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(4) Justification for restricting consideration to a brand-name item:

At this time, the AFLCMC/WIIM doesn't have a qualified replacement that can fit into their customized environment that will not limit, diminish, or cripple the agencies capabilities. An acquisition of non-compliant license would cause an unacceptable degradation in network functionality and place a financial burden on the Government.

(5) Contracting Officer's determination that the anticipated cost to the Government will be fair and reasonable:

The Contracting Officer (CO) has determined that the anticipated cost to the Government will be fair and reasonable and in the Government's best interest. An Independent Government Estimate has been performed to validate the anticipated cost and is attached to the purchase request package. This effort will be competed amongst authorized resellers on the NETCENTS-2 contract vehicle and price competition is anticipated. The CO will ensure that the contract represents the best value (as defined in FAR 2.10 I) and results in the lowest overall cost alternative (considering price, special features, administrative costs, etc.) to meet the Government's needs.

(6) Other facts supporting the justification:

Market research was conducted in accordance with FAR Part I 0. Market research determined the requested Fortify Premium Edition is available from several of the NETCENTS-2 vendors.
