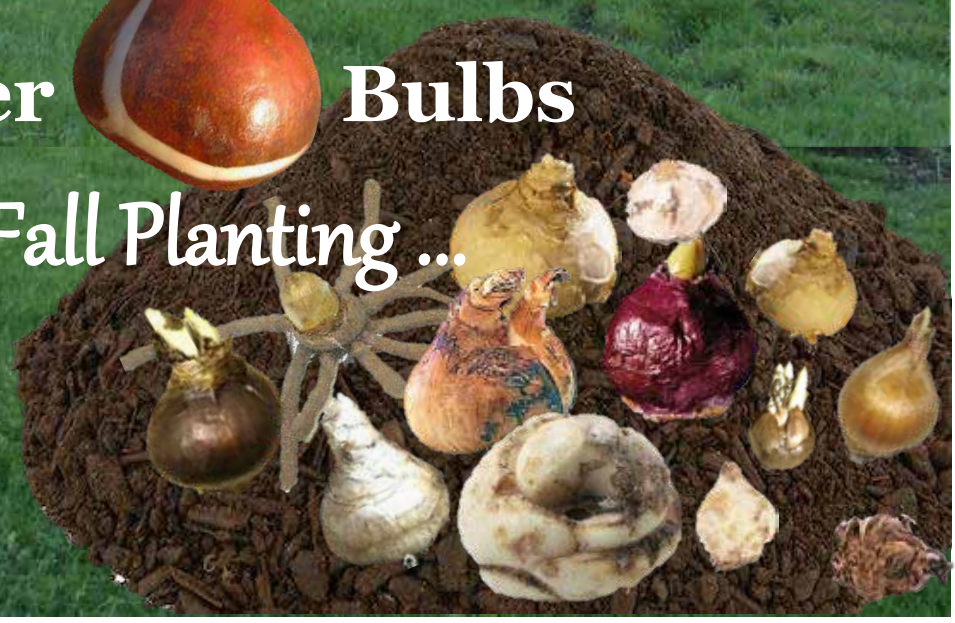

Flower Bulbs for Fall Planting 2023



From the *Ednie Team*

The catalog at which you are looking is a compilation of all flower bulbs which can be planted in the Fall. It is a listing of the items which we offer this Fall with some basic information and small pictures.

There are columns to indicate which flower bulbs can be planted for Cut Forcing and those which are suggested for Potted plants. All flower bulbs listed can be used in Landscapes: Paperwhites and Oxalis can only be used outdoors in warmer climate zones.

As flower bulbs are dug and crop information becomes available, we hope to inform you. Weather always plays a big role and this year is no different. The Tulip crop has been greatly affected by the late intense heat coupled with a heavy rainfall and thus we expect smaller bulbs and possible shortages.

See page 47 for all other catalogs. We update them when necessary. We just launched the 2023 Peony Catalog.

If you have any questions regarding growing habits of any of the items listed, feel free to contact us. Many errors can be made with incorrect storing temperatures and misunderstandings of the crops. Recommendation on how to handle the various crops will hopefully follow later when we ship the bulbs.

General Information



Ednie Flower Bulbs

For the Cut Flower Grower... make sure the Flower Bulbs

1. ... are planted upon arrival, especially if they have been specially programmed (such as Tulips). Otherwise you will forfeit the programming, resulting in poor quality flowers or "no shows".
2. ... are not held in freezers, but (if needed) at 40°F. for 5°C Tulips or at 48°F. for 9°C Tulips until planting. Regular Tulips can be held at either temperature. All other bulbs are best held between 60-70° F. (15-20°C.).
3. ... are planted in well-drained soil (unless grown hydroponically) to establish an excellent root system.
4. ... are kept away from ethylene producing products (e.g. fruit) at all times.



For the Pot Plant Grower... make sure the Flower Bulbs

1. ... are planted upon arrival depending on what programming they received.
2. ... are held in a dry, cool, shaded environment if this is not possible.
3. ... do NOT freeze prior to planting.
4. ... are planted in well-drained soil, pH 6.5 to 7.

Please read further recommendations in (upcoming) Catalog for Potted Flower Bulbs.

For the Landscaper... make sure the Flower Bulbs

1. ... are stored in a dry, cool, and shaded environment when they arrive if they are not planted immediately.
2. ... are planted in a cultivated, well-drained soil, so they do not sit in water after a heavy rainfall.
3. ... have enough time to develop a good root system before (possible) cold sets in to ensure high quality flowers.
4. ... plant depth is approximately 3 times the height of the bulbs to be planted.

Alliums

Alliums are also called the Ornamental Onions. There are 3 different groups of Alliums. The Miniatures are primarily used for landscaping. Some of the varieties in the Medium group can be used as potted plants and need cooling just like Tulips. The Large Flowering varieties are taller globe-shaped flowers and can be used as cut flowers.

For the Landscaper:

Alliums are Deer-Resistant!!!

The space between the Allium bulbs depends on the flower size. Some of the varieties have small bulbs, yet large flower heads, like Allium Schubertii, which is an ideal flower to dry; it can last for years!!

The individual small flowers being part of the Allium flower head are loaded with nectar, hence the attraction to bees and butterflies.

Alliums

belongs to the Liliacea family which includes onions, leeks, chives, and their families. There are many species although not all are cultivated.

Camassias

Camassia was formerly a member of the Family Liliaceae but now belongs to Family Asparagaceae. It is a small genus of North America, also called Quamash or Indian Camas. They have narrow, grasslike leaves. Flowers are not tubular, but of 6 separate segments with a stamen inserted at the base. Fruits are 3-valved capsules, the seeds are black.

For cut flowers, keep them cool overnight before using.

Crocus

is a member of the Family Iridaceae. These harbingers of Spring are stemless plants growing from corms. Crocus is the Greek name for saffron. The foliage is narrow, grasslike and appears before, with, or after the flowers. Although some Crocus flower in the Fall, the most popular varieties which are listed below flower in the Spring. They can be forced into bloom from January on but are not recommended for forcing after March as the flowers do not last as long as other bulb flowers. They do well in Dutch Flowering Bulb Gardens (See page 12 of this catalog and in "Pot Forcing Flower Bulbs Catalog").

Fritillarias

is a member of the Family Liliaceae and has great variation in bulb size as well as flower size from the small Guinea-Hen flowers to the large Crown Imperials. The Crown Imperials have a peculiar odor which keeps rodents away in landscapes where rodents are a pest.

Plant the bulbs 3 - 5" (7 - 12 cm.) apart and 3 - 5" (7 - 12 cm.) deep in moist, well-drained soil. They do not like to dry out in Spring.

Eremurus

was formerly a member of the Liliaceae but now belongs to Family Asphodelaceae. It is also called Foxtail Lily or Desert Candle. They are native to Eastern Europe. Long slender leaves spring from fleshy, rope-like roots in dense basal rosettes. The flower stalks, mostly taller than 4 ft (100 cm.) are "clothed" halfway with colorful starry blooms. Excellent for cut and landscape. Well-drained, sandy soil and full sun are recommended for best results. The plants die after flowering but reappear in Spring. Do protect against late frosts.

Hyacinths

Hyacinthus orientalis was formerly a member of the Family Liliaceae but now belongs to Family Asparagaceae. It is a small genus which originated in the Mediterranean region. It is named for the mythological character "Hyacinth". Although Hyacinths are primarily used for pot plants from early January until after Easter they also do well in landscapes. (It is not necessary to dig the bulbs up; just let them perennialize.)



Hyacinths are very fragrant. The raceme (flower cluster with individual florets) grows about 8 - 10" (20 - 25 cm.) tall. Each individual floret has 3 outer and 3 inner petals (like all members of the Asparagaceae family) and are about 1 - 1.5" (2-4 cm.) long. The majority have single flowers although some are double. Another type is the Multiflora Hyacinths (also called Roman Hyacinths) which produces several stems of spaced out florets. They have an airy presentation and can be used as 1 bulb per pot or in the front of landscapes.

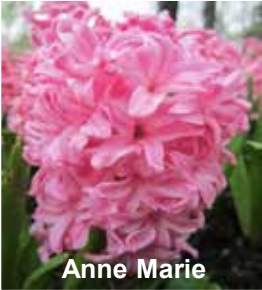

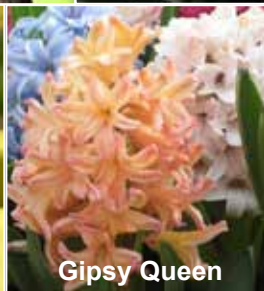

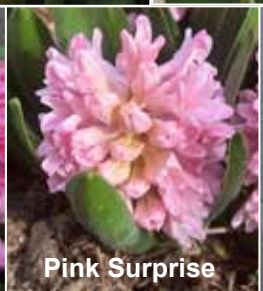

Iris

Bulbous Iris (not to be confused with Bearded Iris which are perennial roots) belongs to the Family Iridaceae; there are two different types: Miniature or Dwarf Iris (Iris Reticulata) and Dutch Iris (Iris Hollandica).

Reticulatas are stemless Iris with grass-like foliage. They bloom early in the season.

Hollandicas (mostly for cut) are taller, have grass-like foliage and bloom in early summer.

Leucojums



Leucojum is a member of the Amaryllidaceae family.

They are also called *Summer Snowflakes*.

They originated in central Europe, Northwest Africa and Turkey.

It is a perennial bulbous plant.

The well developed leaves (when flowering) are narrow and strap-shaped. Flower stems are hollow. The flowers and leaves are being used in medicine (alkaloid galanthamine used in Reminyl for Alzheimer's disease.)

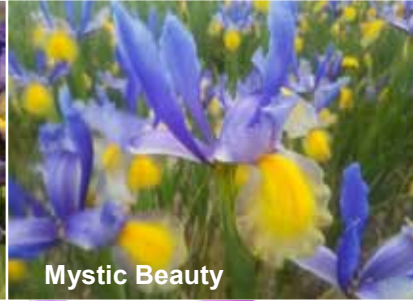

Narcissi



Narcissus is a member of the Family Amaryllidaceae. Each flower, trumpet or cup shaped corona is surrounded by 6 petals. This genus is known since ancient civilisation both botanically as well as medicinally (such as for Alzheimer Disease). This genus includes Daffodils, Jonquils, Paperwhite Narcissus and others.

Many are fragrant. In this catalog we list the following groups:

Daffodil The trumpet-shaped corona is longer than the surrounding six petals.

Large Cupped The corona is a large cup which is shorter than the surrounding six petals.

Split Corona or Butterfly The corona is split for at least 1/3 of its length, making it look like a butterfly.

Double They produce one or more flowers. The corona or the tepals are double, or both.

Other Small Cupped (corona is much shorter than Large Cupped), Tazetta (many flowers) and Triandrus (2 or more flowers).

Miniature Hybrids of Narcissus Cyclamineus; tepals curve slightly backwards; mostly short.

Specialty Various shorter varieties; great for rock gardens and pots.

Paperwhite Narcissi

Paperwhite Narcissi are primarily used for indoor forcing. They can easily be forced into bloom starting the middle of November. These flower bulbs can be grown in pots with soil or on pebbles with water. Cooler forcing will keep the plants shorter. When planted in December, forcing time can be as short as 3 weeks.

They are also very popular for winter shows (indoor landscaping) and in the warmer climate zones they can be used in outdoor landscapes.

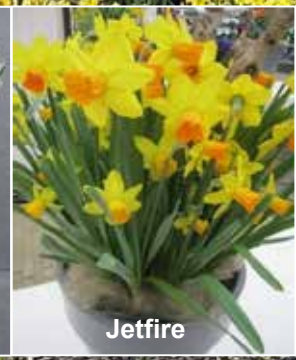

Ornithogalum was, like other flower bulbs, formerly a member of the Family Liliaceae but now belongs to Family Asparagaceae. It is a small genus which originated in the southern region of Europe and Africa. Slender stalks bear clusters of star-shaped flowers. The common name of the white variety is "Star of Bethlehem" (see Biblical story of the birth of Jesus). The plant has basal leaves. Through hybridizing, new colors and applications are possible such as cut flowers and as potted plants.

When grown in landscapes they virtually need no care as they multiply rather rapidly. As cut flowers, they last a long time, especially when water is refreshed weekly.

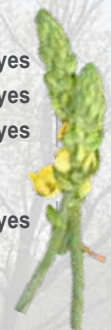

Oxalis

are members of the Family Oxalidaceae and are also called Wood Sorrels (because of the acid taste). They do well in Combination Gardens (See page 13 of this catalog and our "Pot Forcing Flower Bulbs Catalog"). The leaves of the oxalis plants are very light sensitive; they open when light and close when dark. Oxalis can also be used in landscapes in warmer climate zones.

- *Adenophylla* (commonly known as the Chilean Oxalis or silver shamrock) grow best in a cool greenhouse.
- *Deppei* Iron Cross does well in pots as well as landscape (hardy zones 7 - 10).
- *Fanny* and *Myke* are both *Triangularis* types, *Fanny* has light green foliage while *Myke* has purple foliage. *Myke's* flowers are slightly larger than the regular *Triangularis*.
- *Regnellii* (also called Shamrock) is most popular for St. Patrick's Day and is a great ground cover in the warmer climate zones.
- *Triangularis* are popular from small to larger containers, including hanging baskets because of their continuous flowering.

Tulips



Tulipa 'gesneriana' is a member of the Family Liliaceae. It is the most popular flowering bulb. Of the 22,000 hectares (54,300 acres) flower bulbs grown in The Netherlands, more than 50% is Tulips. 65-70% of the Tulip bulbs are being used for commercial forcing which translates into 3,700,000,000 Tulips stems. The other 30-35% are being used in landscaping, either by home-owners or in public gardens and other plantings. More than 1,000,000,000 Tulip bulbs end up in North America.

Because of where they originated, Tulips need a cold period prior to flowering. The total amount of cold (either as bulb in cold storage or planted in the ground) can vary from 12 to 18 weeks depending on the individual variety. For forcing weeks, see our extended Cut Tulip Catalog or the Tulip section in the Pot Flower Bulb Catalog. For optimum flowering results, Tulip bulbs need to have a good root system. Hence the place where Tulips are planted (soil or water) needs to be optimum. Although Tulip bulbs come with their own "food storage", additional fertilizing will ensure better flowering plants. Last but not least, the emphasis should be on water. Once a Tulip bulb is ready to plant all the parts of the plant are inside the bulb, but the cells need to be filled with water. At the same time, Tulip bulbs do not like to drown in water; therefore a well-drained soil with a pH of 7 is advised.

Groups of Tulips

Although there are many different groups, listed below are the groups we currently handle. Fringed Tulips can be found in the groups to which they belong. These varieties are marked "fringed" in the description.

Viridiflora Tulips, as well as Cottage Tulips, are part of the Single Late groups. Further description and or particulars are listed by each group heading. The groups are listed in (approximate) natural flowering order. Each year and each territory may be different.

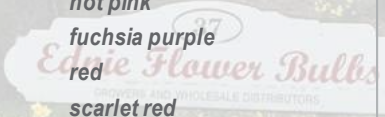
Darwin Hybrid Tulips

This group originated from a cross between Darwin and Fosterina Tulips. They produce some of the largest flowers on sturdy, tall stems and generally have broad foliage. The majority have 36 chromosomes versus most of the regular Tulips which have 24 chromosomes.



Because plants are heavier, cut flower producers need to ensure they plant fewer bulbs per crate or square yard (or meter). When forcing, they are not the earliest to bloom. In landscapes they are very showy. Because of their height, they should not be planted in front rows of gardens. Under normal circumstances they are very strong and last the longest of all Tulips and come back the best in consequent years.

Triumph Tulips can be used for Pot production in various size pots depending on the height of the variety. Growers can plant 3 bulbs per 4" (10 cm.) pot, 5 or 6 per 6" (15 cm.) pot, 8-10 per 8" (20 cm.) pot, 12-15 per 10" (25 cm.) pot and even up to 20 in 12" (30 cm.) pots. For larger pots, taller varieties give the best presentation.

Potted plants can be kept short with a Plant Growth Regulator (if needed). Many varieties are adaptable and can be forced from earlier to later in the growing season. Triumph Tulips perform well in Dutch or Spring Flowering Gardens, see page 12 and 13.

Triumph Tulips are very versatile and always great in landscapes, whether in formal beds or artistic designs. The huge collection of color combinations make Triumph Tulips very attractive. Homeowners will often add bonemeal to their soil when they plant bulbs. However, this may attract rodents who will dig up the bulbs.

A better way to fertilize is to wait until the plants are above ground and then feed them once with Calcium Nitrate although it is not really necessary. Make sure the gardens are watered well in spring.

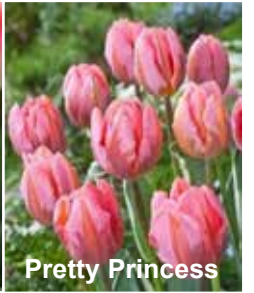

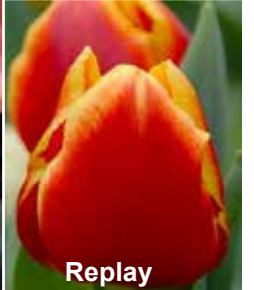

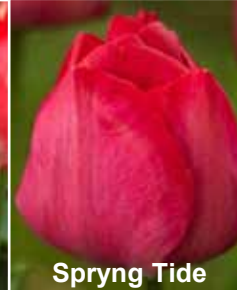

Through hybridizing, new varieties are constantly added to this group. One example is the variety **GARDEN FESTIVAL** which will be available (in small quantities) starting next year.

Single Late Tulips

The group Single Late Tulips combines various groups, original groups originally known as Darwin Tulips (Fore-Father of Darwin Hybrids) and Cottage Tulips. Darwin Tulips were selected by the cup-shape of the flower, while Cottage Tulips were selected because of their egg-shape flowers. Added to this group are the Viridiflora Tulips which are included because of their size of flower, flowering time and height. *Some of the flowers have fringed edges (see explanation on page 28).*



While most of the taller varieties are not suitable for Pot Production, many are very suitable for Cut flower production. Others are lanky and graceful and better used in landscapes. This group includes the French Tulips which are selected (originally grown in France because of the warmer temperatures and thus able to bring them in productions earlier) because of the size of the flower and the stem length.

In landscapes they perform best when planted in a more protected area and away from the front because of their height.

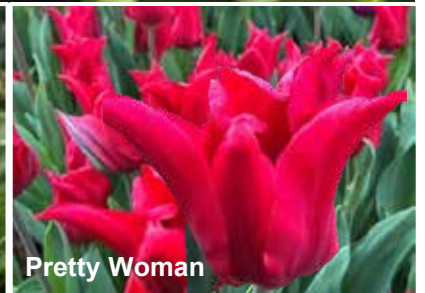

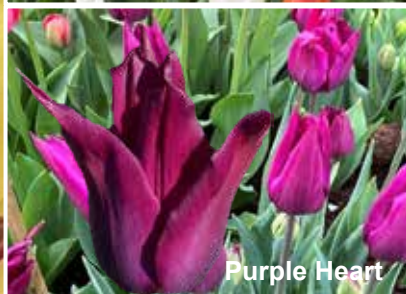

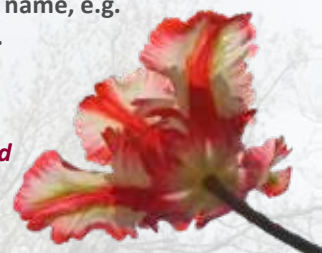

Parrot Tulips

Parrot Tulips are mutations (not hybrids) of existing varieties and appeared over the years of producing flower bulbs. From them others "showed up" and were registered. An example is the variety Alberio (not in production any longer) out of which the mutant Karel Doorman came which produced many other mutants. Sports from Karel Doorman are Apricot Parrot (a well-loved variety), Comet, Salmon Parrot besides 12 other varieties which were registered. Salmon Parrot was the parent of Professor Röntgen and Fancy Parrot. When mutations appear from a registered variety, often that name is the Parrot name, e.g. Negrita Parrot. Generally the flowers are large with petals that are twisted, cut and feathered.



Because of their variation in height, shorter Parrot Tulips can be used in pot forcing, while taller varieties are excellent and unique for cut flower production. Some varieties have weaker stems and are mostly used in landscapes. Wind protection is advised and semi-shade will make the flowers last longer in the garden. Make sure Tulips have enough water available from emergence until flowering.

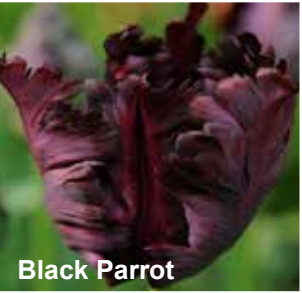

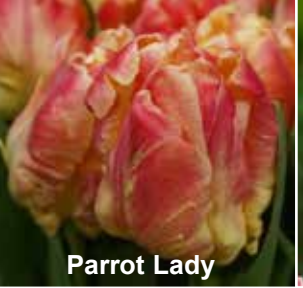

Travels of a Flower Bulb



As with all living things, Flower Bulbs also breathe, multiply, need a rest period, sometimes need to be washed and often carefully checked for diseases or problems.

As with human beings, flowers also have their DNA and no two seemingly identical flowers are exactly the same: the miracle of creation.

When growing in the fields, plants and flowers are examined (even by drones nowadays) for diseases especially for viruses, either in the plant itself or in the flower.



Field grown, inspected and the flowers are removed for optimum flower bulb production and size.



Once the bulbs are "mature" they are dug, and stored in temperature controlled environments. These temperatures vary depending on which programming they will receive which ultimately depends on their end use: destination: Cut, Pot, or Landscape.



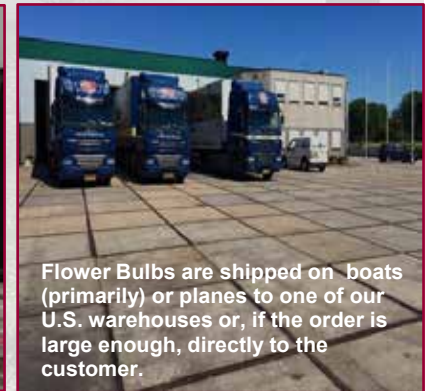
Products entering in North America need to be clean and therefore many need to be washed. This is not always ideal for the product.



Since Fusarium can be detrimental to Tulip bulbs, especially after washing, new machines were invented to detect diseased bulbs by imagery so they can be eliminated early on. (One rotten apple can ruin the entire basket.)

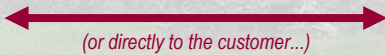


When the bulbs are ready to be shipped, they first need to be approved by Dutch Inspectors and then by the American/Canadian USDA. They are then packed for shipment in temperature controlled containers.



Flower Bulbs are shipped on boats (primarily) or planes to one of our U.S. warehouses or, if the order is large enough, directly to the customer.

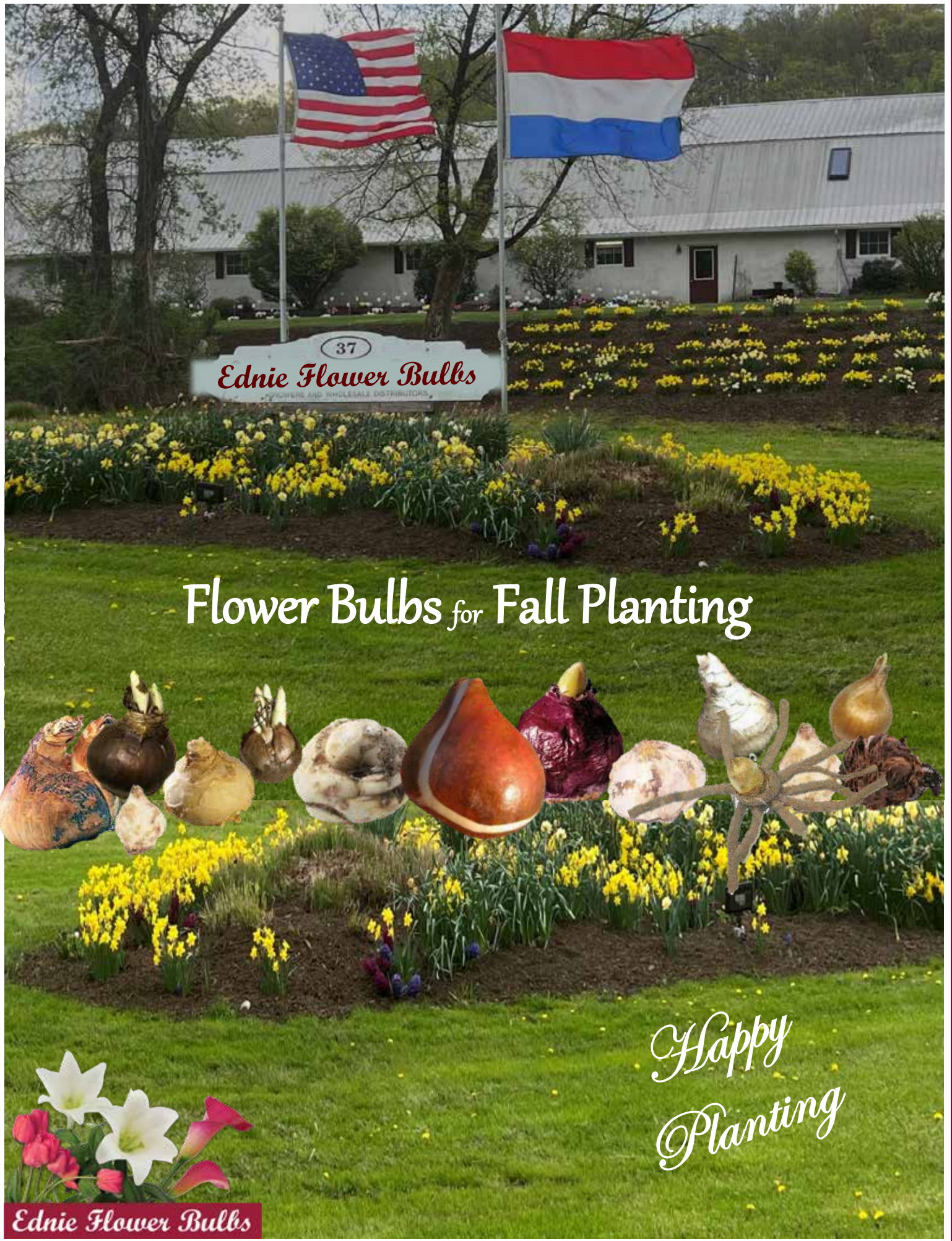
