# **Virtual Meeting**

BOH Meeting start: 8:17 pm

Opening Statement read by Secretary/ Township Clerk

A resolution was read by the Clerk stating that as permitted by the Open Public Meetings Act, stipulating that active participation by the public is limited to observation as set forth in the Agenda.

BOH Chair Engel made a motion to approve June 7, 2023 meeting minutes.

## HEALTH OFFICER REPORT

#### Health Department Updates:

<u>Mayor's Wellness Campaign</u>: Walk with the Mayor program continues throughout the rest of the year. Schedule of dates and location was shared.

#### **Animal Control:**

June Animal Control status report from the Township of Bloomfield Animal Control: 15 animal control calls: 3 domestic issues, 12 sick or injured wildlife. After hours calls: 3.

<u>Coyote Education and Tips:</u> On June 30<sup>th</sup> a coyote attacked 2 people and a dog in the South Mountain Reservation. All parties were treated for injuries and rabies treatment. Tips for keeping coyotes away was shared.

#### Communicable/ infectious disease updates:

<u>Essex County Mobile Health Clinic</u>: is up and running an offering COVID-19 primary vaccines and boosters, as well as health screenings and health education. The weekly schedule for July 3-8 was shared.

#### COVID:

• As of June 29<sup>th</sup>, COVID-19 community transmission (based on hospital admission levels) is LOW, statewide. There are less than 10 hospital admissions per 100,000 people in the state of NJ.

**Environmental Health:** a run down of environmental health activities, investigations and inspections were provided for the month of June.

<u>Spotted Lanternfly:</u> RN Markarova emphasized the importance of killing spotted lanternflies at any stage of their life cycle as they are harmful to our ecosystem.

#### Social Services/ Mental Health:

<u>Open Gym:</u> The Health Department in partnership with RWJ Barnabas and Maplewood Police Department provided sports nutrition and concussion prevention education to students at the Columbia High School Open Gym on June 9, 2023.

RN Markarova shared the New Jersey Department of Human Services social services flyer that includes contact information for different resources and services.

RN Markarova shared the Essex County Monthly Community Grocery Giveaway schedule open to all Essex County residents.

<u>Community Fridge</u>: Updates to new Community Fridge hours of operations was shared. The parking lot behind the community fridge will be closed overnight from 8pm-6am and doors will be installed onto the community fridge for overnight closure from 8am-8pm. DPW will increase cleaning and removal of personal items in and around the fridge

Presentation ended: 8:27 pm

# **BOARD OF HEALTH DISCUSSION**

Mr. DeLuca asked about the guidance for poor air quality and what communication was being provided to families that participate in township camps and outdoor programs. RN Markarova shared the NJ EPA guidance for air quality and outdoor activity for schools that was also given to Administration and the Department of Community Services. Mr. DeLuca expressed a need for a clearer message to parents regarding air quality and participation in township outdoor activities. Mayor Dafis asked if the Township has a policy in place. Mr. Wherry notified the Township Council of previous communication and cancellation of programs when the air quality was very unhealthy. Mr. Wherry will follow up with Department of Community Services and the Health Department to develop clearer communication regarding poor air quality and township camps.

Ms. Adams added that spotted lanternflies can be killed by combining equal parts water, dawn dishwashing soap, and rubbing alcohol and spray them a couple of times.

Mayor Dafis emphasized the changes being implemented to the Community Fridge and the collaborations between township departments to address resident concerns. Mayor Dafis asked Administration and the Health Department on the progress and timeframe to implement the changes. Mr. Wherry stated that the township has removed the picnic bench from behind the fridge, increased the frequency of cleaning the fridge and added additional cleaning of the surrounding area and parking lot. Mr. Wherry mentioned that the police department has already begun closing the parking lot overnight and the next step is to install doors on the shed itself. Mayor Dafis has RN Markarova how soon the health department will begin engagement at the community fridge in terms of surveys and regulation of distribution. RN Markarova notified Mayor Dafis that the surveys will begin this week and the research component is ongoing, the response to the overnight closure and the surveys will determine further research tactics. Mayor Dafis asked what the expected timeline is. RN Markarova described a 3 month increment timeframe, with a full picture in 6 months. Mayor Dafis expressed concern with that timeline and asked if it could be expedited. RN Markarova agreed. Mr. DeLuca requested that the township does not wait for DPW to build the doors and tasked Mr. Wherry with obtaining doors for the fridge. Mr. Wherry accepted.

Mayor Dafis emphasized the need to take action in regards to poor air quality for the townships most sensitive populations. Mayor Dafis asked administration to look into buying a few air purifiers and distribute them to residents who need them, the Township Committee members agreed.

# 3098-23

# AN ORDINANCE TO DIRECT THE INSTALLATION OF STOP SIGNS ON SUMMIT AVENUE AT ITS INTERSECTION WITH MIDLAND BOULEVARD

"Interpretive Statement"

This Ordinance will direct the installation of stop signs in both directions of Summit Avenue at its intersection with Midland Boulevard.

WHEREAS, the Township of Maplewood ("Township") Engineering, Public Works and Planning Sub-committee requested that the Engineering Department perform a study to determine whether a stop sign was appropriate for the intersection of Midland Boulevard and Summit Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the Engineering Department found that the roads in question are under municipal jurisdiction and therefore do not need New Jersey Commission of Transportation approval for the installation of a stop sign; and

WHEREAS, the Township Engineering Department, using the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices, did a study and determined that a stop sign at the referenced intersection does meet the necessary requirements; and

WHEREAS, the Township Engineering Department recommends that stop signs be installed on Summit Avenue at its intersection with Midland Boulevard.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Township Committee of the Township of Maplewood, County of Essex, State of New Jersey that:

### FIRST:

1. Stop signs be installed on the south and north corner of Summit Avenue at its intersection with Midland Boulevard.

2. The Township Department of Public Works install the aforementioned stop signs as a permanent traffic control as soon as practical.

# SECOND: Severability

If any section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the specific section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

### THIRD: <u>Repeal of Prior Ordinances</u>

Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of any such inconsistencies.

#### FOURTH: Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after final passage and publication and as provided by law.

*This ordinance will prohibit parking within five feet of a public or private driveway on Villa Terrace.* 

WHEREAS, the residents on Villa Terrace have experienced difficulty in ingress and egress

from their driveways; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Maplewood ("Township") wishes

to provide relief for the residents on Villa Terrace.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township

of Maplewood, County of Essex, State of New Jersey that:

# FIRST:

- Section 257-82.2 of the Code of the Township of Maplewood, Parking Too Close to Driveways shall be amended to add Villa Terrace as a street on which no vehicle shall park within five (5) feet of a public or private driveway.
- 2. The Township Department of Public Works shall put appropriate signage and/or markings to reflect the intent of this Ordinance.

# **<u>SECOND</u>:** <u>Severability</u>

If any section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the specific section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

# AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 187 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MAPLEWOOD ENTITLED OUTDOOR DINING

"Interpretive Statement"

This ordinance will establish a fee of \$150.00 per year for the securing of an outdoor café license and will require the removal of all equipment used in the outdoor café during a declared state of emergency or at the direction of the Township office of Emergency Management.

WHEREAS, the Township of Maplewood presently has, as codified in Chapter 187, an

Outdoor Café Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, certain modifications to the Outdoor Café Ordinance have been recommended; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Maplewood wishes to

implement these recommendations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the

Township of Maplewood, County of Essex, State of New Jersey, as follows:

**<u>FIRST</u>**: § 187-6 of the Code of the Township of Maplewood entitled Outdoor Dining Application for Licensing shall be amended by adding the following:

- a. There shall be an annual fee of \$150.00 to secure an outdoor café license which shall be payable at the time that the license is issued.
- b. § 187-15, Period of Operation shall be amended by adding the following:

An outdoor café shall be permitted to operate year round. However, Outdoor Cafés must remove all tables, chairs, umbrellas or other equipments used in the outdoor café when an adjacent sidewalk is snow or ice covered, when a State of Emergency has been declared or as directed by the Township Office of Emergency Management.

All other Sections shall remain unchanged.

If any section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the specific section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

# **RESOLUTION NO. 249-23**

### RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING USE OF COMPETITIVE CONTRACTING FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF LEGAL SERVICES, SPECIAL COUNSEL – LABOR AND EMPLOYMENT

WHEREAS, the Township of Maplewood ("Township") wishes to issue a Request for Qualifications ("RFQ") from law firms licensed to practice law in the State of New Jersey that wish to provide legal services related to the drafting, negotiation, and execution of collective bargaining agreements with the Township's employee bargaining units; employment matters; and other labor and employment matters as directed by the Township; and

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-4.1(4)1 permits competitive contracting to be used for any good or service exempt from public bidding pursuant to 40A:11-5, which includes professional services; and

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-4.3(a) requires that in order to use competitive contracting for the first time for a specified purpose, the governing body shall pass a resolution authorizing the use of competitive contracting for such purpose; and

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-4.3(b) requires that the competitive contracting process shall be administered by a designated Authorized Agent who may be a purchasing agent pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-9, or by legal counsel of the contracting unit, or by the chief administrative officer of the contracting unit; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township Committee has determined that the procurement of legal services for said purposes through the use of competitive contracting is in the best interest of the Township.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Maplewood, County of Essex, State of New Jersey that:

The Business Administrator is authorized to initiate competitive contracting for the solicitation of qualifications for legal services.

#### PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN ESSEX REGIONAL HEALTH COMMISSION AND TOWNSHIP OF MAPLEWOOD DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH

This Professional Services Agreement ("Agreement") is made and entered into as of this day of July, 2023 (the "Effective Date"), by and between Essex Regional Health Commission (hereinafter "ERHC") and the Township of Maplewood, Department of Health (hereinafter "MAPLEWOOD").

WHEREAS, MAPLEWOOD is a member of ERHC; and

**WHEREAS**, MAPLEWOOD has requested and ERHC has agreed to provide support to MAPLEWOOD in connection with certain inspection requirements of MAPLEWOOD; and

**WHEREAS**, the support will include the work of Licensed, Registered Environmental Health Specialists ("REHS").

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth, ERHC and MAPLEWOOD agree as follows:

- 1. **Scope of Service**. The ERHC agrees to provide the following services:
  - a. Restaurant and Retail Food Establishment Inspections.
  - b. Camp and Pool Inspections.
  - c. Massage Parlors Inspections
  - d. Complaints related to non-compliance of aforementioned entities or other entities licensed by the local health department.

2. **Term**. The term of this Agreement shall commence on the Effective Date and shall terminate June 30, 2024 unless this Agreement is otherwise extended or terminated in accordance with the terms specified herein.

3. **Payment**. MAPLEWOOD agrees to pay ERHC the sum of \$550.00 per day and \$275 a half day for the REHS providing the services set forth herein. MAPLEWOOD agrees to pay for the Services set forth herein monthly.

4. **Termination**. Either ERHC or MAPLEWOOD may terminate the Agreement upon thirty (30) days written notice to the other party to the Agreement.

5. **Indemnification**. ERHC and MAPLEWOOD agree to hold each other harmless from any and all obligations, penalties, fees, liabilities, judgments, claims and demands which

may arise out of this Agreement and further agrees to save and hold harmless each other and to defend at its own cost and expense any such claim or lawsuit instituted by third parties against the other party. Nothing contained herein shall relieve ERHC or MAPLEWOOD from liability for negligence or other wrong doing of its agents, servants and/or employees.

6. **Dispute Resolution**. In the event a dispute arises concerning the terms and conditions of the Agreement, ERHC and MAPLEWOOD agree:

- a. A representative designated by ERHC and a representative designated by MAPLEWOOD shall attempt to resolve the dispute, if that is unsuccessful;
- b. ERHC and MAPLEWOOD agree to appoint a retired Superior Court judge to act as mediator of the dispute. ERHC and MAPLEWOOD agree that the decision rendered by the mediator shall not be binding on the parties and shall in no way prejudice any rights they may have to pursue all available legal and equitable remedies.

7. **Authorization**. Each party represents and warrants to the other that all actions necessary to enter into and perform all obligations required by the Agreement have been validly taken and that the undersigned are authorized to execute the Agreement.

8. **Governing Law**. This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey.

9. **No Assignments**. This Agreement may not be assigned without the written consent of all parties.

10. **Entire Agreement**. This Agreement, represents the entire agreement between the parties hereto and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous written or oral agreements and all other communications between the parties relaying to the Services to be rendered hereunder. Any additions, deletions or modifications shall not be binding on either party unless accepted and approved in writing by duly authorized representatives of both parties, subject to Municipal Council approval. In the event of any contradictory provisions between this Agreement or other documents issued by ERHC or MAPLEWOOD in connection herewith, the terms set forth in the body of this Agreement shall prevail.

11. **Severability**. The provisions of this Agreement shall be deemed severable, and if any portion shall be held invalid, illegal or unenforceable for any reason, the remainder of this Agreement shall be effective and binding upon the parties, unless to do so would clearly violate the present legal and valid intention of the parties hereto.

12. **Notice**. All notices, consents, request, demands and other communications required or permitted hereunder shall be in writing (which includes facsimile) and shall be deemed given if (i) delivered personally, by overnight mail or by courier service; (ii) when sent by

confirmed facsimile; or (iii) if mailed by U.S. registered or certified mail (return receipt requested) to the party at the party's address written below or at such other address as the party may have previously specified by like notice. If by mail, delivery shall be deemed effective three (3) business days after mailing.
