TWIBB NOTES (This Week In Bulldog Baseball)

◆ **Another SEC Weekend, Another Top Opponent:** Georgia (20-17, 4-11 SEC) finally returns to Foley Field after spending three of the past four weekends on the road in the rugged SEC. Fifth-ranked Arkansas (30-7, 11-4 SEC) marks the fourth straight top 10 SEC opponent for the Bulldogs who went 1-2 last weekend at No. 2 Florida. Georgia stunned the Gators with a seven-run ninth to take the opener 13-11 and then game two was 1-1 going to the ninth before the Gators posted a 2-1 walk-off. It marked Georgia's fifth one-run loss of the year.

Georgia got its first one-run win this past Tuesday with a 5-4 road victory over Clemson that featured the Bulldogs throwing out the tying run at the plate to end the contest! RF Josh Stinson threw to 2B Mason LaPlante who fired home to C Fernando Gonzalez for the win. It was Stinson who drove in the go-ahead run with an RBI-double in the fourth as neither team scored over the final five frames. Meanwhile, the Razorbacks lead the Western Division and are tied with Florida with the second-best league mark behind Vandy. Arkansas swept Tennessee last weekend in Fayetteville and dispatched UCA 6-3 this past Tuesday for their 30th win including 25-3 at home. UA is just 3-3 on the road.

◆ **Series History:** Arkansas holds a 37-25 edge in the series history that began at the 1987 College World Series. UA eliminated Georgia 5-4. The teams last met in 2021 with UA winning a home series 2-1 as well as a game at the SEC Tournament. The last SEC series in Athens came in 2018 with the Bulldogs taking that one 2-1 including a dramatic double play to secure a 3-2 win as the tying run was thrown out at the plate by LF Keegan McGovern. Incidentally, that was the last time Georgia won a game that ended with a runner being thrown out at home until this past Tuesday! Since Arkansas joined the SEC in 1992, the teams have played 20 series, and UA owns a 12-8 edge in those series.

◆ **On The Mound:** Georgia's rotation will be freshman RHP Kolten Smith (1-1, 4.80), junior LHP Charlie Goldstein (1-1, 5.67) and junior LHP Liam Sullivan (3-2, 5.59). Arkansas has named only Thursday's starter in junior LHP Hunter Hollan (6-1, 2.81). For the season, the Bulldogs have a 6.32 ERA with 352 strikeouts and 186 walks. Opponents are batting .265 against the Bulldogs. The Razorbacks sports a 4.77 ERA with 323 strikeouts and 149 walks. Opponents are hitting .267 against UA.

◆ **'CondonSation':** The process which baseballs feature exit velocities of 114+ mph and result in RBI. Charlie Condon (.444/.537/.902) is crucial to the Georgia offense. A 6-6, 215-pound redshirt freshman 1B/OF, Condon has been named to the midseason watch list for the Golden Spikes Award.

Condon ranks 2nd in the SEC in Batting (.444), Total Bases (120), SLG% (.902) and OB% (.537), T1st in Hits (59), 4th in Home Runs (17) and RBI (53) He has reached base safely in 36 games (all but the season opener). He had a 24-game hitting streak (third best in school history). In the series at No. 2 Florida, he tied a school record with three home runs in a 13-11 win over the Gators.

Graduate OF Connor Tate, who has played in 200 games in his career including 166 starts, ranks second on the club in batting at .369. Tate has hit 12 home runs this season including a pair of grand slams, the most recent a game-tying blast in the 9th inning of a 13-11 win at No. 2 Florida last Friday. Graduate INF Will David (.307-3-14), junior 3B/1B Parks Harber (.276-11-37) and junior C/OF Corey Collins (.267-6-20) round out the top offensive threats in the lineup.

◆ **At The Plate:** Georgia is batting .290 with 65 home runs, a .387 on base percentage and is 19-for-22 in stolen base attempts. Arkansas is batting .291 with 60 home runs, a .406 on base percentage and is 33-for-44 in stolen base attempts.

◆ **Tough Glove:** Georgia is fielding .980 while the Razorbacks are fielding .978. In four games last week, Georgia fielded .986 with just two errors.

Condon Enjoying One Of The Best Freshman Seasons In School History

Redshirt-freshman **Charlie Condon** has been named to the Golden Spikes Award Midseason Watch List by USA Baseball. Also, Perfect Game named him a Midseason First Team All-American. He's among the NCAA's offensive leaders.

In Georgia history, one of the greatest freshman years belongs to 1985 National Freshman of the Year outfielder Ron Wenrich. He batted .396-20-70 in just 43 games. Consider Wenrich's fellow freshman teammate in 1985 was two-way standout Derek Lilliquist (8-5, 2.87 ERA in 86 IP, 93K plus hit .355-5-24). And then in 2004, freshman first baseman Josh Morris hit .319-16-71 in 68 games.

Through 37 games, Condon is batting .444-17-53. His on base percentage is .537 while his slugging percentage is .902.

The last freshman to lead Georgia in batting was Tucker Bradley in 2017 at .314-0-10 in 44 games. Currently, Bradley is in Triple-A in the Royals organization.

Two-Time Winner: Liam Sullivan

Georgia junior Liam Sullivan was named the Southeastern Conference Pitcher of the Week on Apr. 10. A 6-6, 255-pound native of Sandy Springs, Ga., Sullivan fired a complete game four-hit shutout to beat No. 10 Kentucky on Easter and even a series as the Wildcats had won 23 of their last 24 games.

The big left-hander matched his career high with seven innings and eight strikeouts to blank a Wildcat team that had been averaging 8.4 runs/game. It was only the fifth time under Nick Mingione's seven-year tenure that a UK team had been shut out.

In the 3-0 win, Georgia snapped the Wildcats six-game winning streak and handed them just their second loss in SEC action.

Sullivan became the first Georgia pitcher to toss an SEC shutout since 2014 when Robert Tyler blanked No. 11 Ole Miss in Oxford 2-0 in nine innings. Georgia went on to sweep a doubleheader that day to clinch their first SEC series. This is the second SEC weekly honor for Sullivan who earned it in February following a shutout of Princeton when he tossed seven hitless and scoreless innings to go with a career-best 11 strikeouts in a 9-0 win.

DID YOU KNOW? Sullivan is one of only six Bulldog pitchers in school history to be named SEC Pitcher of the Week twice in a season, joining Derek Lilliquist, 1987; Brooks Brown, 2006; Alex Wood, 2012; Tony Locey, 2019 and Jonathan Cannon, 2022. Currently, Sullivan is 4-1 with a 3.08 ERA in eight starts.

In the Scott Stricklin era, there have been eight Bulldogs earn Freshman All-America honors and six different Bulldogs named All-America 20 total times. The position players to earn Freshman All-America honors under Stricklin and their rookie campaigns are listed below:

#10 SCOTT STRICKLIN UGA'S IKE COUSINS HEAD BASEBALL COACH 10TH SEASON AT UGA; 19TH OVERALL



Ike Cousins Head Baseball Coach Scott Stricklin is in his 10th season at the helm of the Bulldog program.

The 2022 club battled through an array of pitching injuries to post a 36-23 mark and an appearance in the NCAA Chapel Hill (N.C.) Regional. On March 19, 2022, he became the fifth active coach in the SEC with 600 career wins when the Bulldogs beat No. 24 Miss. State 12-11. In April of 2021, it was announced he had agreed to a contract extension to lead Georgia through 2026.

The 2021 team spent 11 weeks in the nation's top 25 rankings and reached as high as No. 5 before a slew of injuries eventually took its toll. Still, Georgia notched a road series over No. 1 Vanderbilt. It marked the Commodores only home series loss. Georgia went 1-2 at the SEC Tournament and ended the year with a 31-25 mark.

The 2021 team spent 11 weeks in the nation's top 25 rankings and reached as high as No. 5 before a slew of injuries eventually took its toll. Still, Georgia notched a road series over No. 1 Vanderbilt. It marked the Commodores only home series loss. Georgia went 1-2 at the SEC Tournament and ended the year with a 31-25 mark. Georgia was one of just two schools to have earned a top eight National Seed for the NCAA Championships in both 2018 and 2019. Georgia was a No. 8 seed in 2018 and a No. 4 seed in 2019, which marked the best in school history. Then in 2020, the Bulldogs were poised to have a special year, selling out its season tickets, when the global COVID-19 pandemic hit. Georgia finished 2020 ranked as high as No. 2 nationally as it had jumped out to a 7-0 start, swept rival Georgia Tech for the third time in the past four years and tallied a 14-4 mark when the season was canceled. Four Bulldogs signed professional contracts including first round pick Emerson Hancock (sixth overall). Georgia was the only SEC program to receive NCAA APR recognition, 10 Bulldogs earned a degree, and the program posted a record 3.14 GPA for the spring. Hancock was just the fourth student-athlete in school history to be both a first round draft pick and first team Academic All-American.

Stricklin, who led his alma mater Kent State to five NCAA Regionals and the 2012 College World Series (CWS), was named head baseball coach at the University of Georgia on June 3, 2013. Stricklin, a two-time All-Mid-American Conference catcher, was a 23rd round draft pick of the Minnesota Twins in 1993, he played five seasons and reached the Triple-A level with the Twins. He graduated magna cum laude with a bachelor's degree in marketing from KSU in 1995. He and his wife Cheri have three children: daughters Sydney (19) who attends UGA, and Keaton (14), and a son, Cale (17).
