- 1. Reference: 20/00827/FUL: Address: **53 Fairview Drive**, **Bayston Hill**: Erection of first floor side extension and associated alterations It was **resolved unanimously to support this application**.
- 2. Reference: 20/00682/FUL: Address: **62 Lansdowne Crescent, Bayston Hill:** Erection of single storey extension and rebuilding of front garage wall It was **resolved unanimously to support this application.**
- 3. Reference: 20/00440/ADV: Address: **Bayston Hill Service Area**, Hereford Road, Bayston Hill: Erect and display 1 internally illuminated, 9-meter-high totem sign. Committee **resolved to submit a neutral comment** confirming they would not object to like for like replacement signage but observing that the service area is already very brightly lit, which has a detrimental impact on the amenity of overlooking properties and any increased illumination would tend to increase light pollution.
