

SETTING UP YOUR MOUSE

• Plug the USB connector into a USB port on your computer. Your computer automatically finds and installs the appropriate driver. When the installation completes, you can use your mouse.



CLEANING YOUR MOUSE

• Wipe the mouse with a damp, lint-free cloth.
