- Intuitive Touch Screen Interface installs near the entrance of a meeting room to provide a clear indication of the "Clean State" status and meeting schedule.
- Facilities Maintenance can also utilize the screen to input a unique code/PIN once the room has been cleaned, placing the room in a usable state.
- Interface can be customized with indicator colors as well as text information for room name, number and in-use/availability information.

CEN-ODT-C-POE



- Occupancy Sensor monitors room utilization in real-time.
- Once room is vacant, a "Needs Cleaning" state is evaluated.
- If needed, an auto-notification is sent to facilities maintenance advising room needs to be cleaned.

SSW-102



- Outside-Room Indicator light can be custom color coded to visually notify employees that a room needs to be cleaned before the next meeting.
- Once room has been cleaned, the indicator will change colors advising employees that the room is now available.
