.
- Drafted by the Arizona Diamondbacks with the No. 75 overall pick of the 2019 MLB Draft, Fletcher became the 63rd former Razorback to make his MLB debut on April 30, 2023. He collected a double in his first Major League at-bat with the Diamondbacks.
