TAMU Red Hat Academy Infosec Learning RH124 Lab Scholarship Program

Overview:

- This scholarship program is aimed to cover the cost of accessing an Infosec Learning RH124 lab which provides a hands-on training environment with guided exercises to help develop practical Linux administration skills.
- To gain access to Infosec learning labs, an access code is required. Texas A&M
 Cybersecurity Center has a limited number of access codes to distribute to students.

 There is going to be a holistic review to distribute access codes to up to 40-50 students at no-cost.
- An access code grants a student 6 month access to a cloud-based lab environment associated with guided exercises. The exercises are aligned with the RH124 curriculum for which students also have 6 month access.

RH124 Curriculum:

Red Hat System Administration I (RH124) equips you with Linux administration "survival skills" by focusing on foundational Linux concepts and core tasks. You will learn how to apply command-line concepts and enterprise-level tools.

Eligibility Requirements:

- A current college student enrolled at Texas A&M
- Looking to be a student in the Red Hat Academy program at Texas A&M

What we are looking for:

- Committed to learning RH124 curriculum and practicing <u>PE124 objectives</u>.
- A self-motivated and independent learner that seeks to ask questions when in need.
- Someone who wants to improve their technical knowledge or pursue a technology-related career.

***Up to 40-50 potential recipients will be selected. Limit 1 entry per individual.

Submission requirement:

Submission entry should be a pdf document of at least 250 words giving us an idea of why you should be selected for this scholarship program. Suggested format, but is not limited to:

- * Please answer questions with an asterisk.
 - Introduce yourself: Major, grade level, involvement in school and outside school, and interests.
 - What technical knowledge and skills do you want to gain before graduation? listing skills outside of Linux is encouraged.
 - What do you want to pursue after graduation?
 - How do you see skills gained through RH124 contributing to your technical knowledge and career? *
 - What is your time commitment and expectations?
 - Do you plan on spending winter break and/or next semester to learning RH124 curriculum? * Video lessons are around 7.23 hours + lab time + read curriculum time which can vary.
